

Gentlemen (K-12)

Pants/Shorts

- Belts must be worn (grades 7-12)
- Pants/shorts must fit properly and worn near the waist
- Pants/shorts must be purchased from Flynn-O'Hara

Shirts

- Uniform collared shirts (purchased from an approved vendor) are required to be worn during the academic day on Monday through Thursday.
- An FACS-approved t-shirt may be worn on Fridays only

Jackets/Coats

- Approved FACS jackets, sweaters, hoodies, and sweatshirts may be worn inside the building and to class.
- No other designer or athletic logos are allowed to be worn inside the building and to class.
- A uniform collared shirt MUST BE WORN under all outerwear.
- Non-branded outerwear (for the purpose of being outside) may be worn to and from buildings, at recess, and/or with administrative approval.

Shoes

- Permitted shoes include dress shoes, loafers, athletic sneaker, and/or boots
- Shoes must be closed- toed and have backs which cover the heel of the foot.
- No Crocs, foam sneakers, clogs, flip-flops, sandals, houseshoes/slippers,
- Chacos or beachwear are NOT allowed.
- Shoes must be worn at all times.

Hair

- Hair must be above the eyebrows and above the collar.
- Ears must not be covered by hair and must be able to be seen.
- Hair must be a natural color. Extreme colors are not permitted (i.e. blue, green, pink, unnatural red, purple, etc.)
- Hair must be clean and neatly groomed at all times.
- Facial hair must be neatly trimmed and clean.

Jewelry/Body Art, Make-Up

- Ear, facial, or body piercings are NOT permitted.
- Gauges are NOT permitted.
- No inappropriate tattoos are allowed. Facial tattoos are not permitted.
- Gentlemen are not permitted to wear make-up or face paint of any kind.

Hats

• Hats, headbands, du-rags, bandanas, wave caps, bonnets, or other head coverings are not permitted, this includes the hood part of a hoodie sweatshirt.



Ladies (K-12)

Skirts/Jumpers

- School uniform skirts, skorts, and jumpers (plaid) (no more than 3" above the knees when standing.)
 - See Flynn-O'Hara apparel for available options.
- Skirts may not be rolled at the waist to shorten the hem.
- Elementary students (K-6) are permitted to wear uniform shorts from Flynn-O'Hara.
- Secondary students (7-12) are not permitted to wear uniform shorts.

Leggings/Tights/Shorts

- Girls MUST wear **black** mid-calf / full leggings, or shorts, under their skirts/jumpers.
- No pajama or sweat pants under skirts

Slacks

- All slacks should fit properly and must be worn near the waist.
- See Flynn-O'Hara apparel for available options.

Blouses/Shirts/Sweaters

- A collared uniform shirt (from an approved vendor) is required to be worn on Mondays through Thursdays.
- Any FACS-issued spirit shirt may be worn on Fridays.
- Any FACS-issued sweatshirt may be worn over a uniform shirt.

Jackets/Coats

- Approved FACS jackets, sweaters, hoodies, and sweatshirts may be worn inside the building and to class.
- No other designer or athletic logos are allowed to be worn inside the building and to class.
- A uniform collared shirt MUST BE WORN under all outerwear.
- Non-branded outerwear (for the purpose of being outside) may be worn to and from buildings, at recess, and/or with administrative approval.

Shoes

- Permitted shoes include dress shoes, saddle oxfords, loafers, athletic sneakers, and/or boots

Hair

- Hair must be a natural color. Extreme bright colors are not permitted (i.e. blue, green, pink, unnatural red, purple, etc.)
- Hair must be clean, and neat at all times.
- Extreme bright colors at the end of hair or in braids are not permitted.
- Tinsel, feathers, and/or hair wraps are not permitted in hair.

FACS

Jewelry/Body Art

- No inappropriate tattoos. Facial tattoos are not permitted.
- Nose, facial, and body piercing is not permitted.
- Ears should have a limited number of earrings.
- Gauges in the ears are not permitted

Make-up

- In grades PreK 6th grade, make-up is NOT permitted to be worn during the school day.
- In grades 7-12, make-up must be in good taste.
 - Extreme colors are not permitted.
 - Shapes or other artwork are not permitted on the face.
 - Visible stickers are not permitted on the face.
 - Administration reserves the right to determine if make-up is in good taste.



PE Dress Code (Grades 7-9)

Students (Boys/Girls) must dress in FACS approved PE shorts/shirts.

- FACS team sports attire is not allowed for PE classes.
- PE uniforms must be obtained from an approved FACS vendor.
- Students must not deviate from available options from the vendor no items bought from non-approved FACS vendors (t-shirt, shorts).



Preschool Dress Code (PreK-JrK)

Shirts (boys / girls)

- Any short-sleeved or long-sleeved shirt is permitted (see special dress below for items that are not allowed)
- Shirts do not need to be tucked in
- No sleeveless shirts, including spaghetti straps, tank tops, etc.

Shorts / Slacks (boys / girls)

- Shorts and slacks should fit appropriately
- Students should be able to easily work any buttons or zippers on shorts or slacks
- Belts are not required
- Sweatpants or athletic pants ARE permitted for PreK and JrK students only

Dresses (girls only)

- Dresses should be worn with shorts underneath
- No tank dresses or sundresses

Shoes

- Permitted shoes include dress shoes, saddle oxfords, loafers, athletic sneakers, and/or boots
- Shoes must be closed- toed and have backs which cover the heel of the foot.
- No Crocs, foam sneakers, clogs, flip-flops, sandals, houseshoes/slippers,
- Chacos or beachwear are NOT allowed.
- Shoes must be worn at all times.

Hair

- Hair must be a natural color. Extreme bright colors are not permitted (i.e. blue, green, pink, unnatural red, purple, etc.)
- Hair must be clean, and neat at all times.
- Extreme bright colors at the end of hair or in braids are not permitted.
- Tinsel, feathers, and/or hair wraps are not permitted in hair.

Jewelry/Body Art (boys / girls)

- Nose, facial, and body piercing is not permitted.
- Ears may have no more than two (2) earrings per ear.
- Gauges in the ears are not permitted

Make-up (boys / girls)

• In grades PreK - 6th grade, make-up is NOT permitted to be worn during the school day.
