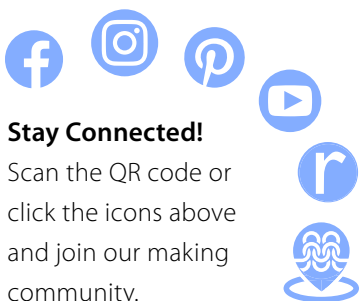

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SIZES

(1, 2, 3, 4) [5, 6, 7] {8, 9, 10 11}

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Bust: (34, 38¾, 42, 46¾) [50, 54¾, 58] {62¾, 66, 70¾, 74}" / (86.5, 98.5, 106.5, 118.5) [127, 139, 147.5] {159.5, 167.5, 179.5, 188} cm

Length: (19½, 20, 20½, 20½) [21, 21, 21½] {22, 22, 22½, 23}" / (49.5, 51, 52, 52) [53.5, 53.5, 54.5] {56, 56, 57, 58.5} cm

Shown in size 3 (42" / 106.5 cm).

Recommended ease: Approximately 2–4" / 5–10 cm positive ease.

YARN

BERROCO TILLIE (100g): (2, 2, 3, 3) [3, 3, 4] {4, 4, 5, 5} hanks
#10976 Celtic Blue

NEEDLES

32" / 80 cm circular needles, sizes 3 / 3.25 mm and 5 / 3.75 mm *or size to obtain gauge*

16" / 40 cm circular needles, size 3 / 3.25 mm

NOTIONS

Waste yarn to hold stitches, tapestry needle.

GAUGE

20 sts and 32 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Pattern Stitch

Gauge is measured after blocking. To save time and ensure accurate measurements, take time to check gauge

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CONSTRUCTION NOTES

Tee is worked in pieces from the bottom up, and then seamed.

PATTERN STITCH

Multiple of 4 sts + 5

Row 1 (RS): K1 (edge), * p3, k1; rep from * to last 4 sts, p3, k1 (edge).

Row 2: Knit.

Row 3: K1 (edge), * p3, k1 in row below; rep from * to last 4 sts, p3, k1 (edge).

Row 4: Knit.

Row 5: K1 (edge) * sl 3 wyif, k1 in row below; rep from * to last 4 sts, sl 3 wyif, k1 (edge).

Row 6: Knit.

Rep Rows 3–6 for Pattern St.

INSTRUCTIONS

FRONT

With smaller 32" / 80 cm circular needle, cast on (85, 97, 105, 117) [125, 137, 145] {157, 165, 177, 185} sts. Do not join.

Work in k1, p1 ribbing until piece measures 1" / 2.5 cm from cast-on.

Change to larger needle.

Work in Pattern St until piece measures approximately 12" / 30 cm from cast-on, end after completing Row 6 of Pattern St.

Shape Sleeves: Cast on 8 sts at beginning of the next 2 rows. (101, 113, 121, 133) [141, 153, 161] {173, 181, 193, 201} sts.

Continue working in Pattern St until sleeve measures approximately (3½, 4, 4½, 4½) [5, 5, 6½] {7, 7, 7½, 7½}" / (11.5, 12.5, 14, 14) [15, 15, 16.5] {18, 18, 19, 19} cm, end after completing Row 5 of pattern.

Divide for Neck: Next Row (WS): Knit (33, 37, 41, 45) [49, 53, 57] {61, 65, 69, 73} sts, slip sts just worked to waste yarn for Right Front, bind off the next (35, 39, 39, 43) [43, 47, 47] {51, 51, 55, 55} sts, knit to end. (33, 37, 41, 45) [49, 53, 57] {61, 65, 69, 73} sts.

Left Front: Work even in pattern as established until sleeve measures (7½, 8, 8½, 8½) [9, 9, 9½] {10, 10, 10½, 11}" / (19, 20.5, 21.5, 21.5) [23, 23, 24] {25.5, 25.5, 26.5, 28} cm, end after completing a WS row. Bind off, knitting or purling sts as they appear.

Right Front: With RS facing, slip (33, 37, 41, 45) [49, 53, 57] {61, 65, 69, 73} sts from waste yarn to needle. Join yarn and work even in pattern as established until sleeve measures (7½, 8, 8½, 8½) [9, 9, 9½] {10, 10, 10½, 11}" / (19, 20.5, 21.5, 21.5) [23, 23, 24] {25.5, 25.5, 26.5, 28} cm, ending after completing a WS row. Bind off, knitting or purling sts as they appear.

BACK

Work same as Front until sleeves measure (6½, 7, 7½, 7½) [8, 8, 8½] {9, 9, 9½, 10}" / (16.5, 18, 19, 19) [20.5, 20.5, 21.5] {23, 23, 24, 25.5} cm, end after completing a RS row.

Divide for Neck: Next Row (WS): Knit (33, 37, 41, 45) [49, 53, 57] {61, 65, 69, 73} sts, slip sts just worked to waste yarn for Right Back, bind off the next (35, 39, 39, 43) [43, 47, 47]



{51, 51, 55, 55} sts, purl to end. (33, 37, 41, 45) [49, 53, 57] {61, 65, 69, 73} sts.

Left Back: Work even in pattern as established until sleeve measures (7½, 8, 8½, 8½) [9, 9, 9½] {10, 10, 10½, 11}" / (19, 20.5, 21.5, 21.5) [23, 23, 24] {25.5, 25.5, 26.5, 28} cm, end after completing a WS row. Bind off, knitting or purling sts as they appear.

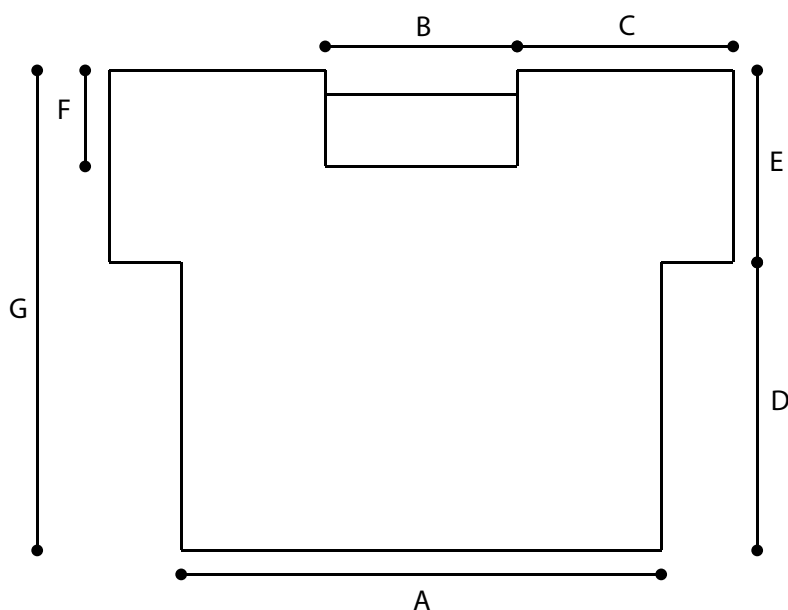
Right Back: With RS facing, slip (33, 37, 41, 45) [49, 53, 57] {61, 65, 69, 73} sts from waste yarn to needle. Join yarn and work even in pattern as established until sleeve measures (7½, 8, 8½, 8½) [9, 9, 9½] {10, 10, 10½, 11}" / (19, 20.5, 21.5, 21.5) [23, 23, 24] {25.5, 25.5, 26.5, 28} cm, end after completing a WS row. Bind off, knitting or purling sts as they appear.

FINISHING

Sew shoulder, underarm, and side seams.

Neck Edging: With RS facing, using smaller 16" / 40 cm needle, pick up and knit 2 sts for every 3 rows and 1 st in each bound off stitch around entire neck edge. Continuing with RS facing, bind off.

Weave in all ends and block as desired.

- A** (Back and Front Width): (17, 19½, 21, 23½) [25, 27½, 29] {31½, 33, 35½, 37}" / (43, 49.5, 53.5, 59.5) [63.5, 70, 73.5] {80, 84, 90, 94} cm
- B** (Neck Width): (7, 7¾, 7¾, 8½) [8½, 9½, 9½] {10¼, 10¼, 11, 11}" / (18, 19.5, 19.5, 21.5) [21.5, 24, 24] {26, 26, 28, 28} cm
- C** (Shoulder Width): (6½, 7½, 8¼, 9) [9¾, 10½, 11½] {12¼, 13, 13¾, 14½}" / (16.5, 19, 21, 23) [25, 26.5, 29] {31, 33, 35, 37} cm
- D** (Length to Underarms): 12" / 30.5 cm
- E** (Armhole Length): (7½, 8, 8½, 8½) [9, 9, 9½] {10, 10, 10½, 11}" / (19, 20.5, 21.5, 21.5) [23, 23, 24] {25.5, 25.5, 26.5, 28} cm
- F** (Front Neck Depth): 4" / 10 cm
- G** (Total Length): (19½, 20, 20½, 20½) [21, 21, 21½] {22, 22, 22½, 23}" / (49.5, 51, 52, 52) [53.5, 53.5, 54.5] {56, 56, 57, 58.5} cm
