This color-neutral chair is manufactured in aluminum that seamlessly flows from top to bottom. The classic profile of its oval back connects to a slim, perfectly molded seat that is supported by sleek yet sturdy legs.

The chair's pure industrial aesthetic is complemented by the skillful use of aluminum. The choice to use aluminum as the primary material is driven by the appeal of its lightness, comfort, and durability. Tasca's aesthetic and smooth finish blend seamlessly with warm and earthy tones where materials such as wood, timber, clay, soil, and granite play a central role.

Unlike any other furniture made of steel or iron, the chair does not rust, but gracefully ages. With its distinctive silvery look, the Tasca makes a very versatile piece, perfect for every space, creating a fine location to enjoy a moment of peace in which time flies imperceptibly.
