


INSTALLATION

1

Install the four support legs


Pair Support Leg 01 with Support Leg 03, and Support Leg 04. The height can be adjusted as needed.

Use M6x15mm Bolts, Washers, and Nuts

Attach the four support legs to the bottom shelf using M10x1.25x50MM Bolts, Washers, and Nuts





Attach the connecting rod to the support legs using
M8x20MM Bolts, Washers, and Nuts

Attach the top shelf to the four support legs Using
M6x15MM Bolts, Washers, and Nuts



When installing on a Jeep JL Wrangler, pull the slide extension out and use the pre-threaded inserts and M10 Bolt, Washer, and Nut to Install directly to the truck bed.



If installing onto other SUVs/CUVs, please check the car owner's handbook or the rear base of your vehicle for anchor point location.

If available, use the chair anchor points to bolt the drawer onto your car.

Check carefully the size between the chair mounting points and compare with the mounting rail at the bottom of the Shelf. Move mounting rail to desired right position.





Use the M10 bolts, nuts and washers. Some vehicles may require longer or shorter bolts. Please check your owners handbook or contact your local vehicle dealer if unable to locate or no anchor points available.

To access the bottom mounting rail easily, slide out the top panel and carefully pull out the drawer tub.

SET-UP & CARE INSTRUCTIONS

CLEANING

Materials Needed:

- Mild dish soap or automotive soap
- Warm water
- Soft cloth or sponge
- Soft-bristle brush (if needed)
- Hose or bucket
- Microfiber cloth
- Optional: Car wax or polish for powder-coated surfaces

Steps:

- Rinse: Use clean water to remove loose dirt.
- Wash: Mix soap with warm water. Gently scrub with a soft cloth or sponge.
- Rinse: Thoroughly rinse off all soap.
- Dry: Use a microfiber cloth to dry.
- Optional: Apply wax or polish for extra shine and protection.

Tips:

- Avoid abrasive cleaners and harsh chemicals.
- Clean regularly to maintain appearance.

WARRANTY

Overland Vehicle Systems Cargo Shelves are produced to the highest manufacturing standards and are covered by a 5 Year limited warranty that protects the original purchaser against any defects in materials and workmanship under normal use. If upon determination by Overland Vehicle Systems that the shackle is defective, Overland Vehicle Systems will replace without charge, with an equivalent Cargo Shelf to the original purchaser according to the instructions supplied with the Cargo Shelf, and not damaged due to abuse, misuse or negligence. This warranty will not cover any labor charges incurred in installation, removal, replacement or repair, transportation cost or any consequential damages, which might be caused by the product. Overland Vehicle Systems shall not be liable in case of;

- Improper installation or modification of original product.
- Damages resulting from abuse
- Improper installation
- Any commercial application If the original purchaser finds a defect in material or workmanship, please contact Overland Vehicle Systems Warranty Service, 9830 Norwalk Blvd Suite 130, Santa Fe Springs, CA 90670.

! WARNINGS

- **DO NOT** exceed the manufacturer's specified weight capacity for the cargo shelf or sliding extension.
- **EVENLY** distribute cargo weight to prevent tipping, binding, or structural stress.
- **ALWAYS** secure all cargo with appropriate tie-downs or restraints before vehicle operation.
- **DO NOT** operate the vehicle with loose, unsecured, or shifting cargo.
- **ENSURE** the sliding extension is fully locked in the open or closed position before driving.
- **NEVER** allow passengers or pets to sit, stand, or ride on the cargo shelf or sliding extension.
- **DO NOT** use the sliding extension as a step, seat, or work platform.
- **KEEP** hands, fingers, and clothing clear of moving parts to avoid pinch or crush injuries.
- **INSPECT** mounting hardware, fasteners, and slide mechanisms regularly for looseness, wear, or damage.
- **DISCONTINUE** use immediately if any component shows signs of bending, cracking, excessive wear, or malfunction.
- **ALWAYS** follow vehicle manufacturer guidelines for cargo load limits and interior mounting points.
- **DO NOT** modify the cargo shelf or sliding extension, as modifications may compromise safety and structural integrity.
- **ENSURE** proper installation according to the provided instructions before use.
- **USE** caution when operating the sliding extension on uneven terrain or inclines.
- **REMOVE** or reduce cargo load when traveling off-road or over rough terrain to prevent damage or failure.
- **KEEP** children away from the sliding extension during operation.
- **FAILURE** to follow these warnings may result in injury, vehicle damage, or product failure.
