

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SI7FS

(1, 2, 3, 4) [5, 6, 7] $\{8, 9, 10, 11\}$

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Bust: (33, 37, 41, 45) [49, 53, 57] {61, 65, 69, 73}" / (84, 94, 104, 114.5) [124.5, 134.5, 145] {155, 165, 174.5, 185.5} cm

Length: (21½, 21½, 22¼, 22½) [23¼, 23¼, 24½] {24½, 25, 25½, 25¾}" / (54.5, 54.5, 56.5, 57) [59.5, 59.5, 62] {62, 63.5, 65, 65.5} cm

Shown in size 5 (49" / 124.5 cm).

Recommended ease: Approximately 2–4" / 5–10 cm positive ease.

YARN

BERROCO VINTAGE SOCK HANDPAINT (100 g): (2, 2, 2, 2) [2, 2, 3] {3, 3, 3, 3} hanks #12202 Driftwood Shore (C1) BERROCO VINTAGE SOCK (100 g): (2, 2, 2, 2) [2, 3, 3] {3, 3, 3, 3} hanks #12002 Buttercream (C2)

NEEDLES

Two 32" / 80 cm circular needles, size 4 / 3.5 mm *or size to obtain gauge*

32" / 80 cm and 16" / 40 cm circular needles, size 2 / 2.75 mm.

1 set each double-pointed needles, or preferred needles for working small circumferences, size 4 / 3.5 mm and size 2 / 2.75 mm

NOTIONS

1 stitch marker, removeable stitch markers, waste yarn to hold stitches

GAUGE

27 sts and 37 rows = 4" / 10 cm in St st using larger needles Gauge is measured after blocking. To save time and ensure accurate measurements, take time to check gauge.

CONSTRUCTION NOTES

Garment is worked sideways in two sections. Each section is worked from sleeve cuff to center front and back, then joined with 3-needle bind off. Sleeves are worked in the round.

INSTRUCTIONS

RIGHT SECTION

Sleeve: With C1 and smaller dpns or preferred needles for working small circumferences, cast on (74, 74, 74, 74) [82, 82, 84] [90, 90, 90, 90] sts. Divide sts onto 3 needles, place BOR marker and join for working in the round.

[Purl 1 round, knit 1 round] 3 times.

Change to larger needles.

Work even in St st until sleeve measures 1" / 2.5 cm.

Inc Rnd: K1, M1R, knit to last stitch, M1L, k1. 2 sts inc'd.

Rep Inc Rnd every (8th, 8th, 7th, 7th) [7th, 7th, 7th] [8th, 8th, 7th, 7th] round (16, 16, 18, 19) [19, 19, 21] [18, 18, 22, 22] times more. (108, 108, 112, 114) [122, 122, 128] [128, 128, 136, 136] sts.

If necessary, work even until sleeve measures (15, 15, 15, 16) [16, 16, 16] {16, 15, 15, 14}" / (38, 38, 38, 40.5) [40.5, 40.5, 40.5] {40.5, 38, 38, 35.5} cm from cast-on.

Mark last round as end of sleeve. Break yarn, leaving stitches on needle(s).

Note: When picking up stitches along cast-on edge, use the second circular needle.

Body: With larger circular needle and C1, cast on (84, 84, 88, 88) [90, 90, 95] {95, 98, 98, 100} sts. Do not join. Knit these stitches, knit across (108, 108, 112, 114) [122, 122, 128] {128, 128, 136, 136} sleeve stitches, then pick up and knit (84, 84, 88, 88) [90, 90, 95] {95, 98, 98, 100} sts along cast on edge of first (84, 84, 88, 88) [90, 90, 95] {95, 98, 98, 100} sts. (276, 276, 288, 290) [302, 302, 318] {318, 324, 332, 336} sts.

Beginning with a purl row, work even in St st until piece measures (4, 5, 6, 7) [8, 9, 10] {11, 12, 13, 14}" / (10, 12.5, 15, 18) [20.5, 23, 25.5] {28, 30.5, 33, 35.5} cm from sleeve marker, end after completing a RS row.

Divide for Neck: Next Row (WS): Purl (138, 138, 144, 145) [151, 151, 159] {159, 162, 166, 168}, slip remaining (138, 138, 144, 145) [151, 151, 159] {159, 162, 166, 168} sts to waste varn for front.

Back: Knit 1 row, purl 1 row.

Shape Neck: Dec Row (RS): K3, k2tog, knit to end. 1 st dec'd. Rep Dec Row every RS row 6 times more. (131, 131, 137, 138) [144, 144, 152] {152, 155, 159, 161} sts.



Work even until piece measures (8¼, 9¼, 10¼, 11¼) [12¼, 13¼, 14¼] {15¼, 16¼, 17¼, 18¼}" / (21, 23.5, 26, 28.5) [31, 33.5, 36] {38.5, 41.5, 44, 46.5} cm from sleeve marker, end after completing a WS row. Break yarn and slip live stitches to waste yarn.

Front: Slip (138, 138, 144, 145) [151, 151, 159] {159, 162, 166, 168} sts from waste yarn to needle. Join C1 to WS at shoulder and purl 1 row, knit 1 row, purl 1 row.

Shape Neck: Dec Row (RS): Knit to the last 5 sts, SSK, k3. 1 st dec'd.

Rep Dec Row every RS row 17 times more. (120, 120, 126, 127) [133, 133, 141] {141, 144, 148, 150} sts.

Work even if necessary until piece measures (8¼, 9¼, 10¼, 11¼) [12¼, 13¼, 14¼] {15¼, 16¼, 17¼, 18¼}" / (21, 23.5, 26, 28.5) [31, 33.5, 36] {38.5, 41.5, 44, 46.5} cm from sleeve marker, end after completing a WS row. Break yarn and slip live stitches to waste yarn.

LEFT SECTION

Sleeve: With C2 and smaller dpns or preferred needles for working small circumferences, cast on (74, 74, 74, 74) [82, 82, 84] {90, 90, 90, 90} sts. Divide sts onto 3 needles, place BOR marker and join for working in the round.

[Purl 1 round, knit 1 round] 3 times.

Change to larger needles.

Work even in St st until sleeve measures 1" / 2.5 cm.

Inc Rnd: K1, M1R, knit to last stitch, M1L, k1. 2 sts inc'd.

Rep Inc Rnd every (8th, 8th, 7th, 7th) [7th, 7th, 7th] {8th, 8th, 7th, 7th} round (16, 16, 18, 19) [19, 19, 21] {18, 18, 22, 22}

times more. (108, 108, 112, 114) [122, 122, 128] {128, 128, 136, 136} sts.

If necessary, work even until sleeve measures (15, 15, 15, 16) [16, 16, 16] {16, 15, 15, 14}" / (38, 38, 38, 40.5) [40.5, 40.5, 40.5] {40.5, 38, 38, 35.5} cm from cast-on.

Mark last round as end of sleeve. Break yarn, leaving stitches on needle(s).

Note: When picking up stitches along cast-on edge, you may find it easier to use a spare circular needle.

Body: With larger circular needle and C2, cast on (84, 84, 88, 88) [90, 90, 95] {95, 98, 98, 100} sts. Do not join. Knit these stitches, knit across (108, 108, 112, 114) [122, 122, 128] {128, 128, 136, 136} sleeve stitches, then pick up and knit (84, 84, 88, 88) [90, 90, 95] {95, 98, 98, 100} sts along cast on edge of first (84, 84, 88, 88) [90, 90, 95] {95, 98, 98, 100} sts. *(276, 276, 288, 290) [302, 302, 318] {318, 324, 332, 336} sts*

Beginning with a purl row, work even in St st until piece measures (4, 5, 6, 7) [8, 9, 10] {11, 12, 13, 14}" / (10, 12.5, 15, 18) [20.5, 23, 25.5] {28, 30.5, 33, 35.5} cm from sleeve marker, end after completing a WS row.

Divide for Neck: Next Row (RS): Knit (138, 138, 144, 145) [151, 151, 159] {159, 162, 166, 168}, slip remaining (138, 138, 144, 145) [151, 151, 159] {159, 162, 166, 168} sts to waste yarn for front.

Back: Purl 1 row, knit 1 row, purl 1 row.

Shape Neck: Dec Row (RS): Knit to the last 5 sts, SSK, k3. *1 st dec'd*.

Rep Dec Row every RS row 6 times more. (131, 131, 137, 138) [144, 144, 152] {152, 155, 159, 161} sts.

Work even until piece measures (8¼, 9¼, 10¼, 11¼) [12¼, 13¼, 14¼] {15¼, 16¼, 17¼, 18¼}" / (21, 23.5, 26, 28.5) [31, 33.5, 36] {38.5, 41.5, 44, 46.5} cm from sleeve marker, end after completing a WS row. Break yarn and slip live stitches to waste yarn.

Front: Slip (138, 138, 144, 145) [151, 151, 159] {159, 162, 166, 168} sts from waste yarn to needle. Join C2 to RS at shoulder and knit 1 row, purl 1 row.

Shape Neck: Dec Row (RS): K3, k2tog, knit to end. 1 st dec'd. Rep Dec Row every RS row 17 times more. (120, 120, 126, 127) [133, 133, 141] {141, 144, 148, 150} sts.

Work even if necessary until piece measures (8¼, 9¼, 10¼, 11¼) [12¼, 13¼, 14¼] {15¼, 16¼, 17¼, 18¼}" / (21, 23.5, 26, 28.5) [31, 33.5, 36] {38.5, 41.5, 44, 46.5} cm from sleeve marker, end after completing a WS row. Break yarn and slip live stitches to waste yarn.

FINISHING

Slip (120, 120, 126, 127) [133, 133, 141] {141, 144, 148, 150} sts of each front section onto separate circular needles. Hold pieces together with WS facing each other (RS out). Using C2, work 3-needle bind off. Join stitches of back sections together in same manner.

Lower Edging: With RS facing, using smaller 32" / 80 cm circular needle and C2, pick up and knit (216, 242, 270, 296) [324, 350, 378] {404, 432, 458, 486} sts along the entire lower edge of the sweater. Exact stitch count is not crucial, but must be an even number. Place marker and join for working in the round. Work even in k1, p1 ribbing for 1" / 2.5 cm. Bind off in ribbing.

Weave in all ends and block as desired.

STANDARD ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

BOR: beginning of round

dec: decrease

dpn(s): double pointed needle(s)

inc: increase

k2tog: knit 2 stitches together

M1L: Make 1 Left—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1R: Make 1 Right—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

rnd(s): round(s)


RS: right side

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

st(s): stitch(es)

St st: Stockinette Stitch—Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round.

WS: wrong side

- **B** (Shoulder Width): (4, 5, 6, 7) [8, 9, 10] {11, 12, 13, 14}" / (10, 12.5, 15, 18) [20.5, 23, 25.5] {28, 30.5, 33, 35.5} cm
- **C** (Length to Underarms): (13½, 13½, 14, 14) [14¼, 14¼, 15] {15, 15½, 15½, 15¾}" / (34.5, 34.5, 35.5, 35.5) [36, 36, 38] {38, 39.5, 39.5, 40} cm
- **D** (Armhole Length): (8, 8, 8¼, 8½) [9, 9, 9½] {9½, 9½, 10, 10}" / (20.5, 20.5, 21, 21.5) [23, 23, 24] {24, 25.5, 25.5} cm
- **E** (Upper Sleeve Circumference): (16, 16, 16½, 17) [18, 18, 19] {19, 19, 20, 20}" / (40.5, 40.5, 42, 43) [45.5, 45.5, 48.5] {48.5, 48.5, 51, 51} cm
- **F** (Lower Sleeve Circumference): (11, 11, 11, 11) [12¼, 12¼, 12½] {13¼, 13¼, 13¼, 13¼, 13¼}" / (28, 28, 28, 28) [31, 31, 32] {33.5, 33.5, 33.5, 33.5} cm
- **G** (Sleeve Length): (15, 15, 15, 16) [16, 16, 16] {16, 15, 15, 14}" / (38, 38, 38, 40.5) [40.5, 40.5, 40.5] {40.5, 38, 38, 35.5} cm
- **H** (Total Length): (21½, 21½, 22¼, 22½) [23¼, 23¼, 24½] {24½, 25, 25½, 25¾}" / (54.5, 54.5, 56.5, 57) [59.5, 59.5, 62] {62, 63.5, 65, 65.5} cm
- I (Front Neck Depth): 2¾" / 7 cm
