Must be worn at all times and be visible.

Note: The lanyard with ID is required as a part of the uniform. It is distributed at registration and collected at the conclusion of the last spring exam.



Rules of Appropriate Dress

Students should be well-groomed at all times, which will positively affect behavior.

- 1. Uniforms are to be clean, pressed, and in good repair.
- 2. Uniforms and personal property should be clearly labeled, especially the blazer.
- 3. The skirt or dress should be hemmed no shorter than 3 inches above the knee.
- 4. Shoes should be clean and in good condition, or replaced.
- 5. Students are not allowed to walk on the backs of their shoes.
- 6. Shoelaces must be tied.
- 7. Students with a doctor's note filed with the Dean may be allowed to wear gray or white athletic shoes with white shoelaces (no high tops or converse).
- 8. Students are not allowed to wear pajama pants or sweatpants under their uniform, even during the cold weather months between arrival of school and 3:30 p.m dismissal.
- 9. Students will be notified of appropriate dress for field trips.
- 10. Students must wear blazers with the uniform to all Masses and to any other event that is so designated by the Dean of the Upper School. Furthermore, students must wear blazers when they walk up to take communion. **No outerwear** is to be worn under the blazer.
- 11. No outerwear, jackets, sweatshirts, or rain gear are to be worn around shoulders or tied across the front of the chest or the waist.
- 12. School uniforms must be buttoned at all times, and the waistband should not be rolled.
- 13. An SAA approved shirt must be worn under an SAA approved sweatshirt.

The "out of uniform" uniform is required attire for all casual events designated by the Dean where the traditional school day uniform is not required.

- 14. When students are out of uniform on specially designated days, there are rules of modesty that must be followed.
 - a. No article of clothing may be too tight, too short, or too revealing.
 - b. No bare midriffs.
 - c. No shorts unless it is a special event, such as Field Day. P.E. uniform shorts are required for Field Day.
 - d. No rompers for church events (jumpsuits [pant length] acceptable).
 - e. No pajamas or pajama pants.
 - f. No tank tops, crop tops, or tube tops.
 - g. No spaghetti straps unless with a cover up or shrug.
 - h. The "out of uniform" uniform includes the following:
 - · Jeans (no ripped, distressed, or washed out)

- · SAA t-shirt
- · Socks (must show)
- · Lanyard must be visible
- · Tennis shoes
- · St. Agnes outerwear
- Approved St. Agnes yoga pants sold by Key Club (when specifically allowed)
- 15. Students will be allowed to wear their team athletic shirt and/or outerwear on game days.

Athletic Attire

- · St. Agnes team shirt and/or sweatshirt (depending on the weather) with
- St. Agnes uniform
- 16. Guidelines for appropriate and tasteful dress for ceremonies, dances, field trips, and class events:
 - · Nothing too short, nothing too tight, and nothing too revealing.
 - · No more than 3 inches above the knee
 - · Chest covered

Rules of Appropriate Grooming

- 1. Hair
 - a. A student's hair should be neat and simply styled.
 - b. Hair color or style should not be a source of distraction as determined by the Dean, i.e. no trending hair colors, such as pink, orange, green, blue, purple, etc.
 - c. A student may not wear faddish hair accessories such as oversized headbands, bandanas, ear warmers, or hats.
- 1. Jewelry
 - a. Students are not permitted to wear excessive or faddish jewelry.
 - b. Students are only allowed to wear
 - 1) one ring on each hand
 - 2) a watch (no smart watches, and/or Fitbits)
 - 3) a simple chain necklace nothing faddish or bulky.
 - 4) Earrings should be restricted to the earlobe area only no cartilage piercing, no earring bars, no gauges.
 - c. No other jewelry will be permitted.
 - 2. Facial and body piercings and tattoos are forbidden, as is any body painting.
 - 3. Students are not allowed to write or mark on themselves.
 - 4. Students are not allowed to wear tongue bars or any type of pierced tongue jewelry.
 - 5. Blazer lapel pins must be in good taste as deemed by the dean.

Shorts:	 Khaki shorts are permitted as part of the dress uniform for K-6 but need to be worn with a white dress shirt for grades K-6 Khaki shorts w/ belt for grades 3-6 required Students have the option of wearing the pull-on pants until the end of 2nd grade, belts are not required with pull-on pants
Pants:	 Khaki pants w/ belt for grades 3-6 required Students have the option of wearing the pull-on pants until the end of 2nd grade, belts are not required with pull-on pants
Tie or Bowtie:	Purple with a gold stripe from Flynn O'Hara
Socks:	 Visible white or black socks w/ minimal logos. Students are encouraged to purchase the SDS spirit socks from the Spirit Shop. Neon colored socks are not allowed
Belt:	 Brown, black, or cordovan leather belt w/ minimal logos Fabric SDS logo belt (the boys love the fabric SDS logo belt from the Spirit Shop and is a good alternative to the SEC college belts)

General Guidelines for Student Appearance

St. Dominic School for Boys teaches its students the importance of maintaining an appropriate appearance and decorum for certain activities. The School reserves the right to determine the appropriateness of any dress or student appearance at school or at all school events on campus or not.

Hair and Headwear

- Hair should be above the collar, above the ears and eyes, and be generally neat
- Traditional styles only; no fads or embellishments
- Boys must be clean-shaven with sideburns no longer than the earlobe
- Students may not wear head coverings such as caps, hats, headbands, scarves, or bandanas.

Jewelry and Watches

- One bracelet **OR** one watch is allowed
- Smartwatches with cellular capabilities (e.g. Apple Watch) are not permitted at school
- We suggest having your son wear an analog watch to practice telling time the traditional way

Shirt Tails and Waistbands

- Shirts must be worn tucked in at all times
- Please purchase shirts long enough for your student to keep them tucked in at all times
- The top of the waistband on pants must be no lower than the top of the hipbone

Kindergarten-6th Grade

Outerwear

- Students may wear only dress code approved outerwear items inside all of the SAA-SDS school buildings
- Students may wear non-dress code outerwear clothing outside the buildings to manage cold temperatures and must be removed once inside all of the SAA-SDS school buildings

Undershirts

- Only <u>solid</u> white short-sleeved undershirts may be worn beneath the white dress uniform shirts
- Only white short or long-sleeved undershirts maybe we wore beneath the purple SDS logo uniform shirts

Casual Days

- Students will be notified of special occasions designated as "Casual Days" on which the student has the option not to wear the School uniform. Typically, spirit weeks are occasions for casual days.
- Other special occasions will give students the opportunity to wear special clothes that are related to specific themes. The specific options will be given to students on those occasions. These days are not casual-dress days, and students who do not choose to wear the thematic clothing must wear the School uniform. The administration reserves the right to determine any item inappropriate for school.
- At no time may students wear the following items:
 - o Open-toed shoes, sandals, boots, house slippers

MISCELLANEOUS:

- 1. Undergarments: Bras must be white/neutral so that they do not show through the uniform
- 2. Shorts that do not show through the uniform must be worn under the uniform.
- 3. A PLAIN, WHITE t-shirt or camisole may be worn under the uniform shirt. T-shirt sleeves must be completely covered by the uniform shirt.
- 4. **Saddle Oxford shoes are required.** This American Podiatric Medical Association approved <u>saddle oxford option</u> is available up to women's size 6. This <u>all-white leather sneaker</u> is available in larger women's sizes and approved for those with a medical note filed with the dean, indicating a more supportive shoe is necessary.

JEWELRY:

Jewelry is to be limited to the following:

- 1. a watch (no smartwatches)
- 2. a ring
- 3. a simple chain necklace with a cross or other religious symbol
- 4. a pair of post earrings worn in the lobe

MAKEUP:

- 1. Makeup is not permitted in grades 1-7.
- 2. Students in <u>Grade 8 only</u> may wear a light foundation and light or natural nail polish. Nails must be short, natural shapes, no jewels or nail art. Eye makeup is not permitted in any grade.
- 3. Hair color must be natural; no bright colors or tinsel.
