inspiro has a unique shade guide system which is both simple and effective to select color in a straight forward two steps approach.

If the combined dentin & enamel shades selected do match the patient's natural teeth no surprise, you'll get the color right!





Practically, shade samples are being used first separately; dentin is placed next to the collar of the reference tooth to choose the appropriate dentin chroma and then, enamel is selected simply visually according to its tone and brightness. Finally, shades samples are being combined with a drop of glycerine in-between them to allow optimal light transmission and shade rendering.
