

CLEANING CARE INSTRUCTIONS

You can vacuum your mattress with an upholstery attachment to help keep it clean, and we highly suggested that you do. A great time to do this is when changing your bedding before applying fresh sheets.

The cover is not removable and doing so will void the warranty. Laundering the cover in a washing machine may cause irreversible damage. Instead, we suggest you spot clean using one of the cleaning methods below:

Before applying any cleansers, soak up as much of the stain as possible with a clean and dry towel by gently blotting the affected area. Be careful not to rub or scrub as this will potentially spread the stain.

SWEAT

Mix together in a spray bottle:

8 ounces hydrogen peroxide 3 tablespoons baking soda

1 drop liquid dish soap

Spray lightly on stain, and let sit for 5-10 minutes. Blot away moisture with a clean, dry towel. Ensure memory foam is completely dry before covering with linens.

URINE

What you need:

Distilled white vinegar in a spray bottle Baking soda

Lightly spray the stain with vinegar and let it sit for 5 minutes. With a clean, dry towel, dab stain until as dry as possible. Next, sprinkle a layer of baking soda on the stain and let it sit overnight. Use vacuum upholstery attachment to extract baking soda from mattress.

BLOOD

Mix together:

Two parts cold water One part baking soda

Apply paste to the stain, and let it sit for 30 minutes. Next, gently dab into stain with a cool damp cloth. Once dry, vacuum any remaining residue with upholstery attachment.

VOMIT

What you need:

Baking soda Dish soap (one drop) Equal parts water/distilled white vinegar in a spray bottle

Sprinkle a layer of baking soda on the stain and let it sit overnight. Use vacuum attachment to extract baking soda from mattress. Lightly spray the stain with water/vinegar/dish soap mixture and blot stain until clean and dry.

SMELLS

What you need:

Baking soda Fabric freshener

Sprinkle baking soda over mattress and let it sit for 30 minutes to 1 hour. Vacuum up baking soda with upholstery attachment. If there is still an odor present, you can repeat the process and/or use fabric freshener

GENERAL MAINTENANCE

A waterproof mattress cover is recommended to help keep your mattress stain- and odor-free, and will minimize your need for potential stain removal.

Your mattress needs to be moisture-free before you cover with linens. To speed up this process a simple fan or hair dryer (on cool setting) can be used. You can also dry your mattress naturally by placing on a clean area outside.
