# TABLE OF CONTENTS



**GROUNDCOVERS..... 1**  
Groundcover plants are low-growing with a spreading habit that covers a wide area.



**PERENNIALS ..... 5**  
Perennials are soft-stemmed plants that do not form woody branches. This category includes many flowering plants, grasses, ferns, and succulents.



**SHRUBS ..... 12**  
Shrubs are woody-stemmed plants that stay below 20 feet high. Most shrubs have a deeper root system and are longer-lived than perennials.



**TREES ..... 17**  
Trees are woody-stemmed plants with a single or multiple trunks that grow 15 feet and higher.



**VINES..... 20**  
Vines have long and flexible stems that climb to cover fences or walls, forming a living screen.

Plant performance is based on many factors, and it is important to plan around your site conditions. Plants generally perform best in their native climate, although taking advantage of your site's micro-climates can aid in plant performance. We have identified plants that prefer coastal or inland climates throughout this booklet.

These plants are better suited to grow in coastal climates, which have cooler overall temperatures and higher humidity, with wet winters and dry summers.



These plants are better suited for inland climates that often experience hot, dry summers with mild winter days and cold nights.

## Arctostaphylos 'Point Reyes'

Manzanita • evergreen shrub • 5-18" high x 8-10' wide • USDA zones 5-10

Spreading habit with trailing branches and red bark. Dark green leaves turn purple-red in winter. Clusters of pale pink flowers.



## Baccharis 'Pigeon Point'

Pigeon Point Dwarf Coyote Brush • evergreen shrub • 2-3' high x 9' wide • USDA zones 8-10

Dense and billowy light green bank cover. Small white flowers bloom in winter.



## Ceanothus hearstiorum

San Simeon Ceanothus • evergreen shrub • 6" high x 6-8' wide • USDA zones 8-10

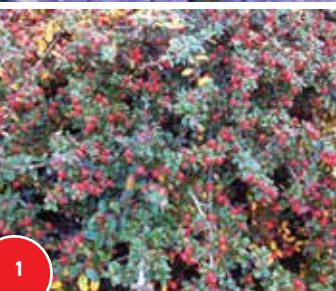
Very low growing with puckerd, medium green foliage. Fragrant, medium blue flower clusters in spring.



## Convolvulus mauritanicus

Ground Morning Glory • evergreen perennial • 1' high x 2-3' wide • USDA zones 7-10

Perennial with fuzzy, gray-green foliage. Funnel-shaped flowers display lavender-blue petals and white centers.



## Cotoneaster 'Lowfast'

Bearberry Cotoneaster • evergreen shrub • 1-2' high x 8-12' wide • USDA zones 5-8

Low, mounding shrub with trailing stems and small, dense, dark green leaves. Tiny white flowers followed by red berries.





### **Delosperma cooperi**

Hardy Ice Plant • succulent perennial • 3-6" high x 1-2' wide • USDA zones 5-11

Mat-forming succulent with fleshy, frosted green leaves. Bright magenta daisy-like flowers bloom from spring to fall.



### **Dymondia margaretae**

Silver Carpet • perennial • 2-3" high x 1-2' wide • USDA zones 9-11

Forms slow-spreading carpet of narrow green leaves with silver undersides. Yellow daisy-like flowers. Provide good drainage.



### **Echeveria imbricata**

Blue Rose Hens and Chicks • succulent perennial • 4-8" high x wide • USDA zones 9-11

Spreading rosettes of pale blue-green flushed with pink. Slender flower stalks carry bell-shaped flowers in red and yellow.



### **Epilobium 'Wayne's Silver'**

Wayne's Silver Humboldt County Fuchsia • semi-evergreen perennial • 6-12" high x 2-3' wide • USDA zones 8-11

Spreading mound of silver, felty leaves. Trumpet-shaped flowers in bright scarlet.



### **Erigeron 'Wayne Roderick'**

Wayne Roderick Seaside Daisy • evergreen perennial • 1' high x 2' wide • USDA zones 7-10

Deep gray-green leaves and lavender-pink flowers. Provide good drainage.





### **Grevillea 'Coastal Gem'**

Coastal Gem Woolly Grevillea • evergreen shrub • 1' high x 4-5' wide • USDA zones 9-11

Low and spreading with woolly, dense, gray-green leaves. Unusual clusters of pink and cream flowers.



### **Juniperus 'Wiltonii'**

Blue Carpet Juniper • evergreen conifer • 4-6" high x 6-8' wide • USDA zones 3-9

Dense, trailing branches and silvery-blue needle-like foliage that matures to scale-like. Produces catkin-like male cones, or berry-like female cones. Attracts birds.



### **Myoporum parvifolium**

Prostrate Myoporum • evergreen shrub • 3-6" high x 8-15' wide • USDA zones 9-10

Dense and low growing shrub with tiny, bright green leaves and white star-shaped flowers. Roots where stems touch soil. Suitable for erosion control.



### **Rosmarinus 'Huntington Carpet'**

Rosemary • evergreen shrub • 1-2' high x 4-8' wide • USDA zones 7-10

Dense, cascading groundcover with aromatic, needle-like leaves. Pale blue flowers. Maintains a dense center and does not become woody.



### **Rubus calycinoides 'Emerald Carpet'**

Creeping Raspberry • evergreen perennial • 1-2" high x 1-5' wide • USDA zones 7-9

Dense mat of rough, ruffled, rounded leaves. Small white flowers followed by edible orange berries that ripen in fall. Needs additional watering in inland conditions.



### **Satureja douglasii**

Yerba Buena • perennial • 6" high x 1-3' wide • USDA zones 7-10  
Forms a lush, flat carpet. Roots where stems touch soil. Small, pale purple to white flowers. Best in part shade; full shade inland where it is ephemeral.



### **Sedum 'Angelina'**

Angelina Stonecrop • succulent perennial • 3-6" high x 2-3' wide • USDA zones 3-11

Needle-like, yellow-green leaves are fleshy and closely set along the stems. Foliage turns orange in cooler weather.



### **Senecio mandraliscae**

Blue Chalk Sticks • succulent perennial • 1-2' high x 2-3' wide • USDA zones 9-11

Blue-green, pencil-like, fleshy leaves form a spreading groundcover. Small and ray-less off-white flowers.



### **Teucrium majoricum**

Fruity Germander • perennial • 4-6" high x 2-3' wide • USDA zones 5-10  
Low and spreading semi-woody shrub with aromatic, silvery green foliage. Whorls of small, lavender-purple flowers bloom in summer.



### **Thymus 'Elfin'**

Elfin Creeping Thyme • evergreen perennial • 1-2" high x 4-8" wide • USDA zones 4-8

Forms a slowly creeping groundcover. Aromatic, tiny green leaves. Purple flowers. Performs well between stepping stones or as a lawn substitute with light foot traffic.



## Achillea 'Moonshine'

Moonshine Common Yarrow • perennial • 2' high x wide •  
USDA zones 3-9

Ferny, gray-green, aromatic leaves. Flat-topped flower clusters in lemon yellow. Tolerant of drought, wind, and heat.



## Aeonium 'Zwartkop'

Black Rose Aeonium •  
succulent perennial • 3-4' high x 1-2'  
wide • USDA zones 9-11

Forms deep reddish-black spoon leafed rosettes at the tips of bare stems. Panicles of vibrant yellow flowers in summer.



## Agave 'Blue Glow'

Blue Glow Agave • succulent perennial  
• 1-2' high x 2-3' wide • USDA zones  
9-11

Rosettes of upward-arching, steely-blue leaves with serrated, scarlet margins. Mature plants produce tall flower stalks.



## Bouteloua 'Blonde Ambition'

Blue Grama Grass • perennial  
grass • 1-3' high x wide • USDA  
zones 3-10

Clump-forming grass with unique flower spikes that attach to stems at a 90° angle. Seed heads emerge chartreuse and mature to blonde.



## Bulbine 'Hallmark'

Orange Stalked Bulbine •  
succulent perennial • 12" high x 4-5'  
wide • USDA zones 9-11

Fleshy and gray-green, pencil-like leaves. Bright orange and yellow starry flower clusters.







### **Calandrinia spectabilis**

Rock Purslane • succulent perennial • 2-3' high x wide •  
USDA zones 8-10

Clumping growth habit. Fleshy, gray-green leaves.

Brilliant magenta flowers bloom year round atop tall, bare stalks.



### **Calylophus drummondianus**

Sundrops • perennial • 1' high x 2' wide •  
USDA zones 5-9

Showy groundcover with bright yellow, four-petaled flowers and fuzzy, gray-blue-green foliage. Attracts butterflies, hummingbirds, moths.



### **Carex tumulicola**

Foothill Sedge • evergreen perennial • 10-12" high x 1-2' wide • USDA zones 4-10

Roots spread to form wide, arching clumps of dark green, grass-like foliage. Spikes of small flower heads.



### **Dianella 'Cassa Blue'**

Cassa Blue Flax Lily • perennial • 1-2' high x wide • USDA zones 7-11

Evergreen clumps of strappy, blue-gray foliage. Loose clusters of dark blue, star-shaped flowers followed by lustrous blue fruits. Dwarf selection.



### **Diplacus (Mimulus) aurantiacus**

Sticky Monkey Flower • herbaceous perennial • 3-5' high x wide • USDA zones 7-10

Narrow, sticky, dark green leaves. Lobed, funnel-shaped flowers in golden orange. Summer dormant in hot and dry climates.





### **Echium fastuosum**

Pride of Madeira • evergreen shrub • 4-6' high x 6-10' wide •  
USDA zones 9-11

Soft-sowing shrub with whorled lance-shaped, gray-green, hairy foliage. Large stalks of small lavender-blue flowers attract pollinators.



### **Epilobium canum**

California Fuchsia • herbaceous perennial • 2' high x 4' wide •  
USDA zones 7-10

Herbaceous semi-evergreen shrub with mounding habit. Felty, gray-green foliage. Trumpet-shaped flowers in bright orange-red.



### **Eriogonum grande rubescens**

Red Buckwheat • woody perennial • 1-2' high x 2-3' wide •  
USDA zones 8-11

Spoon-shaped, gray-green foliage. Rounded clusters of red flowers mature to rusty pale pink.



### **Euphorbia characias ssp. wulfenii**

Wulf Spurge • evergreen perennial • 2-3' high x wide • USDA zones 7-10

Whorls of linear, blue-green leaves. Terminal clusters of lime-green bracts surround small yellow and burgundy flowers.



### **Festuca 'Elijah Blue'**

Elijah Blue Common Blue Fescue • perennial grass • 8-10" high x 1-2' wide •  
USDA zones 4-11

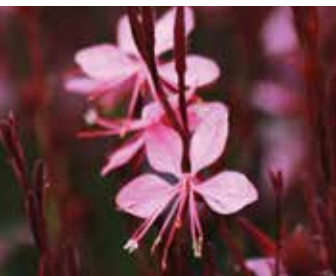
Fine-textured leaf blades in silvery blue. Flower heads age to amber-tan.



## **Festuca mairei**

Atlas Fescue • perennial grass • 2-3' high x wide • USDA zones 4-10

Forms a large fountain-like clump of fine textured yellow-gray leaf blades. Tall stems hold grayish green to amber flower heads.



## **Gaura 'Siskiyou Pink'**

Siskiyou Pink Gaura • perennial • 2-3' high x wide • USDA zones 5-9

Showy, tall and airy flowers in shades of maroon to pink. Narrow lance-shaped foliage is tinged with deep red.



## **Glandularia (Verbena) 'De La Mina'**

De La Mina Cedros Island Verbena • perennial • 3' high x wide • USDA zones 7-11

Bushy and mounding with finely divided bright green leaves. Clusters of lilac-purple flowers.



## **Helleborus argutifolius**

Corsican Hellebore • evergreen perennial • 2-3' high x wide • USDA zones 7-9

Bold, serrated, leathery blue-green leaves. Creamy green, nodding flowers bloom in winter. Dry shade.



## **Hesperaloe parviflora 'Brakelights'**

Brakelights Red Yucca • perennial • 1-2' high x wide • USDA zones 5-10

Perennial with stiff, gray-green leaves with thread-like fringe along margins. Branching inflorescences carry clusters of tubular, bright red flowers over a long season.







## Heuchera maxima

Island Alum Root • perennial • 2-3' high x wide •  
USDA zones 4-9

Loose mounds of round, lobed leaves in marbled dark green. Small pale pink flowers held on upright, wiry stems. Needs shade.



## Iris douglasiana

Douglas Iris • evergreen  
perennial • 2-4' high x wide •  
USDA zones 5-10

Clumps of narrow, strappy gray-green foliage. Slender stems carry beardless flowers in lavender-blue and white.



## Lavandula 'Hidcote Blue'

Hidcote Blue English Lavender •  
woody perennial • 1-2' high x wide •  
USDA zones 5-9

Compact mounded shrub is evergreen in mild winters. Aromatic, finely divided, gray-green foliage. Spikes of fragrant, deep violet flowers.



## Leymus 'Canyon Prince'

Canyon Prince Giant Wild Rye •  
perennial grass • 3-5' high x wide •  
USDA zones 7-10

Forms open, mounding clumps of coarse, silver-blue leaf blades. Tan flower spikes arise 1-2' above foliage. Spreads by rhizomes.



## Limonium perezii

Statice • perennial • 2-3' high  
x wide • USDA zones 10-11

Forms a rosette of large, bright green basal leaves. Airy flower clusters in white and purple are held above foliage. Ideal for seaside conditions.





## Lomandra 'Breeze'

Breeze Dwarf Mat Rush • evergreen perennial • 2-3' high x 3-4' wide  
• USDA zones 8-11

Grass-like perennial with arching green foliage forms a rounded clump. Yellow flower spikes. Tolerates seaside, inland, and drought conditions.



## Melica californica

California Melic Grass • perennial grass • 1-2' high x wide • USDA zones 6-10



Clumping, cool-season bunchgrass with bright green leaf blades. Spikes of silver, papery flower heads rise in summer.



## Monardella 'Russian River'

Russian River Coyote Mint • perennial • 12-18" high x wide • USDA zones 6-10



Forms a robust mound of grayish green, aromatic foliage. Pinkish-purple flowers are arranged in large, showy globes. Attracts butterflies, bees, and hummingbirds.



## Muhlenbergia rigens

Deer Grass • evergreen grass • 4-5' high x 3-4' wide • USDA zones 7-11



Dense, upright to arching fountain of fine-textured, gray-green leaf blades. From late summer through fall, slender flower stalks emerge light purple and age to honey-tan.



## Nepeta x faassenii

Catmint • perennial • 1-2' high x 2-3' wide • USDA zones 3-9

Forms a rounded mound of aromatic, soft, gray-green foliage. Loose upright clusters of lavender-blue flowers. Sterile hybrid.



## Penstemon 'Margarita BOP'



Margarita BOP Foothill Penstemon • herbaceous perennial • 1-2' high x 2-3' wide • USDA zones 6-10

Narrow and linear, blue-green foliage. Spikes of flared flowers fade from sky blue to purple.



## Polystichum munitum



Western Sword Fern • evergreen fern • 3-6' high x wide • USDA zones 5-9

Vigorous, clumping fern with upright to arching, leathery, dark green fronds. Needs shade. Well suited for coastal conditions.



## Salvia spathacea



Hummingbird Sage • herbaceous perennial • 1-2' high x 3-6' wide • USDA zones 8-10

Upright, spreading perennial with fuzzy, arrow-shaped, light green leaves. Flower spikes carry whorls of magenta-red flowers.



## Sedum 'Cape Blanco'



Cape Blanco Pacific Stonecrop • succulent perennial • 3" high x 12" wide • USDA zones 3-11

Forms a dense, trailing groundcover of chalky silver rosettes. Foliage tinges purple in cool weather. Cheery yellow flowers attract bees and butterflies.



## Teucrium chamaedrys

Wall Germander • semi-woody perennial • 8-12" high x 1-2' wide • USDA zones 5-10

Dense, upright, tidy form with dark green, aromatic foliage. Whorls of small, purple-pink flowers bloom in summer.



### Acacia 'Cousin Itt'

Cousin Itt Bower Wattle • evergreen shrub • 2-3' high x 4-6' wide • USDA zones 9-11

Low and mounding form with dense, linear, weeping foliage in bright green.



### Arctostaphylos 'Howard McMinn'

Howard McMinn Manzanita • evergreen shrub • 6-10' high x wide • USDA zones 7-10

Mounding shrub with sculptural, exfoliating, reddish branches and bright green leaves.

Clusters of pale pink flowers.



### Berberis (Mahonia) repens

Creeping Oregon Grape • evergreen shrub • 1-2' high x 3-4' wide • USDA zones 5-9

Low and spreading shrub with compound holly-like leaves. Spikes of bright yellow flowers followed by blue berries.



### Callistemon 'Little John'

Little John Dwarf Weeping Bottlebrush • evergreen shrub • 3-5' high x 4-6' wide • USDA zones 8-11

Dwarf shrub with dense branches covered in blue-green leaves. Red bristle-like flowers.



### Carpenteria californica

Bush Anemone • evergreen shrub • 5-7' high x 3-4' wide • USDA zones 8-10

Rounded, multi-branching, upright shrub with leathery, lance-shaped leaves. Fragrant white flowers with yellow stamens.







### **Ceanothus 'Valley Violet'**

Valley Violet California Lilac • evergreen shrub • 3-4' high x wide • USDA zones 8-10

Small, mounding shrub with leathery, gray-green leaves. Springtime brings a sea of fragrant, lavender-purple flowers. Beneficial to pollinators and local wildlife.



### **Cistus x purpureus**

Orchid Rockrose • evergreen shrub • 4-6' high x wide • USDA zones 8-10

Low-maintenance shrub with profuse blooms that open and drop daily. Bright pink, papery petals with dark burgundy spots. Narrow, gray-green, resinous foliage.



### **Correa 'Dusky Bells'**

Dusky Bells Australian Fuchsia • evergreen shrub • 1-2' high x 2-3' wide • USDA zones 9-10

Dense and low-growing. Downy, gray-green leaves. Drooping, tubular flowers in bright reddish pink.



### **Cotinus 'Royal Purple'**

Royal Purple Smoke Tree • deciduous shrub • 8-15' high x wide • USDA zones 4-8

Pinkish purple sprays of spent flowers create a smoke-like appearance in summer. Egg shaped leaves emerge wine red and mature to dark purple, then turn bright red and orange in fall.



### **Dodonaea viscosa 'Purpurea'**

Purple Leaved Hopseed Bush • evergreen shrub • 10-15' high x wide • USDA zones 8-11

Bronzy-green willow-like foliage turns burgundy-red in cooler weather. Small flowers followed by papery pink seed pods.





## Eremophila hygrophana

Blue Emu Bush • evergreen shrub • 2-3' high x 3-4' wide •  
USDA zones 8-11

Spreading mound of small, bright silvery-green leaves. Violet-blue, funnel shaped flowers from spring to winter attract birds and butterflies.



## Frangula (Rhamnus) 'Eve Case'

Eve Case Coffeeberry •  
evergreen shrub • 4-8' high  
x wide • USDA zones 7-10

Versatile shrub with dense, rounded habit and leathery green leaves. Large red to black berries.



## Frangula (Rhamnus) 'Leatherleaf'

Leatherleaf Coffeeberry •  
evergreen shrub • 5-8' high  
x wide • USDA zones 7-10

Forms a neat mound of dark green, leathery leaves. Small, white flowers are followed by reddish black berries in fall.



## Fremontodendron 'Ken Taylor'

Ken Taylor Hybrid Flannel Bush • evergreen shrub • 6' high x 8-12' wide • USDA zones 8-10

Upright to arching shrub has dark gray-green leaves with felty undersides. Bright yellow flowers in spring to summer.



## Grevillea 'Mt. Tamboritha'

Mt. Tamboritha Woolly Grevillea •  
evergreen shrub • 1-2' high x 3-4' wide • USDA zones 9-11

Low and spreading. Woolly, narrow, gray-green leaves densely set along the branches. Brush-like clusters of long and curved, pink and cream flowers.



## Heteromeles arbutifolia



Toyon • evergreen shrub • 10-15' high x 6-8' wide •  
USDA zones 7-10

Dark green and leathery, toothed leaves. Clusters of white flowers followed by small red berries in the fall and winter.



## Lantana 'Confetti'



Confetti Spreading Lantana •  
evergreen shrub • 2-3' high x 6-8' wide •  
USDA zones 9-11

Heat-loving and vigorous. Flower clusters in yellow, pink, and purple attract hummingbirds and bees from late spring to fall.



## Leucophyllum 'Heavenly Cloud'



Heavenly Cloud Texas Ranger •  
evergreen shrub • 5-8' high x  
wide • USDA zones 7-10

Small, medium green leaves and lavender colored flowers. Flowers bloom in abundance from spring into fall, and in greater numbers after a spike in humidity such as rainfall.



## Olea 'Little Ollie'

Little Ollie Dwarf Olive • evergreen  
shrub • 4-6' high x wide • USDA zones  
8-11

Excellent low hedge with narrow, gray-green foliage with silvery undersides. Rarely produces pollen or fruit.



## Ribes speciosum



Fuchsia-flowered Gooseberry •  
deciduous shrub • 4-6' high x wide  
• USDA zones 6-10

Arching, sharply thorned branches lined with lobed, glossy deep green leaves. Red, drooping fuchsia-like flowers emerge in early spring. Attracts birds and hummingbirds.



## Ribes viburnifolium



Evergreen Currant • evergreen shrub •  
3-4' high x 4-6' wide • USDA zones 6-10

Sprawling, spreading shrub with aromatic, glossy green leaves. Clusters of deep red flowers in spring followed by summer berries.



## Rosmarinus 'Ken Taylor'

Ken Taylor Rosemary • evergreen shrub • 1-3' wide x 4-6' wide • USDA zones 8-11

Low-growing, sprawling habit with aromatic, needle-like, gray-green leaves. Tiny, dark blue flowers.



## Teucrium 'Azureum'

Azureum Bush Germander • semi-woody evergreen shrub • 3-4' high x wide • USDA zones 8-10

Upright, bushy growth habit with silvery green, aromatic foliage. Bright purple-blue flowers.



## Vitex agnus-castus



Chaste Tree • deciduous shrub • 8-15' high x wide • USDA zones 6-11

Rounded to vase-shaped habit with aromatic, gray-green palmate leaves, and large spikes of fragrant purple flowers. Blooms are followed by small, dark berries.



## Westringia 'Morning Light'



Morning Light Coast Rosemary • evergreen shrub • 3-4' high x 4-5' wide • USDA zones 9-10

Forms a compact mound with linear, gray-green and white variegated foliage. Small white star-shaped flowers.



## Acca (Feijoa) sellowiana

Pineapple Guava • evergreen tree • 15'+ high x wide •  
USDA zones 8-10

Fruiting shrub that produces edible blue-green, egg shaped fruits. Dark green leaves with felty white undersides and attractive, purple-white flowers with showy red stamens attract bees.



## Arbutus x 'Marina'

Marina Strawberry Tree •  
evergreen tree • 25-40' high x wide •  
USDA zones 7-9



Broad, dense crown with leathery, dark green leaves. Clusters of pink flowers followed by bright orange-red fruits. Exfoliating reddish bark.



## Cedrus deodara

Deodar Cedar • evergreen conifer •  
40-80' high x 20-40' wide • USDA  
zones 7-9

Conifer with a fast, tall, pyramidal growth habit. Horizontal branches display upright cones and gray-green needles.



## Cercidium x 'Desert Museum'

Desert Museum Palo Verde •  
deciduous tree • 20-25' high x wide •  
USDA zones 6-9

Open and airy, vase-shaped form with bright green trunk and branches. Small, oval leaflets and profuse yellow flowers. Less seedpod litter than other Cercidium. Thornless.



## Cercis occidentalis

Western Redbud • deciduous  
tree • 10-18' high x wide •  
USDA zones 6-9



Bright pink flowers bloom on bare branches in early spring, followed by broad, heart-shaped leaves.





### Chitalpa 'Pink Dawn'

Pink Dawn Chitalpa • deciduous tree • 20-30' high x wide • USDA zones 6-8

Fast-growing hybrid tree with frilly pink trumpet-shaped flowers. Bright green linear leaves. Slender trunk with chestnut brown bark.



### Geijera parviflora

Australian Willow • evergreen tree • 30' high x 20' wide • USDA zones 9-11

Graceful and weeping form with narrow, silvery-green, willow-like leaves. Tiny clusters of white and yellow flowers.



### Lagerstroemia 'Tuscarora'

Tuscarora Crape Myrtle • deciduous tree • 20-25' high x 12-15' wide • USDA zones 6-9

Upright, open branching tree with bright rosy-pink flower clusters. Oval green leaves turn red-orange in fall. Bark exfoliates with age. Mildew resistant hybrid.



### Olea europaea 'Swan Hill'

Swan Hill Olives® Tree • evergreen tree • 20-30' high x wide • USDA zones 8-10

Grafted evergreen tree with gray-green foliage and light gray bark that becomes gnarled with age. Certified fruitless variety, rarely produces pollen or fruit.



### Pistacia x 'Red Push'

Red Push Pistache • deciduous tree • 25-40' high x 20'-30' wide • USDA zones 7-9

Divided leaflets emerge red, mature to deep green, then turn yellow-orange-red in fall. Semi-evergreen in mild climates.



## Pomegranate 'Wonderful'

Wonderful Pomegranate • deciduous fruit tree • 8-20' high x wide • USDA zones 7-10

Arching branches with narrow, glossy leaves. Showy orange-red blossoms followed by shiny red fruit with tasty edible seeds.



## Quercus agrifolia

Coast Live Oak • evergreen tree • 20-70' high x wide • USDA zones 8-10

Broad and dense crown with thick, leathery, dark green leaves. Bark becomes furrowed and dark gray with age.



## Robinia 'Purple Robe'

Black Locust • deciduous tree • 30-40' high x 20-30' wide • USDA zones 5-10

Upright, oval habit with blue-green compound leaves. Fragrant clusters of dark violet, sweet pea-like flowers in late spring.



## Schinus molle

California Pepper Tree • evergreen tree • 25-40' high x wide • USDA zones 8-11

Broad crown with weeping branches and a gnarled trunk. Bright green compound leaves. Red berry clusters. May become invasive under certain conditions.



## Searsia (Rhus) lancea

African Sumac • evergreen tree • 20-30' high x 20-35' wide • USDA zones 9-11

Spreading, umbrella crown with reddish brown, fissured bark. Arching branches and weeping, dark green, willow-like foliage.



## Bougainvillea 'San Diego Red'

Bougainvillea • evergreen vine • climbs 15-30' • USDA zones 10-11  
Shrubby vine displays flower clusters with vibrant, deep red bracts. Medium green leaves are oval to heart-shaped.



## Campsis radicans

Trumpet vine • deciduous vine • climbs 40' • USDA zones 4-9

Vigorous grower with lush green foliage. Clusters of orange-red, trumpet-shaped flowers followed by slender seed pods.



## Hardenbergia 'Happy Wanderer'

Happy Wanderer Purple Lilac Vine • evergreen vine • climbs 10-15' • USDA zones 9-11

Pendulous clusters of purple flowers resemble small Wisteria blooms. Narrow, dark green foliage.



## Lonicera vacillans

Pink Honeysuckle • semi-evergreen • climbs 5-10' • USDA zones 7-10

Vine-like habit with mid-green foliage and clusters of tubular pink flowers. Forms a loose groundcover or may be trained on a structure.



## Vitis x 'Roger's Red'

Roger's Red Grape • deciduous vine • climbs 15-40' • USDA zones 8-10

Vigorous vine with climbing tendrils. Broad green leaves turn bright red in the fall. Small edible fruit.
