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

Note: These door stay reinforcements are designed for use with the later door stays that have integrated nuts. Early door stays have integrated studs that are too short, so stays require modification to use this kit.

- 1.) If you have removable door speakers, install can be done be removing the speaker and working through the speaker hole. If you do not have door speakers, the first step will be to remove the door cards.
- 2.) Remove the door stay pin. Note: Once Pin has be removed, use care to ensure that the door does not swing open too far.
- 3.) Working on the hinge end of the door, loosen the two screws the hold the door stay in place. Reach inside the door to catch the door stay as you remove the screws.
- 4.) If the door stay area of the door has been bent or ripped, now is the time to repair it.
- 5.) Using the supplied grease, lubricate the door stay while it's out of the car.
- 6.) Reinstall door stay along with your new door stay reinforcement as shown in the diagram below.
- 7.) Reinstall door stay pin and speaker and/or door card.



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
