**HOOK and NOTIONS** Crochet hook, size 12 mm (P-16)

### BAG

**Bottom:** With crochet hook, ch 4, join with a sl st to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Work 10 sc in ring, join with a sl st in first sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, \* work 2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc; rep from \* 4 times more, join with a sl st in beg ch-1—15 sc.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, \* work 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of the next 2 sc's; rep from \* 4 times more, join with a sl st in beg ch-1—20 sc.

Continue in this manner to inc 5 sc every round, having 1 more sc between incs, 14 times more—90 sc. Mark end of last round for beginning of top.

**Top:** Work even in sc until piece measures 8" / 20 cm from marker.

Dec Rnd: Ch 1, \* sc in each of the next 2 sc, dec 1 sc over next 2 sc, sc in each of the next 3 sc, dec 1 sc over the next 2 sc; rep from \* 9 times more, join with a sl st in beg ch-1 —70 sc. Fasten off.

### **FINISHING**

**Straps (Make 2):** Ch 33. Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across—72 sc. Turn.

**Dec Row:** Ch 1, \* sc in each of the next 3 sc, skip 1 sc; rep from \* across—54 sc. Fasten off.

Turn piece and work 1 sc in each ch on opposite side of foundation chain—72 sc.

Rep Dec Row—54 sc. Fasten off.

Lay bag out flat. Measure in  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " / 11 cm in from each edge of bag on back and front and mark for edge of strap. Sew one end of first strap to back of bag with outer edge at marker. Sew the other end of first strap to front of bag with outer edge at marker. Repeat of the other side of bag with second strap.

Felt bag in top loading washing machine, using hot water and soap. Check piece often. When piece has reached the desired measurements, remove from washer, shape by hand and allow to air dry. Using sharp scissors, carefully trim any extra fuzz left from felting if necessary.

rep: repeat rnd(s): round(s) RS: right side sc: single crochet sl st: slip stitch

sliding loop: Form a loop of yarn around your fingers, with the end attached to the ball on the right and the tail on the left. Insert hook into the loop under both pieces of yarn and draw up a loop onto hook. (This does not count as your first stitch.) Work first row into the original loop. Pull up the yarn tail after your first row is complete to close the loop.

sp: space st(s): stitch(es) tog: together

tr: treble

WS: wrong side yo: yarn over
