Setting up your HUE camera


Step 1

With your HUE camera connected to your computer, please launch Microsoft Teams, and sign in to your account.

Click on your profile icon located near the top right corner, then click on Settings (see image below).



Step 2

On the Settings page, Click on **Devices** on the panel to the left, to reveal the camera and microphone settings page.






Step 3

Device Settings: On the **Devices** settings page, there will be a list of drop-down menus. Click on the drop-down menu below **Microphone** and select your **HUE** camera to use your HUE camera microphone.



Click on the drop-down menu below **Camera**, and select your HUE camera from the list.



You can now use your HUE camera as a capture device on Microsoft Teams. Use the **Make a Call** button on the Calls tab, or accept a call that you have received.








Using HUE Intuition with Teams

If you want to share your HUE Intuition screen through Microsoft Teams rather than connecting directly to the camera, these instructions will help you get started.

Step 1

Launch **HUE Intuition** and select your HUE camera using the drop-down menu located near the bottom right.

Open the Microsoft Teams app and make a call or join a call that you have been invited to.






You can click on the **Activity button** on the top-left corner to see any calls you have received.


Step 2

Once you are on the call, click on the **Share** button located on the menu bar.





Clicking the share button will reveal a list of open applications and windows. Click on the HUE Intuition application window to share it with Mirosoft Teams.




Step 3

After clicking on the application window, your screen will switch to HUE Intuition, allowing you to use the application during the call. This enables your call participants to see what you are doing in HUE Animation.

You can hover your mouse towards the top of the HUE Intuition window to reveal the Microsoft Teams overlay menu.
