## Daily Uniform

Students are expected to wear their uniform properly at all times on campus. Students will not be allowed in class if they are not wearing the correct uniform. The daily Saint Gertrude uniform is as follows:

- Plaid skirt, no shorter than three inches (front and back) from the bend in the back of the knee.
- Solid forest green SGHS monogrammed polo shirt, long or short sleeves, purchased from Flynn O'Hara only.
- All non-uniform items must be taken off as soon as the student arrives to campus. Hats may not be worn during school hours. Pajama pants and sweatpants may not be worn on campus under or instead of a school kilt. Non-uniform sweatshirts may not be worn on campus.
- White, oxford cloth button down front and button down collar blouse; long or short sleeves; worn only with solid white or skin-tone undergarments; no ruffles, lace, or monogram; no oversized shirts; blouses must be tucked into the kilt at all times on campus.
- Long-sleeved white turtlenecks may be worn alone, under long-sleeved blouse or with sweater; worn only with solid white or skin-tone undergarments. <u>Turtleneck must be tucked into the skirt</u>.
- Socks must match the color of the shoe worn. Solid black socks must be worn with black shoes and, for seniors, solid white socks must be worn with white tennis shoes. Crew socks may be folded but the ankle must be covered. Small logos on socks are acceptable.
- Solid black tights/leggings without a flare are acceptable.
- Solid Forest Green SGHS monogrammed cardigan, crew-neck sweater, fleece jacket (full or quarter zip), or sweatshirt (quarter zip) purchased from Flynn O'Hara only, worn over the school polo, blouse, or turtleneck.
- Solid black jacket or coat; when in uniform on campus, only black jackets or coats may be worn. These may not be worn in the classroom after Morning Gathering, but may be brought into classrooms if necessary.
- Solid, enclosed non-athletic black shoes with black or tan soles only; heel or wedge may not be greater than one inch; shoes must be worn with socks or tights/leggings; no duck shoes; no moccasins; no tassels; no boots (shoes

above the ankle); shoes with laces must be tied, and shoes may not be worn with backs folded down.

 As a senior privilege, seniors may wear solid white socks and tennis shoes on non-Mass days from August until October 31 and again after Easter vacation until the end of school with the approval of the Head of School. This privilege may be extended upon request from the Senior Class President. White shoes may not be worn with white shirts and blazers.

We strongly suggest names be tacked inside blazers, sweaters, fleece jackets and black coats in case they are misplaced

## **Dress Uniform**

The **dress uniform** includes green blazer, kilt, uniform white shirt, stockings and black enclosed dress shoes that are no higher than one inch heel. The dress uniform, along with white gloves (available for purchase through school in the spring) is the required attire for Song Contest.

The blazer will be worn at all Liturgies, assemblies, and special occasions. Only white button down shirts or turtleneck shirts may be worn with blazers, and they are to be tucked into the skirt.
