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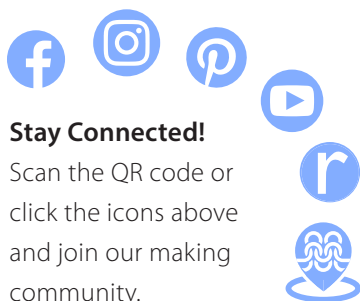

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FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Completed Blanket: Approximately 50½" / 128 cm x 66" / 167.5 cm

Each Block: Approximately 15½" / 39 cm square

YARN

BERROCO VINTAGE (100 g): 6 hanks #5182 Black Currant (C1), 5 hanks #5144 Cork (C2), and 5 hanks #5102 Buttercream (C3)

NEEDLES

Knitting needles, size 7 / 4.5 mm or size to obtain gauge

NOTIONS

Cable needle, tapestry needle

GAUGE

Note: The gauge for Block 7 is the same gauge as the first three blocks. You may need to adjust your needle size to match the finished gauge.

23 sts and 29 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Block 7 Pattern St

Gauge is measured after blocking. To save time and ensure accurate measurements, take time to check gauge.

CONSTRUCTION NOTES

The blanket consists of 12 unique cable blocks, each worked individually and then sewn together. The blocks include a garter stitch selvedge edge.

Each block's pattern stitch is both written and charted for your preference.

Cast on all blocks using the long-tail method; the first row begins on a WS row.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

2/1 LC: 2/1 Left Cross—sl 2 to cn and hold to FRONT, k1, k2 from cn.

2/1 LPC: 2/1 Left Purl Cross—sl 2 to cn and hold to FRONT, p1, k2 from cn.

2/1 RC: 2/1 Right Cross—sl 1 to cn and hold to BACK, k2, k1 from cn.

2/1 RPC: 2/1 Right Purl Cross—sl 1 to cn and hold to BACK, k2, p1 from cn.

2/2 LC: 2/2 Left Cross—sl 2 to cn and hold to FRONT, k2, k2 from cn.

BLOCK 7 PATTERN STITCH

Multiple of 14 sts + 4

Row 1 (WS): K7, p2, * p2, k10, p2; rep from * 5 times, p2, k7.

Row 2 (RS): K1, p5, 2/1 RPC, * 2/1 LC, p8, 2/1 RPC; rep from * 5 times, 2/1 LC, p5, k1.

Row 3: K6, p3, * k1, p2, k8, p3; rep from * 5 times, k1, p2, k6.

Row 4: K1, p4, 2/1 RPC, k1, * p1, 2/1 LC, p6, 2/1 RPC, k1; rep from * 5 times, p1, 2/1 LC, p4, k1.

Row 5: K5, p3, k1, * p1, k1, p2, k6, p3, k1; rep from * 5 times, p1, k1, p2, k5.

Row 6: K1, p3, 2/1 RPC, k1, p1, * k1, p1, 2/1 LC, p4, 2/1 RPC, k1, p1; rep from * 5 times, k1, p1, 2/1 LC, p3, k1.

Row 7: K4, p3, k1, p1, * k1, p1, k1, p2, k4, p3, k1, p1; rep from * 5 times, k1, p1, k1, p2, k4.

Row 8: K1, p2, 2/1 RPC, k1, p1, k1, * p1, k1, p1, 2/1 LC, p2, 2/1 RPC, k1, p1, k1; rep from * 5 times, p1, k1, p1, 2/1 LC, p2, k1.

Row 9: K3, p3, k1, p1, k1, * [p1, k1] twice, p2, k2, p3, k1, p1, k1; rep from * 5 times, [p1, k1] twice, p2, k3.

Row 10: K1, p1, 2/1 RPC, [k1, p1] twice, * [k1, p1] twice, 2/1 LC, 2/1 RPC, [k1, p1] twice; rep from * 5 times, [k1, p1] twice, 2/1 LC, p1, k1.

Row 11: K2, p3, [k1, p1] twice, * [k1, p1] twice, k1, p5, [k1, p1] twice; rep from * 5 times, [k1, p1] twice, k1, p2, k2.

Row 12: K1, p1, k3, [p1, k1] twice, * [p1, k1] twice, p1, 2/2 LC, [k1, p1] twice, k1; rep from * 5 times, [p1, k1] twice, p1, k2, p1, k1.

Row 13: K2, p2, [k1, p1] twice, k1, * [p1, k1] twice, p5, [k1, p1] twice, k1; rep from * 5 times, [p1, k1] twice, p3, k2.

Row 14: K1, p1, 2/1 LPC, [k1, p1] twice, * [k1, p1] twice, 2/1 RC, 2/1 LPC, [k1, p1] twice; rep from * 5 times, [k1, p1] twice, 2/1 RC, p1, k1.

Row 15: K3, p2, [k1, p1] twice, * k1, p1, k1, p3, k2, p2, [k1, p1] twice; rep from * 5 times, k1, p1, k1, p3, k3.

Row 16: K1, p2, 2/1 LPC, k1, p1, k1, * p1, k1, p1, 2/1 RC, p2, 2/1 LPC, k1, p1, k1; rep from * 5 times, p1, k1, p1, 2/1 RC, p2, k1.

Row 17: K4, p2, k1, p1, k1, * p1, k1, p3, k4, p2, k1, p1, k1; rep from * 5 times, p1, k1, p3, k4.

Row 18: K1, p3, 2/1 LPC, k1, p1, * k1, p1, 2/1 RC, p4, 2/1 LPC, k1, p1; rep from * 5 times, k1, p1, 2/1 RC, p3, k1.

Row 19: K5, p2, k1, p1, * k1, p3, k6, p2, k1, p1; rep from * 5 times, k1, p3, k5.

Row 20: K1, p4, 2/1 LPC, k1, * p1, 2/1 RC, p6, 2/1 LPC, k1; rep from * 5 times, p1, 2/1 RC, p4, k1.

Row 21: K6, p2, k1, * p3, k8, p2, k1; rep from * 5 times, p3, k6.

Row 22: K1, p5, 2/1 LPC, * 2/1 RC, p8, 2/1 LPC; rep from * 5 times, 2/1 RC, p5, k1.

Row 23: Rep Row 1.

Row 24: K1, p6, 2/2 LC, * p10, 2/2 LC; rep from * 5 times, p6, k1.

Rep Rows 1–24 for Block 7 Pattern St.

INSTRUCTIONS

With C2, cast on 88 sts.

Beg on WS, work Rows 1–24 of Block 7 Pattern St 4 times.

Rep Rows 1–17 once.

Bind off purlwise on next RS row.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends and block as desired.

STANDARD ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

beg: beginning

C: color

cn: cable needle

k: knit

p: purl

rep: repeat

RS: right side

sl: slip

st(s): stitch(es)

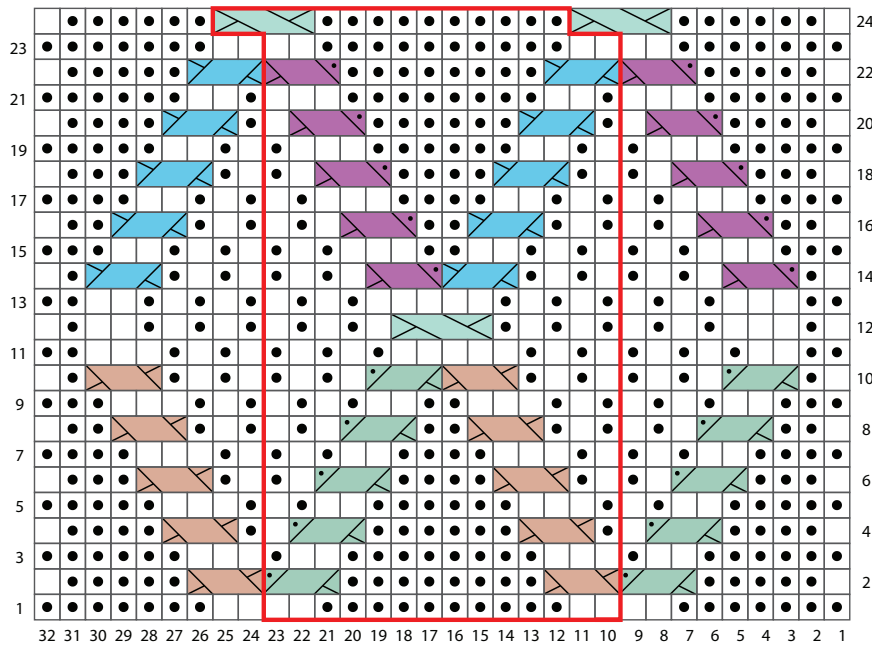
WS: wrong side

Work from right to left on RS rows
