#### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Approximately 44" / 112 cm wide x 52" / 132 cm long

#### YARN

BERROCO BOZZOLO (100 g): 5 balls each #10816 Azalea (C1) and #10837 Chalkhill (C2)

#### HOOK

Crochet hook, size H-8 / 5 mm or size to obtain gauge

#### NOTIONS

Tapestry needle

#### GAUGE

1 Motif = 4'' / 10 cm square

14 dc and 8 rows = 4'' / 10 cm in dc

Gauge is measured after blocking. To save time and ensure accurate measurements, take time to check gauge.

#### **CONSTRUCTION NOTES**

Motifs are worked separately, then sewn together to form center section. Middle section is then worked around center section in double crochet. Final row of motifs is sewn to middle section, then border is worked in double crochet. See diagram for color placement.

#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

# MOTIF (Make 44 each with C1 and C2—88 Motifs total)

Begin with a Magic Ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 3 (counts as dc throughout), then work 23 dc into Ring, join with a sl st in top of beg ch-3. 24 dc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in same st, ch 5, skip 2 dc, sc in next dc, ch 3, skip 2 dc, \* sc in next dc, ch 5, skip 2 dc, sc in next dc, ch 3, skip 2 dc; rep from \* around, join with a sl st in beg sc. Sl st into next ch-5 sp. 8 sc, 4 ch-3 sp, 4 ch-5 sp.

Rnd 3: Ch 3, [2 dc, ch 3, 3 dc] in ch-5 sp, 3 dc in next ch-3 sp, \* [3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc] in next ch-5 sp, 3 dc in next ch-3 sp; rep from \* around, join with a sl st in top of beg ch-3. 9 dc per side, 4 ch-3 corner sp.



Rnd 4: Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in each of the next 2 dc, [dc, ch 3, dc] in ch-3 sp, \* dc in each dc to next ch-3 sp, [dc, ch 3, dc] in next ch-3 sp; rep from \* around, dc in each dc to end, join with a sl st in top of beg ch-3. 11 dc per side, 4 ch-3 corner sp.

Fasten off.

#### **FINISHING**

**Center Section:** Holding RS of Motifs together, sewing through upper loops of sts, join 24 Motifs together to form center section. (See diagram).

Middle Section: Join C2 with a sl st in any ch-3 corner sp.

Rnd 1: [Ch 3, 2 dc, ch 3, 3 dc] in same corner sp, dc in each dc, ch sp, and seam to next ch-3 corner sp, \* [3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc] in ch-3 corner sp, dc in each dc, ch sp, and seam to next ch-3 corner sp; rep from \* around, join with a sl st in top of beg ch-3.

Rnd 2: [Ch 3, 2 dc, ch-3, 3 dc] in corner sp, dc in each dc to next ch-3 corner sp, \* [3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc] in ch-3 corner sp, dc in each dc to next ch-3 corner sp; rep from \* around, join with a sl st in top of beg ch-3.

Change to C1 and rep Rnd 2 twice more.

Change to C2 and rep Rnd 2 twice more.

Change to C1 and rep Rnd 2 twice more. 8 rnds completed.

Sew together 2 strips of 8 Motifs each, alternating colors.

Sew together 2 strips of 12 Motifs each, alternating colors.

Sew one 8-Motif strip to each short end of throw, matching seams on strips to seams on center section as closely as possible.

Sew one 12-Motif strip to each long end of throw, matching seams on strips to seams on center secton as closely as possible.

**Border:** Join C2 to any ch-3 corner space on last round of Motifs. Work Rnds 1 and 2 of Middle Section. Change to C1 and work Rnd 2 of Middle Section twice. *4 rounds completed.*.

Fasten off.

Weave in all ends and block as desired.

#### STANDARD ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

Note: Berroco patterns use American crochet terms

beg: beginningch: chain


**dc:** double crochet

inc: increase


Magic Ring: Form a loop of yarn around your fingers, with the end attached to the ball on the right and the tail on the left. Insert hook into the loop under both pieces of yarn and draw up a loop onto hook. (This does not count as your first stitch.) Work first row into the original loop. Pull up the yarn tail after your first row is complete to close the loop.

rep: repeat
rnd(s): round(s)
RS: right side
sc: single crochet
sl st: slip stitch
sp: space
st(s): stitch(es)
tog: together
WS: wrong side
