



# Guardian Urn Vault Instructions

FOR VAULTS: VHS-100 & VHS-101

Prior to sealing, clean any dust off the surface of the urn vault, especially on areas where the adhesive is to be applied.

A clean, dry surface ensures the best adhesion when sealing the urn vault.



## PARTS

Please check that you have the following parts:



URN VAULT BASE



URN VAULT LID



ADHESIVE



URN RISER  
(Optional)



CREMATION URN  
(Not Included)

## INSTRUCTIONS

**NOTE:** If a brass plate was purchased, you may affix it to the inside or outside of the urn vault in a location of your choice.

- 1 Place the filled cremation urn in the Guardian Urn Vault
- 2 Remove the cap from the tube of glue and carefully puncture the seal
- 3 For Guardian Urn Vaults **without** a riser:
  - Apply a continuous line of glue on the lip of the vault base
  - Place the lid on the vault base and press down firmly, ensuring you get an even seal. Allow to set for 10 minutes.

For Guardian Urn Vaults **with** a riser:

- Apply a continuous line of glue on the lip of the vault base
- Place the riser on the vault base and press down firmly, ensuring you get an even seal. Allow to set for 10 minutes.
- Apply a continuous line of glue on the lip of the riser
- Place the lid on top of the riser and press down firmly, ensuring you get an even seal. Allow to set for 10 minutes.
