



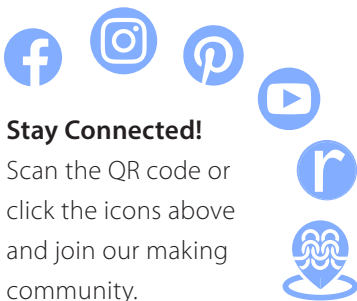

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We recommend using yarns called for in our instructions. Every effort has been made to ensure that directions contained in this pattern are accurate and complete, however errors do occur. We cannot be responsible for variance of individual knitters, human, or typographical errors.

All pattern PDFs are updated when corrections are made. In the event of finding an error, please make sure you've downloaded the most recent version.



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FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Completed Blanket: Approximately 50½" / 128 cm x 66" / 167.5 cm

Each Block: Approximately 15½" / 39 cm square

YARN

BERROCO VINTAGE (100 g): 6 hanks #5182 Black Currant (C1), 5 hanks #5144 Cork (C2), and 5 hanks #5102 Buttercream (C3)

NEEDLES

Knitting needles, size 7 / 4.5 mm *or size to obtain gauge*

NOTIONS

Cable needle, tapestry needle

GAUGE

Note: The gauge for Block 5 is slightly tighter than the first three blocks due to the cable pattern. You may need to adjust your needle size to match the finished gauge.

24 sts and 29 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Block 5 Pattern St
Gauge is measured after blocking. To save time and ensure accurate measurements, take time to check gauge.

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CONSTRUCTION NOTES

The blanket consists of 12 unique cable blocks, each worked individually and then sewn together. The blocks include a garter stitch selvedge edge. Each block's pattern stitch is both written and charted for your preference.

Cast on all blocks using the long-tail method; the first row begins on a WS row.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

2/2 LC: 2/2 Left Cross—sl 2 to cn and hold to FRONT, k2, k2 from cn.

2/2 RC: 2/2 Right Cross—sl 2 to cn and hold to BACK, k2, k2 from cn.

BLOCK 5 PATTERN STITCH

Multiple of 22 sts + 5

Row 1 and all WS Rows: K4, * p8, k3; rep from * to last st, k1.

Rows 2 and 14 (RS): K1, * p3, 2/2 LC, 2/2 RC, p3, 2/2 RC, 2/2 LC; rep from * to last 4 sts, p3, k1.

Row 4: K1, * p3, k2, 2/2 LC, k2, p3, k8; rep from * to last 4 sts, p3, k1.

Rows 6: K1, * p3, 2/2 RC, 2/2 LC, p3, 2/2 LC, 2/2 RC; rep from * to last 4 sts, p3, k1.

Row 8: K1, * p3, k8; rep from * to last 4 sts, p3, k1.

Row 10: Rep Row 6.

Row 12: K1, * p3, k8, p3, k2, 2/2 LC, k2; rep from * to last 4 sts, p3, k1.

Row 16: Rep Row 8.

Rep Rows 1–16 for Block 5 Pattern St.

INSTRUCTIONS

With C1, cast on 93 sts.

Beg on WS, work Rows 1–16 of Block 5 Pattern St 6 times.

Rep Rows 1–15 once.

Bind off purlwise on next RS row.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends and block as desired.

STANDARD ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

beg: beginning

C: color

cn: cable needle

k: knit

p: purl

rep: repeat

RS: right side

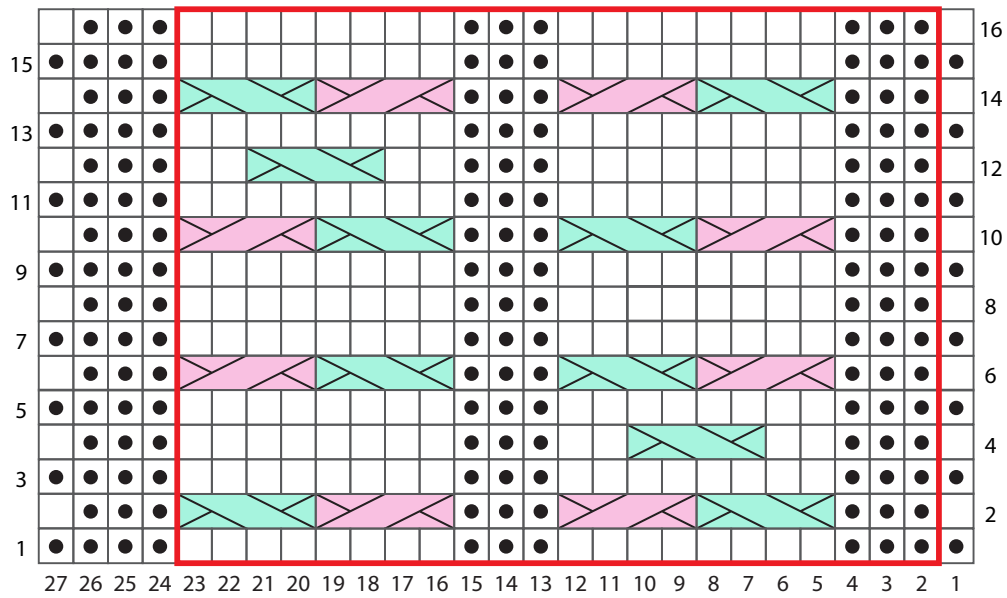
sl: slip

st(s): stitch(es)

WS: wrong side

KEY TO CHART

 knit on RS; purl on WS

 purl on RS; knit on WS

 2/2 RC—sl 2 to cn and hold to BACK, k2, k2 from cn

 2/2 LC—sl 2 to cn and hold to FRONT, k2, k2 from cn

 pattern repeat

CHART NOTES

Work from right to left on RS rows
and from left to right on WS rows.
