



Cable Craze Blanket: Block Three
Designed by Berroco Design Team / Skill level: Intermediate
Version 3



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FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Completed Blanket: Approximately 50½" / 128 cm x 66" / 167.5 cm

Each Block: Approximately 15½" / 39 cm square

YARN

BERROCO VINTAGE (100 g): 6 hanks #5182 Black Currant (C1), 5 hanks #5144 Cork (C2), and 5 hanks #5102 Buttercream (C3)

NEEDLES

Knitting needles, size 7 / 4.5 mm or size to obtain gauge

NOTIONS

Cable needle, tapestry needle

GAUGE

23 sts and 29 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Block 3 Pattern St

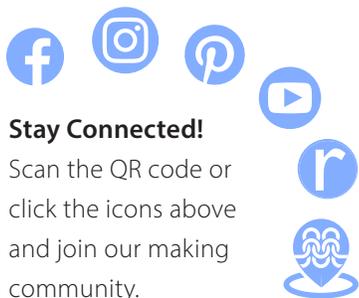
Gauge is measured after blocking. To save time and ensure accurate measurements, take time to check gauge.

We recommend using yarns called for in our instructions. Every effort has been made to ensure that directions contained in this pattern are accurate and complete, however errors do occur. We cannot be responsible for variance of individual knitters, human or typographical errors.

All pattern PDFs are updated when corrections are made. In the event of finding an error, please make sure you've downloaded the most recent version.



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CONSTRUCTION NOTES

The blanket consists of 12 unique cable blocks, each worked individually and then sewn together. The blocks include a garter stitch selvedge edge. Each block's pattern stitch is both written and charted for your preference.

Cast on all blocks using the long-tail method; the first row begins on a WS row.

Expect slight variations in the finished measurements of the different cable blocks. Cable and rib stitches naturally draw in, so when blocking, focus on stretching each block widthwise to reach the stated measurements. Once the blocks are joined, this inward pull will balance out.

At this stage, you may find it enjoyable to seam your blocks as you complete them. See p. 4 for layout options for arranging the finished blocks. SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

4/4 LC: 4/4 Left Cross—sl 4 to cn and hold to FRONT, k4, k4 from cn.

BLOCK 3 PATTERN STITCH

Multiple of 21 sts + 3

Row 1 and all WS Rows: K1, p1, *k2, p2, k2, p8, k2, p2, k2, p1; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 2 (RS): K1, *k1, p2, k2, p2, k8, p2, k2, p2; rep from * to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 4: K1, *k1, p2, k2, p2, 4/4 LC, p2, k2, p2; rep from * to last 2 sts, k2.

Rows 6 and 8: Rep Row 2.

Rep Rows 1–8 for Block 3 Pattern St.

INSTRUCTIONS

With C3, cast on 87 sts.

Beg on WS, rep Rows 1–8 of Block 3 Pattern St 13 times.

Rep Rows 1–7 once more.

Bind off purlwise on next RS row.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends and block as desired.

STANDARD ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

beg: beginning

C: color

cn: cable needle

k: knit

p: purl

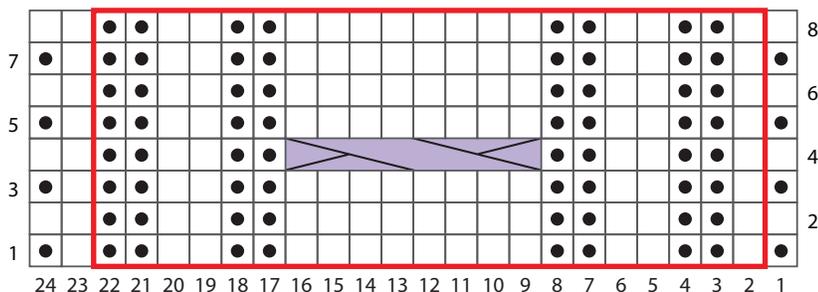
rep: repeat

RS: right side

sl: slip

st(s): stitch(es)

WS: wrong side

BLOCK 3 PATTERN**KEY TO CHART**

knit on RS; purl on WS

purl on RS; knit on WS



4/4 LC—sl 4 to cn and hold to FRONT, k4, k4 from cn

pattern repeat

CHART NOTES

Work from right to left on RS rows and from left to right on WS rows.

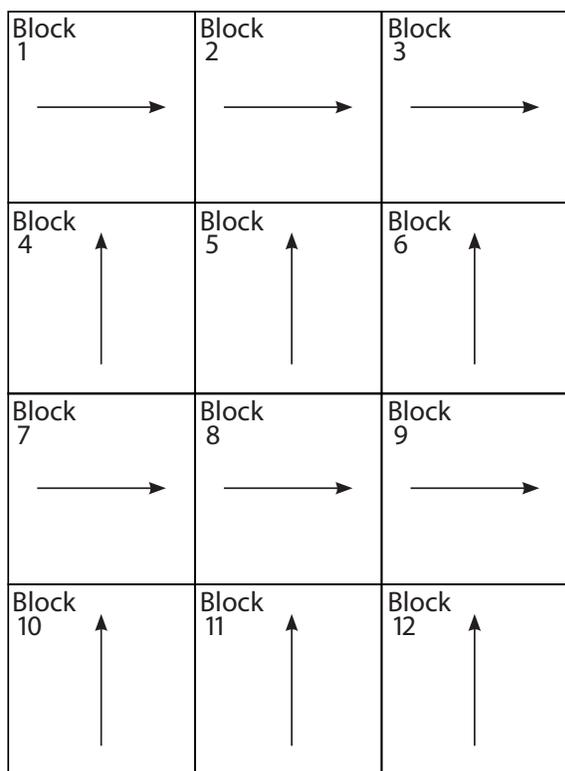

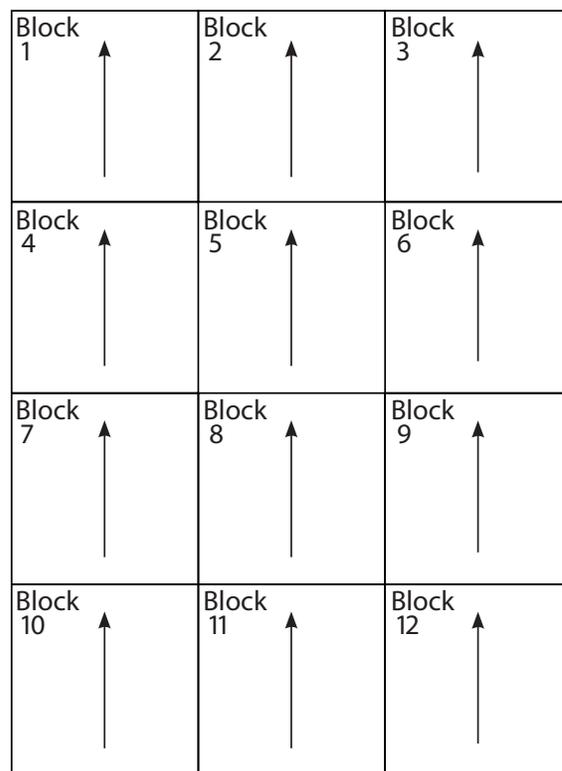
