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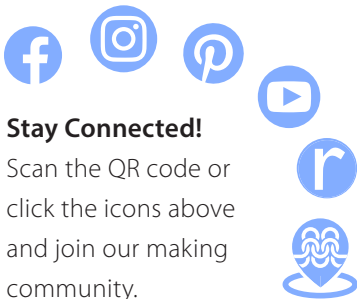

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FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Completed Blanket: Approximately 50½" / 128 cm x 66" / 167.5 cm

Each Block: Approximately 15½" / 39 cm square

YARN

BERROCO VINTAGE (100 g): 6 hanks #5182 Black Currant (C1), 5 hanks #5144 Cork (C2), and 5 hanks #5102 Buttercream (C3)

NEEDLES

Knitting needles, size 7 / 4.5 mm or size to obtain gauge

NOTIONS

Cable needle, tapestry needle

GAUGE

Note: The gauge for Block 9 is the same gauge as the first three blocks. You may need to adjust your needle size to match the finished gauge.

23 sts and 29 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Block 9 Pattern St

Gauge is measured after blocking. To save time and ensure accurate measurements, take time to check gauge.

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CONSTRUCTION NOTES

The blanket consists of 12 unique cable blocks, each worked individually and then sewn together. The blocks include a garter stitch selvedge edge.

Each block's pattern stitch is both written and charted for your preference.

Cast on all blocks using the long-tail method; the first row begins on a WS row.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

2/2 LC: Sl 2 to cn and hold to FRONT, k2, k2 from cn.

2/2 RC: Sl 2 to cn and hold to BACK, k2, k2 from cn.

BLOCK 9 PATTERN STITCH

Worked over 87 sts.

Note: The chart is broken into two so as to fit on the page. Start WS odd-numbered rows on the left side of Chart B (sts 87–44) and then move to Chart A for the remainder of the WS row, from left to right (sts 43–1). Start RS even-numbered rows on the right side of Chart A (sts 1–43) and then move to Chart B for the remainder of the RS row, from right to left (sts 44–87).

Row 1 (WS): K2, p1 tbl, k1, * p2, k6, p1 tbl, k3, p1 tbl, k1, p4, k1, p1 tbl, k3, p1 tbl, k6, p2, ** [k1, p1 tbl, k1, p1] 3 times, k1, p1 tbl, k1, rep from * to ** once, k1, p1 tbl, k2.

Row 2 (RS): K1, p1, k1 tbl, p1, * 2/2 LC, p2, [k1, p1, k1 tbl, p1] twice, k4, [p1, k1 tbl, p1, k1] twice, p2, 2/2 RC, ** p1, [k1 tbl, p3] 3 times, k1 tbl, p1, rep from * to ** once, p1, k1 tbl, p1, k1.

Row 3: K2, p1 tbl, k1, * p4, k4, p1 tbl, k3, p1 tbl, k6, p1 tbl, k3, p1 tbl, k4, p4, ** [k1, p1 tbl, k1, p1] 3 times, k1, p1 tbl, k1, rep from * to ** once, k1, p1 tbl, k2.

Row 4: K1, p1, k1 tbl, p1, * k2, 2/2 LC, [k1, p1, k1 tbl, p1] twice, k4, [p1, k1 tbl, p1, k1] twice, 2/2 RC, k2, ** p1, [k1 tbl, p3] 3 times, k1 tbl, p1, rep from * to ** once, p1, k1 tbl, p1, k1.

Row 5: K2, p1 tbl, k1, * p6, k2, p1 tbl, k3, p1 tbl, k6, p1 tbl, k3, p1 tbl, k2, p6, ** [k1, p1 tbl, k1, p1] 3 times, k1, p1 tbl, k1, rep from * to ** once, k1, p1 tbl, k2.

Row 6: K1, p1, k1 tbl, p1, * k4, 2/2 LC, k1 tbl, p1, k1, p1, k1 tbl, p1, k4, p1, k1 tbl, p1, k1, p1, k1 tbl, 2/2 RC, k4, ** p1, [k1 tbl, p3] 3 times, k1 tbl, p1, rep from * to ** once, p1, k1 tbl, p1, k1.

Row 7: K2, p1 tbl, k1, * p8, p1 tbl, k3, p1 tbl, k1, p4, k1, p1 tbl, k3, p1 tbl, p8, ** [k1, p1 tbl, k1, p1] 3 times, k1, p1 tbl, k1, rep from * to ** once, k1, p1 tbl, k2.

Row 8: K1, p1, k1 tbl, p1, * k6, 2/2 LC, k1, p1, k1 tbl, p1, k4, p1, k1 tbl, p1, k1, 2/2 RC, k6, ** p1, [k1 tbl, p3] 3 times, k1 tbl, p1, rep from * to ** once, p1, k1 tbl, p1, k1.

Row 9: K2, p1 tbl, k1, * p10, k2, p1 tbl, k6, p1 tbl, k2, p10, ** [k1, p1 tbl, k1, p1] 3 times, k1, p1 tbl, k1, rep from * to ** once, k1, p1 tbl, k2.

Row 10: K1, p1, k1 tbl, p1, * k8, 2/2 LC, k1 tbl, p1, k4, p1, k1 tbl, 2/2 RC, k8, ** p1, [k1 tbl, p3] 3 times, k1 tbl, p1, rep from * to ** once, p1, k1 tbl, p1, k1.

Row 11: K2, p1 tbl, k1, * p12, p1 tbl, k6, p1 tbl, p12, ** [k1, p1 tbl, k1, p1] 3 times, k1, p1 tbl, k1, rep from * to ** once, k1, p1 tbl, k2.

Row 12: K1, p1, k1 tbl, p1, * 2/2 LC, k6, 2/2 LC, k4, 2/2 RC, k6, 2/2 RC, ** p1, [k1 tbl, p3] 3 times, k1 tbl, p1, rep from * to ** once, p1, k1 tbl, p1, k1.

Row 13: K2, p1 tbl, k1, * p32, ** [k1, p1 tbl, k1, p1] 3 times, k1, p1 tbl, k1, rep from * to ** once, k1, p1 tbl, k2.

Row 14: K1, p1, k1 tbl, p1, * k2, 2/2 LC, k6, 2/2 LC, 2/2 RC, k6, 2/2 RC, k2, ** p1, [k1 tbl, p3] 3 times, k1 tbl, p1, rep from * to ** once, p1, k1 tbl, p1, k1.

Row 15: Rep Row 13.

Row 16: K1, p1, k1 tbl, p1, * k4, [2/2 LC, k6] twice, 2/2 RC, k4, ** p1, [k1 tbl, p3] 3 times, k1 tbl, p1, rep from * to ** once, p1, k1 tbl, p1, k1.

Row 17: Rep Row 13.

Row 18: K1, p1, k1 tbl, p1, * k6, 2/2 LC, k12, 2/2 RC, k6, ** p1, [k1 tbl, p3] 3 times, k1 tbl, p1, rep from * to ** once, p1, k1 tbl, p1, k1.

Row 19: Rep Row 13.

Row 20: K1, p1, k1 tbl, p1, * k8, 2/2 LC, k8, 2/2 RC, k8, ** p1, [k1 tbl, p3] 3 times, k1 tbl, p1, rep from * to ** once, p1, k1 tbl, p1, k1.

Row 21: Rep Row 13.

Rep Rows 12–21 for Block 9 Pattern St.

INSTRUCTIONS

With C1, cast on 87 sts.

Beg on WS, work Rows 1–21 of Block 9 Pattern St once.

Rep Rows 12–21 nine times.

Bind off purlwise on next RS row.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends and block as desired.

STANDARD ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

beg: beginning

C: color

cn: cable needle

k: knit

p: purl

rep: repeat

RS: right side

sl: slip

st(s): stitch(es)

tbl: through the back loop(s)

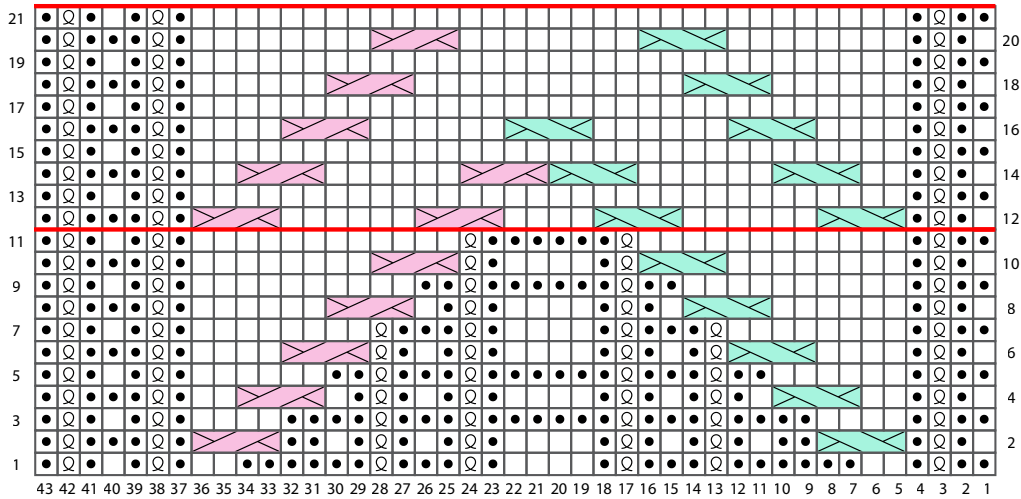
WS: wrong side

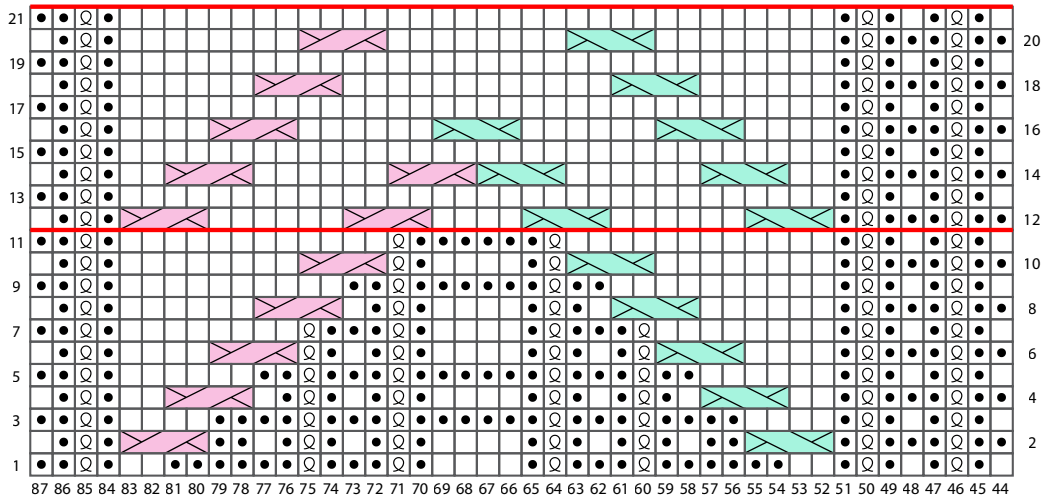

KEY TO CHART

- knit on the RS; purl on the WS
- purl on the RS; knit on the WS
- k tbl on the RS; p tbl on the WS
- 2/2 LC: Sl 2 to cn and hold to FRONT, k2, k2 from cn.
- 2/2 RC: Sl 2 to cn and hold to BACK, k2, k2 from cn.
- Rep Rows 12–21

CHART NOTES

The chart is broken into two so as to fit on the page.
 Start WS odd-numbered rows on the left side of Chart B (sts 87–44) and then move to Chart A for the remainder of the WS row, from left to right (sts 43–1).
 Start RS even-numbered rows on the right side of Chart A (sts 1–43) and then move to Chart B for the remainder of the RS row, from right to left (sts 44–87).
 Work Rows 1–21 once.
 Rep Rows 12–21 nine times.
