Khaki Pants and Shorts: No exterior or cargo-style pockets.

Socks: All socks must be ankle height or higher. Knee socks must be worn with girl's winter jumper or skirt

Belts: Belts must be leather or artificial leather. No fabric belts permitted.

Dress Shoes: Dress shoes must be brown, black or navy leather (or artificial leather) and should be sturdy enough for the student to Loafer and boat shoes are permitted. No high heels, no patent leather, no ballet flats, no sneakers, no boots, no canvas shoes participate in recess. Mary Jane-style shoes or lace up shoes are suggested for girls. Lace-up oxford-style shoes are suggested for boys.

White Sneakers: Sneakers must be white, blue, and/or gray. Limited additional colors are permitted, such as a small logo.

**Appearance**: All uniform apparel should fit properly and be neat and clean.
