The 29 CFR 1910.1200 has been updated to align with the UN Globally Harmonized System of Classification and Labeling of Chemicals (GHS), Revision 3, issued in the Federal Register, March 26, 2012. This rule became effective May 25, 2012.

This document is to certify that the product you have purchased is a “drug” to which the revised hazard communication requirement of 1910.1200 (a) and (b) do not apply, as specifically stated in 1910.1200(b)(6)(vii).

Accordingly, no safety data sheets (SDS) exist for drugs.
