

Screw-in Folding Tow Hook REV2

Step 1.

Assemble the tow hook assembly as shown in Photo 1. Note: For high vibration environments, we recommend dressing the 3/8" bolt with red loctite. ** Note: In a small number of applications, it may be necessary to install the screw into the bumper first, and then fasten the loop as described above.



Parts List

- (1) 3/8-16 2" S/S button head bolt MC92949A633
- (5) Nylon Spacers MC90295A200 *Not included with all kits*
- (2) Nylon Washer MC95606A150
- (1) Buna n Rubber O'ring MC9452K387
- (1) Tow Hook
- (1) Threaded Bumper Insert
- (1) Tow Sticker
- (1) Rubber Bumper MC95495K121



Step 2.

Screw the assembly into bumper until the threads bottom out. If the loop contacts your bumper before the screw bottoms out, you will need to remove the assembly and add some of the supplied spacers. Repeat until you have adequate clearance between the loop and bumper cover with the assembly screwed in all the way.

The O-ring allows the tow hook to be timed while maintaining resistance on the threads.

Note: Due to strength and vibration concerns, most tow hooks will only thread in a 1/2 turn by hand. If your hook fits like this, ensure it is threading in straight and not cross-threaded, and use a 13mm or 1/2" wrench to slowly turn the screw in. It should screw in smoothly with consistent effort until it bottoms out. After initial install tools will likely not be needed. This is intentional and when comparing the threads of your Rennline tow hook to the factory tow hook, you will notice a substantial difference in thread profiles. This is also an important part of the design.

Towing Instructions: Always refer to your factory manual for towing instructions and be sure to never tow the vehicle at an angle. Vehicles must be towed straight on as advised in the factory manuals.
