FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Approximately 20" / 51 cm around
x 8" / 20 cm long including brim.

YARN

BERROCO MERAKI (50 grs): 1 ball
each #6033 Devotion (MC) and
#6013 Cherish (CC)

HOOKS AND NOTIONS

Crochet hook, size G / 4 mm or size
to obtain gauge

GAUGE

14 dc and 8½ rows = 4" / 10 cm in
dc

*Gauge is measured after blocking.
To save time and ensure accurate
measurements, take time to check
gauge.*

CONSTRUCTION NOTES

Hat is worked in the round from the top down with a decorative brim band.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

M1D (Make 1 Daisy): 2 dc into next dc, [ch 2, 2 dc into loop created by previous 2 dc, sl st into loop] 5 times, rotating your work as you work through the dc loop to create a round flower.

HAT

Begin with a sliding loop using MC.

Set Up Rnd: Ch 2 (does NOT count as a st throughout), 6 dc into loop, join with a sl st in beg ch-2, then tighten loop.

Rnd 1 (Inc Rnd): Ch 2, * 2 dc in next dc; rep from * around, join with a sl st in beg ch-2, turn—12 dc.

Rnd 2: Ch 2, * dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc; rep from * around, join with a sl st in beg st, ch-2, turn—18 dc.

Rnd 3: Ch 2, * dc in the next 2 dc, 2 dc in next dc; rep from * around, join with a sl st in beg ch-2, turn—24 dc.

Rnd 4: Ch 2, * dc in the next 3 dc, 2 dc in the next dc; rep from * around, join with a sl st in beg ch-2, turn—30 dc.

Rnd 5: Ch 2, * dc in next 4 dc, 2 dc in the next dc; rep from * around, join with a sl st in beg ch-2, turn—36 dc.

Rnd 6: Ch 2, * dc in next 5 dc, 2 dc 2 in the next dc; rep from * around, join with a sl st in beg ch-2, turn—42 dc.



Rnd 7: Ch 2, * dc in next 6 dc, 2 dc in the next dc; rep from * around, join with a sl st in beg ch-2, turn—48 dc.

Rnd 8: Ch 2, * dc in next 7 dc, 2 dc in the next dc; rep from * around, join with a sl st in beg ch-2, turn—54 dc.

Rnd 9: Ch 2, * dc in next 8 dc, 2 dc in the next dc; rep from * around, join with a sl st in beg ch-2, turn—60 dc.

Rnd 10: Ch 2, * dc in next 9 dc, 2 dc in the next dc; rep from * around, join with a sl st in beg ch-2, turn—66 dc.

Rnds 11–23: Ch 2, * dc in each dc around, join with a sl st in beg ch-2, turn. Join CC (leaving MC attached).

Rnd 24: With CC, ch 2, * dc in each of the next 6 dc, M1D; rep from * around, join with a sl st in beg ch-2, turn.

Rnd 25: With CC, ch 2, dc in each dc and M1D around, join with a sl st in beg ch-2, turn. Break off CC.

Rnd 26: Using MC, ch 2, * dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc; rep from * around, join with a sl st in beg ch-2, turn—99 dc.

Rnd 27: Ch 2, dc in each dc around, join with a sl st in beg ch-2, turn.

Rnds 28 and 29: Rep Rnds 26 and 27. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends and block as desired.



STANDARD ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

Note: Berroco patterns use American crochet terms

beg: beginning

BLO: back loop only

BP: back post

BPdc: back post double crochet

BPhdc: back post half double crochet

BPsc: back post single crochet

BPtc: back post treble crochet

CC: contrasting color

cont: continue

ch: chain

dec: decrease

dc: double crochet

dc2tog: double crochet 2 stitches together

dtr: double treble crochet

est: established

FLO: front loop only

est: established

FP: front post

FPdc: front post double crochet

FPhdc: front post half double crochet

FPsc: front post single crochet

FPtc: front post treble crochet

hdc: half double crochet

hdc2tog: half double crochet 2 stitches together

inc: increase

MC: main color

pat(s): pattern(s)

pm: place marker

rep: repeat

rnd(s): round(s)

RS: right side

sc: single crochet

sc2tog: single crochet 2 stitches together

sl st: slip stitch

sliding loop: Form a loop of yarn around your fingers, with the end attached to the ball on the right and the tail on the left. Insert hook into the loop under both pieces of yarn and draw up a loop onto hook. (This does not count as your first stitch.) Work first row into the original loop. Pull up the yarn tail after your first row is complete to close the loop.

sp: space

st(s): stitch(es)

tog: together

tr: treble

WS: wrong side

yo: yarn over
