





Stress and injuries are reduced by providing a sure-footed, quiet, shock-absorbing surface. Plastisol-coated .314′′ diameter woven wire has ⁷/₈′′x 2³/₁₆′′ square openings. A better, more profitable way to bring veal calves to market, or get your replacement heifers off to a good start.

2. Reduced Knee & Leg Abrasions

Tenderfoot's friendly surface is kind to the sensitive skin of young piglets. No rough or sharp edges to cause injuries and open the door for infection. Research farm tests showed abrasions on 45% of the pigs farrowed on wire mesh, none with Tenderfoot.

3. Reduced Incidence of Spraddle Legs and Underline Problems (Teat Necosis)

Small openings prevent entrapment and leg injury, yet provide the traction necessary to reduce spraddle legs and sprains, to avoid crushing by the sow and to properly massage the udder for maximum milk let-down.

4. Insulated Surface Controls Heat Loss

Plastisol coating is a superb insulator and provides superior comfort. Warm living conditions allow pigs to direct food energy to weight gain by reducing the energy needed to maintain body temperature.

5. Strong-But-Soft Coating, Extended Life

In many installations Tenderfoot has lasted substantially longer than other flooring systems. Many have found it to be the best system for their livestock and the least expensive when its extended life is considered.
