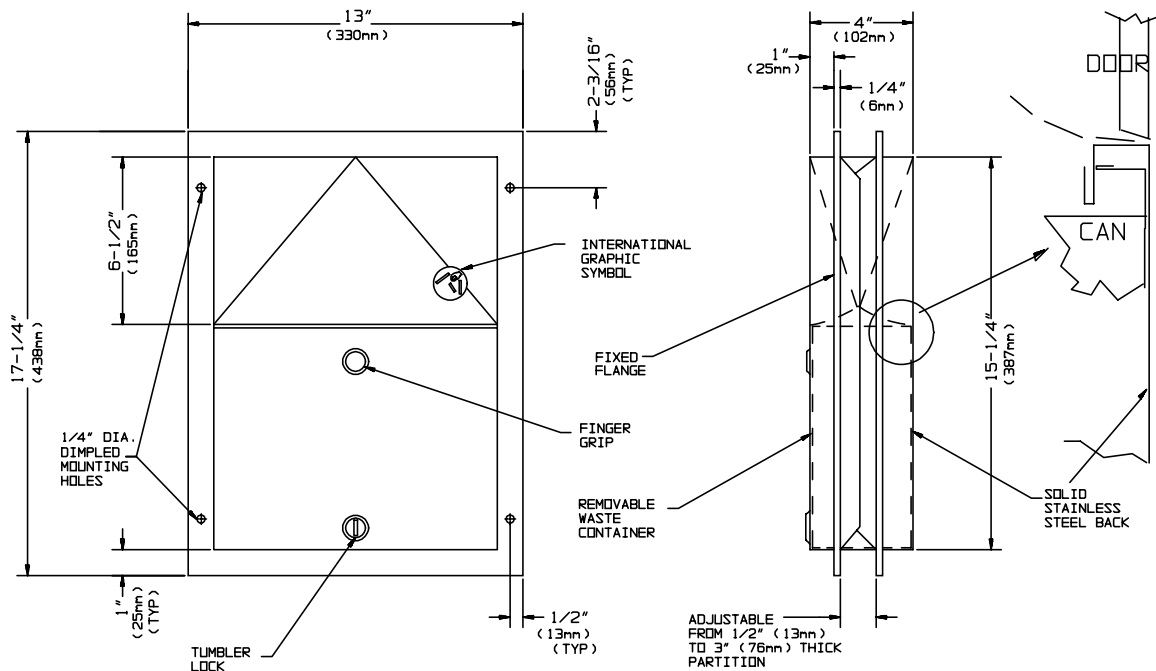

## PARTITION MOUNTED DUAL ACCESS SANITARY NAPKIN DISPOSAL



### SPECIFICATION

Partition Mounted Dual Access Sanitary Napkin Disposal shall hold 1.5 gal (5.7liters) of dry/solids waste and shall have doors and cabinet fabricated of alloy 18-8 stainless steel, type 304, 22 gauge. All exposed surfaces shall be N° 4 satin finish and be protected during shipment with a PVC film easily removable after installation. Upper doors shall be hung to cabinet with a stainless steel spring hinge and have the international waste symbol on face. Waste container shall have hemmed edges for safety and shall be retained by a tumbler lock keyed alike to other ASI washroom equipment and be removable from one side for servicing. Structural assembly of body and door components shall be of welded construction. Face trim mounting flanges shall be of one piece construction 1" (25.4mm) wide with no welded miters and shall have square 1/4" (6.4mm) returns with an adjustability range for partition thickness of 1/2" to 3" (13mm to 76mm).

### INSTALLATION

Unit is mounted on partition using eight (8) N°10 self-tapping screws (supplied). For maximum usability and compliance with ADA Accessibility Guidelines, unit should be installed so that top of disposal door is between 33" (864mm) maximum above finished floor (AFF) and 24" (610mm) minimum AFF and 27" to centerline of cutout from rear wall. One trim mounting flange adjusts for partition thickness of 1/2" to 3" (13mm to 76mm). Note that cut-out is 3/16" (5mm) above cabinet door top and 13/16" (21mm) below top mounting flange top edge.

**Partition Cutout Required is ...11-3/8"W x 15-5/8"H x 1/2" to 3" thick partition (289mm x 397mm x 13mm to 76mm)**

### OPERATION

Users push doors to deposit waste material. Doors are self-closing and operate independently and may be used simultaneously. Maintenance schedule determines waste removal cycle. Unit is emptied by removing bottom waste container and inverting over collection bag. Waste container is captured by lock to prevent inadvertent dumping and safety-edged finger grip provides convenient grip for service.
