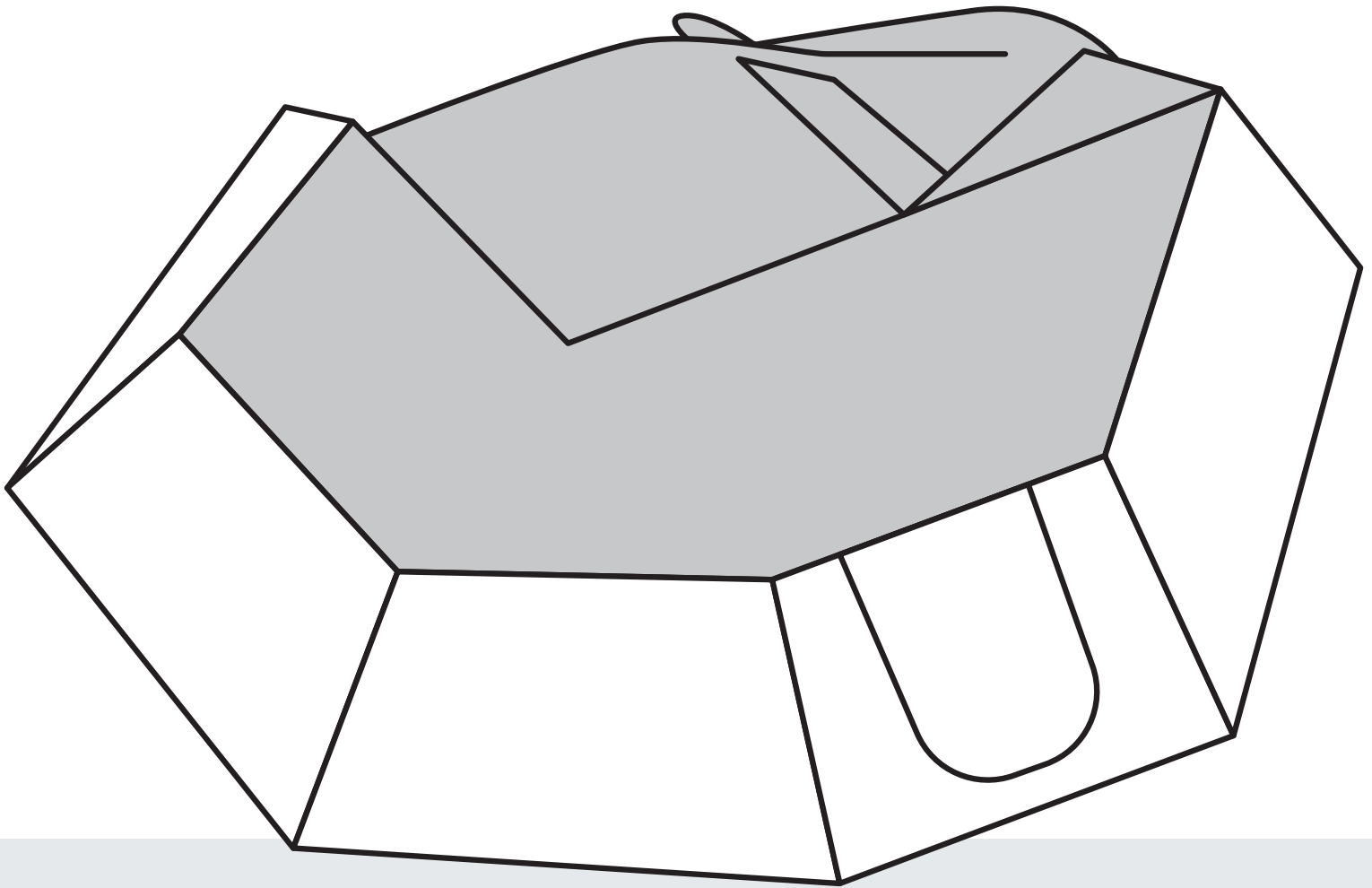

## Nomadic Awning Walls Instructions



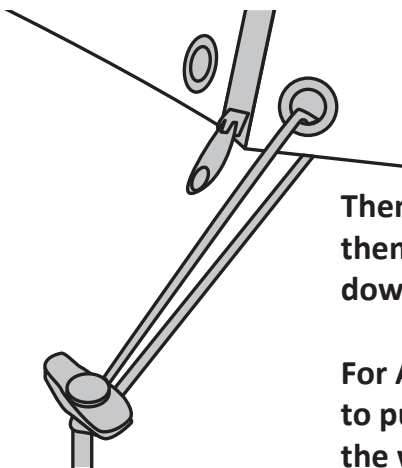
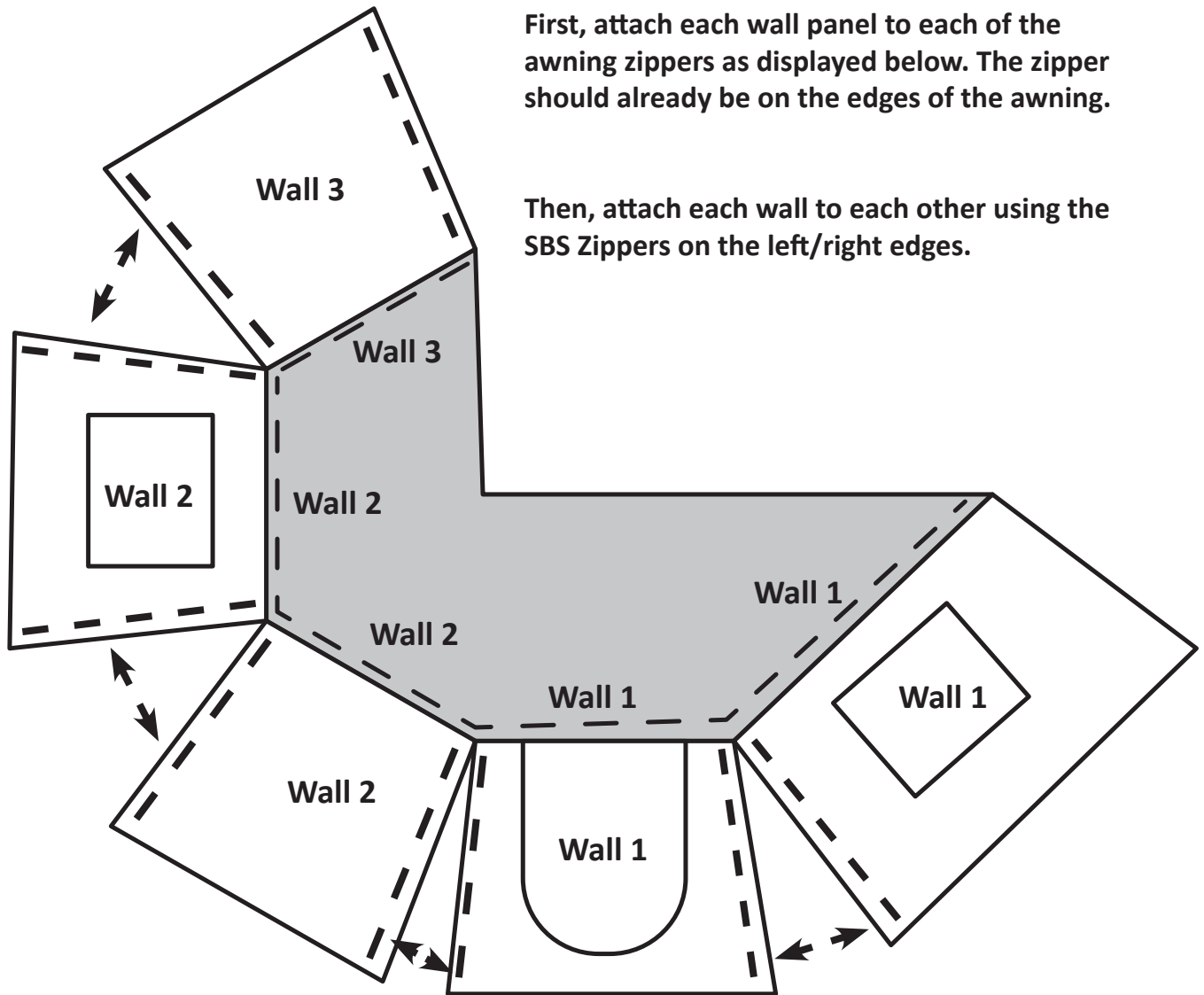
**CAREFULLY READ INSTRUCTIONS

## FULL-SIZE 270° ZIPPER INSTALLATION

1

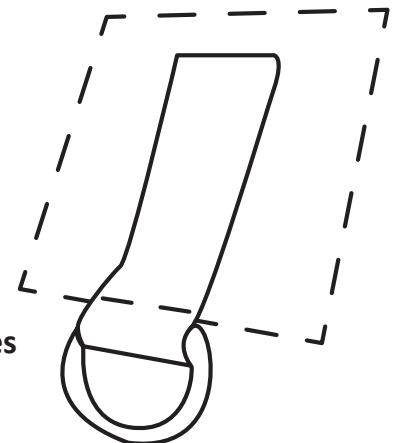
First, attach each wall panel to each of the awning zippers as displayed below. The zipper should already be on the edges of the awning.

Then, attach each wall to each other using the SBS Zippers on the left/right edges.



Then, use the provided ground stakes, insert them through the elastic bands, and mallet down on grass or dirt

For Added Internal Space, Use the Guide Lines to pull the loops located on the exterior of the walls and stake them down.



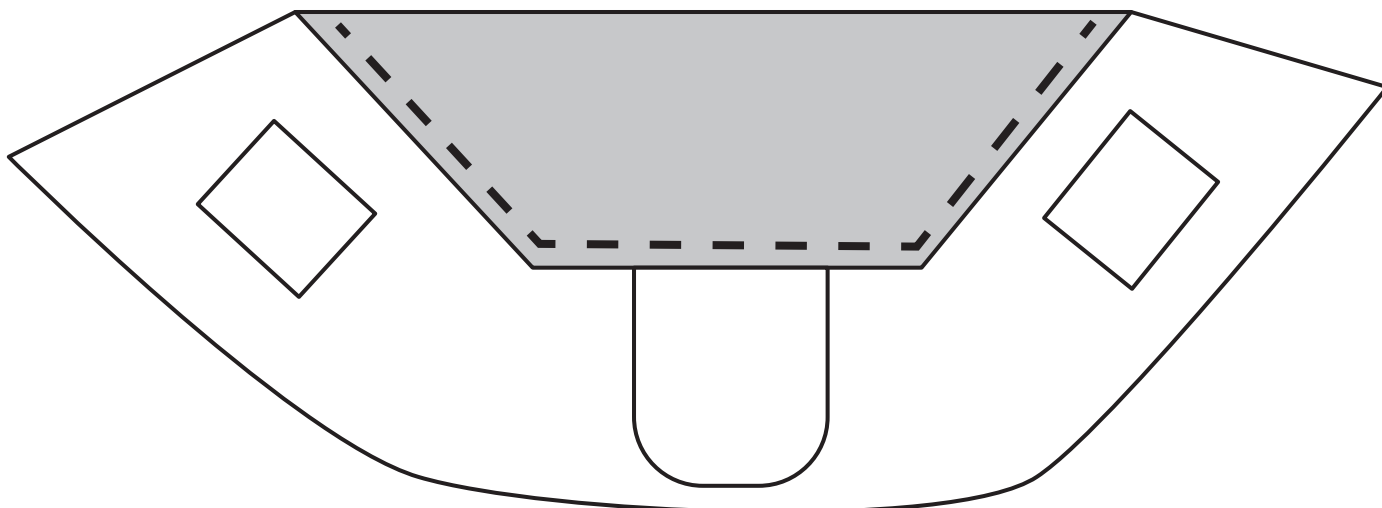

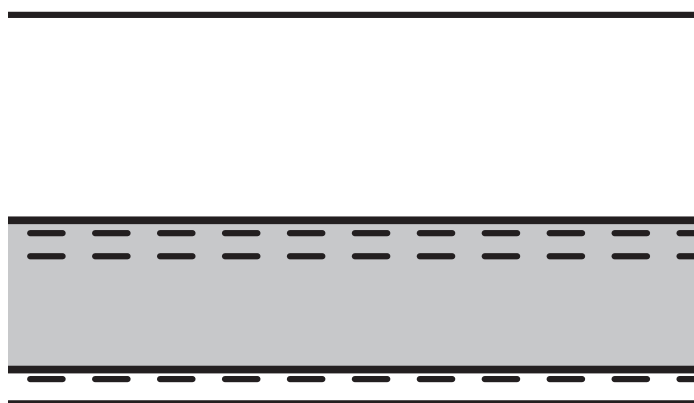
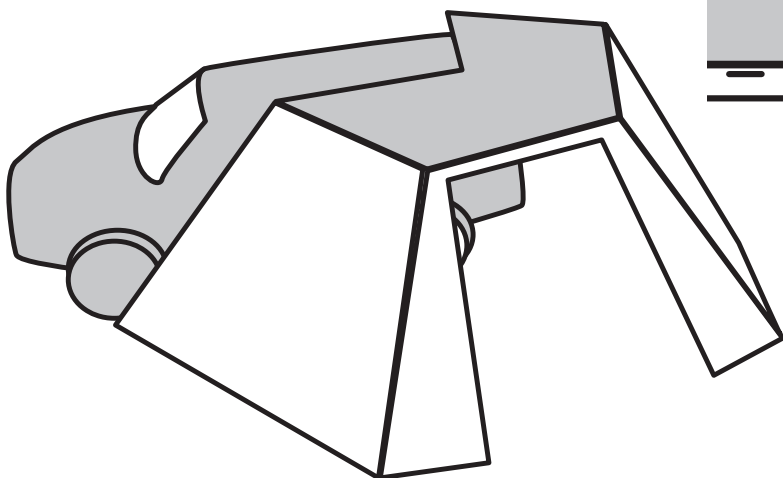
The 180° Awning Wall is a 1 Piece Strip that spans from both ends of the 180° Awning



## VELCRO INSTALLATION

The LTE Awnings have Velcro Attachments instead of the typical Zippers of the Full Size and LT Versions. Apply the same technique, but attach via Velcro Instead

### CLEANING

Clean with Cold Water and Soap with a Soft Sponge

## WARNINGS

- **DO NOT** use awning wall panels in high winds, severe storms, or extreme weather conditions.
- **ALWAYS** secure wall panels properly before use to prevent detachment or damage.
- **IMPROPER** installation may result in damage, injury, or product failure.
- **NEVER** leave awning wall panels unattended in windy conditions.
- **DISCONTINUE** use immediately if panels show signs of tearing, fraying, or structural damage.
- **DO NOT** exceed manufacturer-recommended wind or weather limits.
- **ENSURE** adequate ventilation when all wall panels are installed to prevent heat buildup or condensation.
- **KEEP CLEAR** of tension straps, poles, and attachment points during setup and takedown.
- **DO NOT** allow children to play in or around awning wall panels.
- **USE CAUTION** when entering or exiting to avoid tripping or entanglement.
- **DO NOT** modify wall panels or attachment hardware in any way.
- **CHECK** all fasteners and attachment points before each use.
- **REMOVE** wall panels immediately if wind speeds increase unexpectedly.
- **AVOID** open flames, heaters, or cooking devices near wall panels.
- **FAILURE** to follow these warnings may result in injury, damage, or voided warranty.
