Brick (knit cowl)

Designed by Mel Kennelly / Skill level: Easy



FINISHED MEASUREMENTS
Approximately 28" / 71 cm around
x 11¾" / 30 cm wide

YARN
BERROCO ULTRA ALPACA (100 grs):
1 hank #6292 Tiger's Eye Mix

NEEDLES and NOTIONS
24" / 60 cm circular needles, sizes
7 / 4.5 mm and 8 / 5 mm or size to
obtain gauge
1 stitch marker

GAUGE
18 sts and 26 rows = 4" / 10 cm in
pattern on larger needle
Gauge is measured after blocking.
To save time and ensure accurate
measurements, take time to check
gauge.

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We recommend using yarns called for in our instructions. COWL

With smaller needle, cast on 120 sts. Place marker and join for working in the round.

Set Up Rib: Rnd 1: * K1, p1; rep from * around.

Rep this round until piece measures 1" / 2.5 cm from cast-on.

Change to larger needle.

Rnds 1–3: Knit.

Rnds 4, 6, and 8: * P3, k6, p3; rep from * around.

Rnds 5, 7, and 9: Knit.

Rnds 10–12: Knit.

Rnds 13 and 15: * K6, p6; rep from * around.

Rnds 14 and 16: Knit.

Rnd 17: Rep Rnd 13.

Rep these 17 rounds until piece measures approximately 9¾" / 25 cm from cast-on, end on either Rnd 3 or Rnd 8.

Change to smaller needle.

Work in ribbing as at beginning for 1" / 2.5 cm. Bind off in ribbing.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends and block as desired.



Mortar (crocheted cowl)

Designed by Mel Kennelly / Skill level: Intermediate



FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Approximately 27½" / 70 cm
around x 8" / 20.5 cm wide

YARN

BERROCO ULTRA ALPACA (100 grs):
2 hanks #6204 Buckwheat

HOOKS and NOTIONS

Crochet hook, size 5 mm / F or size
to obtain gauge

GAUGE

13 hdc and 11 rows = 4" / 10 cm
Gauge is measured after blocking.
To save time and ensure accurate
measurements, take time to check
gauge.

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COWL

Ch 90. Join with a sl st in first ch.

Set Up Rnd: Ch 2, hdc in each ch around, join with a sl st in beg ch-2. Turn.

Rnds 1–3: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc around, join with a sl st in beg ch-2. Turn.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, * sc in the next 3 hdc, 3 tr in 3rd round below, sc in the next 3 hdc; rep from * around, join with a sl st in beg ch-1. Turn.

Rnds 5–7: Rep Rnds 1–3. Turn.

Rnd 8: Ch 1, * sc in the next 6 hdc, 3 tr in 3rd round below; rep from * around, join with a sl st in beg ch-1. Turn.

Rep these 8 rounds until cowl measures approximately 6" / 15 cm from beginning, end on either Rnd 4 or Rnd 8.

Next Rnd: Ch 2, hdc in each stitch around, join with a sl st in beg ch-2. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Ribbed Edging: Ch 6.

Row 1 (RS): Sc in the second ch from the hook, sc in each ch to end, sc into edge of cowl. Turn.

Row 2: Sc in first sc, sc tbl of each sc to end, ch 1. Turn.

Row 3: Sc in first sc, sc tbl of each sc to end, sc into edge of cowl. Turn.

Rep Rows 2 and 3 until you have worked completely around the edge of cowl, end on Row 3. Turn. Slip stitch the 2 ends of edging together. Fasten off.

Repeat on the other edge of cowl.

Weave in all ends and block as desired.



ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

Note: Berroco patterns use American crochet terms

beg: beginning

ch: chain

hdc: half double crochet

k: knit

p: purl

rep: repeat

rnd(s): round(s)

sl st: slip stitch

st(s): stitch(es)

tbl: through back loop(s)

tr: treble
