FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Approximately 77" / 195.5 cm wide x 35" / 89 cm deep along short edge

YARN

BERROCO WIZARD (100 g): 2 balls each #29104 Slate (C1) and #2985 Onyx (C2)

HOOKS AND NOTIONS

Tunisian crochet hook with 16" / 40 cm cord, size M-13 / 9 mm or size to obtain gauge

GAUGE

13 sts and 15 rows = 4" / 10 cm in pattern stitch

Gauge is measured after blocking. To save time and ensure accurate measurements, take time to check gauge.

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We recommend using yarns called for in our instructions. Every effort has been made to ensure that directions contained in this pattern are accurate and complete, however errors do occur. We cannot be responsible for variance of individual knitters, human or typographical errors.

All pattern PDFs are updated when corrections are made. In the event of finding an error, please make sure you've downloaded the most recent version.

CONSTRUCTION NOTES

This shawl is worked from narrow to wide edge.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch: chain

Inc (Increase): Insert hook between first and second stitch and pull up a loop.

rep: repeat

RetP (Return Pass): Yo and pull through 1 loop on hook, *yo and pull through 2 loops; rep from * until 1 loop left on hook.

st(s): stitch(es)

Tks (Tunisian knit stitch): Insert hook from front to back through center of st between vertical bars, yo and pull through.

Tks purled (Tunisian knit stitch purled): Bring yarn to front, insert hook as for Tks, take yarn across front of st to back of work, yo and pull through.

yo: yarn over



INSTRUCTIONS

Begin with a sliding loop, using C1.

Row 1: Ch 4, pull up a loop in the 2nd ch from hook and each ch across row. RetP. Change to C2. 4 sts.

Row 2: With C2, skip 1st vertical bar, * 1 Tks in next st, 1 Tks purled in next st; rep from * to last stitch, pull up a loop in last st. RetP. Change to C1.

Row 3 (Inc Row): With C1, insert hook between first and second stitch and pull up a loop (1 stitch inc'd), * 1 Tks purled in next st, 1 Tks in next st; rep from * to last stitch, pull up a loop in last stitch. RetP. Change to C2. 1 st inc'd.

Row 4: With C2, 1 Tks purled in next st, * 1 Tks in next st, 1 Tks purled in next st; rep from * to last stitch, pull up a loop in last stitch. RetP. Change to C1.

Row 5 (Inc Row): With C1, insert hook between first and second stitch and pull up a loop (1 stitch inc'd), 1 Tks in next st, * 1 Tks purled in next st, 1 Tks in next st; rep from * to last stitch, pull up a loop in last stitch. RetP. Change to C2. 1 st inc'd.

Row 6: With C2, * 1 Tks in next st, 1 Tks purled in next st; rep from * to last stitch, pull up a loop in last stitch. RetP. Change to C1.

Rep Rows 3-6 until straight edge of shawl measures 77" / 195.5 cm.

Note: Shawl can be made smaller or larger with fewer or additional rows, but make sure to end with C1.

Bind-Off Row: Skip first vertical bar, then insert hook in next vertical bar, yo and pull through stitch and loop on hook.

Repeat until all stitches have been worked. You will finish with one loop on hook. Fasten off by pulling tail through loop and tightening.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends and block as desired.
