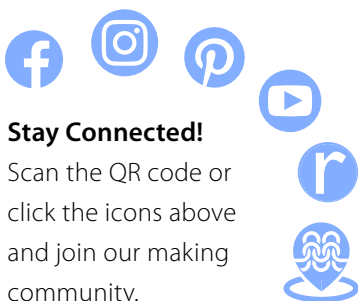

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SIZES

(1, 2, 3, 4, 5)

(Toddler, Child, Women's S/M, Women's Large/Men's S/M, Men's Large/XL)

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Approximately (4¾, 6½, 8, 9½, 11¼)" / (12, 16.5, 20.5, 24, 28.5) cm around (unstretched).

Foot Length: (5½, 7, 9, 10, 11)" / (14, 18, 23, 25.5, 28) cm. Length is adjustable.

Shown in sizes 2 and 3.

YARN

BERROCO VINTAGE SOCK HANDPAINT (100 g): (1, 1, 1, 1, 2) hank(s)

Shown in #12204 Sunset Serenade (Version 1, Size 2), #12205 Spring Bloom (Version 1, Size 3), #12206 Ocean Breeze (Version 2, Size 3)

NEEDLES

1 set double-pointed needles, or preferred needles for working small circumferences, size 1 / 2.25 mm *or size to obtain gauge*

NOTIONS

2 stitch markers (2 different colors), tapestry needle

GAUGE

30 sts and 40 rnds = 4" / 10 cm in St st

30 sts and 44 rnds = 4" / 10 cm in Pattern St

Gauge shown is after blocking. To save time and ensure accurate measurements, take time to check gauge.

CONSTRUCTION NOTES

Socks are worked from the cuff down.

PATTERN STITCH (Version 2)

Multiple of 6 sts

Rnd 1: * K5, p1; rep from * around.

Rnd 2: * P1, k3, p1, k1; rep from * around.

Rnd 3: * K1, p1, k1, p1, k2; rep from * around.

Rnd 4: * K2, p1, k3; rep from * around.

Rep these 4 rounds for Pattern Stitch.



INSTRUCTIONS

SOCKS

Using Long Tail cast-on, cast on (36, 48, 60, 72, 84) sts, divide stitches onto 3 needles (if using double-pointed needles), place marker and join for working in the round.

Work 14 rounds in k1, p1 ribbing, then work in St st (for Version 1) or Pattern Stitch (for Version 2) as desired until sock measures approximately (4, 5, 6, 7, 8)" / (10, 12.5, 15, 18, 20.5) cm, or desired length to beginning of heel.

Set Up Heel: Next Rnd: Work in pattern across (17, 23, 29, 35, 41) sts for front.

The heel will be worked in rows over the next (19, 25, 31, 37, 43) sts. Arrange sts on needle as preferred.

Heel Flap: Row 1 (RS): Sl 1, knit (18, 24, 30, 36, 42), turn.

Row 2: Sl 1, purl (18, 24, 30, 36, 42), turn.

Rep the last 2 rows (8, 9, 11, 12, 14) times more.

Turn Heel: Short Rows: Row 1 (RS): Sl 1, knit (11, 15, 17, 21, 23), SSK, k1, turn. *1 st dec'd.*

Row 2 (WS): Sl 1, purl (6, 8, 6, 8, 6), p2tog, p1, turn. *1 st dec'd.*

Row 3: Sl 1, knit to 1 st before gap, k2tog, k1, turn. *1 st dec'd.*

Row 4: Sl 1, purl to 1 st before gap, p2tog, p1, turn. *1 st dec'd.*

Repeat the last 2 rows until all heel sts have been worked. (13, 17, 19, 23, 25) sts.

Heel Gusset: Next Row (RS): Knit across (13, 17, 19, 23, 25) sts of heel flap, pick up and knit (9, 10, 12, 13, 15) sts along left edge of heel flap, slip BOR marker, work in pattern across (17, 23, 29, 35, 41) sts of front needle, place side marker, pick up and knit (9, 10, 12, 13, 15) sts along right edge of heel flap, then knit to BOR marker. (48, 60, 72, 84, 96) sts.

Note: From here you will again be working in the round. Work in St st for Version 1, or Pattern st for Version 2, over the center front (17, 23, 29, 35, 41) sts, keeping remaining stitches in St st.

Work 1 round even, slipping markers.

Dec Rnd: Work in pattern across front sts, sm, k1, SSK, work to 3 sts before next marker, k2tog, k1. *2 sts dec'd.*

Rep Dec Rnd every other round 5 times more. (36, 48, 60, 72, 84) sts.

Work even in pattern as established until foot measures (4¼, 5½, 6¾, 7½, 8)" / (11, 14, 17, 19, 20.5) cm, or (1¼, 1½, 2¼, 2½, 3)" / (3, 4, 5.5, 6.5, 7.5) cm less than desired length. Discontinue Pattern Stitch (if working Version 2), and work all stitches in St st from here.

Shape Toe: Dec Rnd 1: Knit to marker, sm, k1, SSK, knit to 3 sts before next marker, k2tog, k1, sm. *2 sts dec'd.*

Next Rnd: Knit.

Dec Rnd 2: * K1, SSK, knit to 3 sts before next marker, k2tog, k1, sm; rep from * once more. *4 sts dec'd.*

Next Rnd: Knit.

Rep the last 2 rounds (4, 6, 9, 11, 13) times more. (*14, 18, 18, 22, 24*) sts.

Dividing stitches at markers, slip (7, 9, 9, 11, 12) sts onto each of 2 dpns. Break off yarn leaving an approximately 18" / 46 cm long end. Thread end into tapestry needle., hold needles parallel to each other and graft toe stitches together using Kitchener st.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends and block as desired.

STANDARD ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

dec: decrease

k: knit

k2tog: knit 2 stitches together

p: purl

p2tog: purl 2 stitches together

rep: repeat

rnd(s): round(s)

sl: slip

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

st(s): stitch(es)

St st: Stockinette Stitch—Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round.
