Application Limits

These products are intended for use in general purpose compressed air systems only.

Installation

To perform at maximum efficiency, the filter with the automatic drain should be located as far as possible from the compressor and as near the equipment as possible. Be sure filter is mounted in pipe line vertically. Suitable means should be provided for the disposal of ejected scavenged material such as an open container or scavenger bucket. For SA602D, SA603D (External Auto Drains)

- 1. Depressurize Filter and remove Bowl.
- 2. Unscrew Drain Cock (turn counterclockwise) and discard.
- 3. Thread Stem of Auto Drain Assembly through Drain Cock opening in the bowl.
- 4. Drop Float over Stem inside Bowl.
- 5. Reassemble the Bowl with Auto Drain Assembly to Filter Body.

For SA602MD, SA605MD, SAF105MD, & SA702MD (Internal Auto Drains)

- 1. Depressurize Filter and remove Bowl.
- 2. Unscrew Drain Cock (turn counterclockwise) and discard.
- 3. Insert the entire Auto Drain in place of removed Drain Cock and tighten by hand.
- 5. Reassemble the Bowl with Auto Drain assembly to Filter Body.




Cleaning SA602D, SA603D

The Auto Drain may be flushed out manually by pressing the Push Button. If additional cleaning is indicated, depressurize and remove Auto Drain assembly from Filter Bowl. Remove Hex Nut at opposite Push Button and shake out Spring and Disc. Clean Disc and blow out Body with compressed air. When using compressed air to blow dry, be sure to wear appropriate eye protection. Replace parts, positioning them as shown making sure small end of Disc sets into brass shoulder of Diaphragm Assembly. (This can be checked through the 1/4" drain opening).

Cleaning SA602MD, SA605MD, SAF105MD, & SA702MD


The Auto Drain may be flushed out manually by rotating the Drain Cock clockwise. If additional cleaning is required, remove the Auto Drain Assembly from the Filter Bowl and clean Screen. Disassemble the Lever actuation mechanism by snapping Lever out of the plastic Retainer on Float and remove Pin. Remove Disc Assembly and the large Float. Carefully break away the interface fit between the black Plastic Housing and Brass Body. Remove the Piston and Spring. Clean all component parts thoroughly with soapy water or alcohol and clean or replace all seals as necessary. Insure that the small orifices in the Housing and Piston are not clogged. Lubricate "V" seals and then carefully reassemble all parts, positioning them as shown.


