WARNINGS AND LIMITATIONS


- Never use the FallTech Arc Flash Rescue Strap for personal fall arrest, restraint, or work positioning.
- Inspect the FallTech Arc Flash Rescue Strap before each use in accordance with the requirements in Section 6 below.
- Never modify or alter the FallTech Arc Flash Rescue Strap. This includes extending the length or tying knots in the Arc Flash Rescue Straps.
- Immediately inspect the FallTech Arc Flash Rescue Strap for damage if the strap has been loaded.
- Do not use this product if the user exceeds the rated capacity of the FallTech Arc Flash Rescue Strap.
- Do not use this product if it will interfere with any personal fall protection equipment.
- Avoid using around moving machinery, thermal, electrical and/or chemical hazards as contact may cause serious injury or death.
- All procedures shown in these instructions are for FallTech Arc Flash Rescue Straps only.
- Report all incidents to your supervisor or safety coordinator.

1.0 Description - The FallTech Arc Flash Rescue Straps is used to attach front self rescue loops to FallTech Arc Flash Harnesses that do not have integral straps built in or other frontal or sternal connection. .

- 2.0 Application The FallTech Arc Flash Rescue Straps is designed to be used as aid for self rescue.
- 3.0 System Requirements The FallTech Arc Flash Rescue Straps is designed for use by a single person with a combined weight no greater than 310 lbs (141kg).
 - 3.1 Compatibility of Components: Equipment is designed for use with approved components and subsystems only. Substitutions or replacements made with non-approved components or subsystems may jeopardize compatibility of equipment and may affect the safety and reliability of the complete system.
 - 3.2 Making Connections: Only use locking connectors with this equipment. Only use connectors that are suitable to each application. Ensure all connections are compatible in size, shape, and strength. Do not use equipment that is not compatible. Visually ensure all connectors are fully closed and locked.

4.0 Installation

- **4.1 Pre-Use Inspection:** Inspect the Arc Flash Rescue Straps thoroughly before beginning to work at height for damage or wear. Inspect the webbing and stitching for cuts, fraying, and signs of damage to the webbing from excessive wear or abrasion. Inspect the labels, all labels must be present and legible. If any of these conditions exist, remove from service.
- 4.2 Installation Procedure: Ensure the Arc Flash Rescue Straps are clean and free of oil, grease, or debris. See the figures below for the installation




Place the Arc Flash Rescue straps behind the harness where the shoulder strap crosses the leg straps.



Feed the end of the Arc Flash Rescue straps through the opposite loop and choke down onto the harness




Place a double locking carabiner in the two loops when ready to use.



5.0 Maintenance, Service, and Storage

- 5.1 Maintenance: No scheduled maintenance is required, other than the replacement of items that fail inspection.
- 5.2 Service: There are no specific service requirements for this system component.
- 5.3 Storage: Store in a clean, dry, chemical-free environment out of direct sunlight. Avoid prolonged exposure to extreme heat conditions.
- 6.0 Inspection Inspect the FallTech Arc Flash Rescue Straps for damage and wear. If any abnormalities are found, remove from service.
- 7.0 Labels The labels must be present and legible.
