YARN

BERROCO VINTAGE (100 grs):

5 (5, 6, 7, 7, 8, 8, 9) hanks #5194

Breezeway

NEEDLES and NOTIONS

Knitting needles, sizes 7 (4.50 mm) and 8 (5.00 mm) *or size to obtain gauge*

Spare knitting needle, size 8 (5.00 mm)

2 stitch holders

Six 1" buttons

GAUGE

18 sts and 24 rows = 4" in St st on larger needles

To save time and ensure accurate measurements, take time to check gauge.

BACK

With smaller needles, cast on 75 (83, 91, 99, 111, 119, 127, 135) sts.

Set Up Rib: Row 1 (RS): K3, * p1, k3; rep from * across.

Row 2: P3, * k1, p3; rep from * across. Rep these 2 rows until piece measures 3" from beginning, end on WS, dec 1 (1, 0, 0, 1, 1, 0, 0) st each end of last row—73 (81, 91, 99, 109, 117, 127, 135) sts. Change to larger needles and work even in St st until piece measures 4 (4, 4½, 4½, 5, 5, 5)" from beginning, end on WS. Dec 1 st each end of next row, then every 3" twice more—67 (75, 85, 93, 103, 111, 121, 129) sts. Work even until piece measures 12 (12, 12½, 12½, 13, 13, 13)" from beginning, end on WS. Inc 1 st each end of next row, then every 2" twice more—73 (81, 91, 99, 109, 117, 127, 135) sts. Work even until piece measures 16 (16, 16½, 16½, 17, 17, 17, 17)" from beginning, end on WS.

Shape Armholes: Bind off 4 (4, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11) sts at beginning of the next 2 rows—65 (73, 79, 85, 93, 99, 107, 113) sts. Dec 1 st each side every RS row 5 (7, 8, 9, 11, 12, 13, 14) times—55 (59, 63, 67, 71, 75, 81, 85) sts. Work even until armholes measure 7 (7, 7½, 8, 8½, 9, 9½, 10)", end on WS.

Shape Shoulders: Bind off 4 (4, 4, 6, 6, 6, 7, 9) sts at beginning of the next 2 rows, then 3 (4, 5, 5, 6, 7, 8, 8) sts at beginning of the next 4 rows. Bind off remaining 35 sts for back neck.

FRONT

Work as for back until piece measures 5 (5, 5½, 5½, 6, 6, 6)", end on WS—71 (79, 89, 97, 107, 115, 127, 135) sts. Mark center 45 sts on last row.

Divide for Pocket: Next Row (RS): Knit to first marker, sm, * K1, M1, slip M1 to holder held in FRONT; rep from * to second marker (45 sts on holder), sm, knit to end—71 (79, 89, 97, 107, 115, 127, 135) sts. Work as for back until piece measures 10 (10, 10½, 10½, 11, 11, 11, 11)" from beginning, end on WS—67 (75, 85, 93, 103, 111, 121, 129) sts. Leave stitches on spare needle.

Pocket: With WS facing, slip 45 sts from holder to larger needle. Join yarn and purl 1 row, end on WS. Work even in St st for 2 rows, end on WS.



Dec Row (RS): K1, k2tog, knit to last 3 sts, SSK, k1—2 sts dec'd. Rep Dec Row every 6th row 3 times more—37 sts. Work even until pocket measures the same as front, end on WS.

Joining Row (RS): K15 (19, 24, 28, 33, 37, 38, 42) sts of front; hold needle with pocket stitches parallel and in front of needle holding front stitches, * insert point of RH needle through first stitch of pocket and first stitch of front and knit these 2 sts together; rep from * until all pocket sts have been worked, knit to end—67 (75, 85, 93, 103, 111, 121, 129) sts. Work as for back until piece measures 16 (16, 16½, 16½, 17, 17, 17, 17)" from beginning, end on WS—73 (81, 91, 99, 109, 117, 127, 135) sts. Mark center 17 sts on last row, with 25 (29, 34, 38, 43, 47, 52, 56) sts on each side of markers.

Shape Armholes and Neck: Next Row (RS): Bind off 4 (4, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11) sts, knit to first marker, slip 24 (28, 31, 34, 38, 41, 45, 48) sts just worked to holder for left side; bind off center 17 sts, removing markers, knit to end—28 (32, 37, 41, 46, 50, 55, 59) sts.

Right Side: Next Row (WS): Bind off 4 (4, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11) sts, then work to end—24 (28, 31, 34, 38, 41, 45, 48) sts. Dec 1 st at armhole edge every RS row 5 (7, 8, 9, 11, 12, 13, 14) times. AT THE SAME TIME, dec 1 st at neck edge every 4th row 9 times. When all decs have been completed, work



even on 10 (12, 14, 16, 18, 20, 23, 25) sts until armhole measures 7 (7, 7½, 8, 8½, 9, 9½, 10)", end on RS. Bind off 4 (4, 4, 6, 6, 6, 7, 9) sts at armhole edge once, then 3 (4, 5, 5, 6, 7, 8, 8) sts twice for shoulder.

Left Side: With WS facing, slip 24 (28, 31, 34, 38, 41, 45, 48) sts from holder to larger needle. Join yarn and purl 1 WS row. Dec 1 st at armhole edge every RS row 5 (7, 8, 9, 11, 12, 13, 14) times. AT THE SAME TIME, dec 1 st at neck edge every 4th row 9 times. When all decs have been completed, work even on 10 (12, 14, 16, 18, 20, 23, 25) sts until armhole measures 7 (7, 7½, 8, 8½, 9, 9½, 10)", end on WS. Bind off 4 (4, 4, 6, 6, 6, 7, 9) sts at armhole edge once, then 3 (4, 5, 5, 6, 7, 8, 8) sts twice for shoulder.

SLEEVES

With smaller needles, cast on 41 sts. Work in ribbing as for back for 3", end on WS. Change to larger needles. Working in St st, inc 1 st each side every 12th (12th, 8th, 6th, 6th, 4th, 4th) row 7 (7, 9, 11, 13, 16, 18, 20) times—55 (55, 59, 63, 67, 73, 77, 81) sts. Work even until sleeve measures 18" from beginning, end on WS.

Shape Cap: Bind off 4 (4, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11) sts at beginning of the next 2 rows—47 (47, 47, 49, 51, 55, 57, 59) sts. Dec 1 st each side every RS row 11 (11, 12, 15, 15, 15, 15, 14) times, then EVERY row 8 (8, 6, 4, 4, 6, 6, 8) times, end on WS—9 (9, 11, 11, 13, 13, 15, 15) sts. Work even on 9 (9, 11, 11, 13, 13, 15, 15) sts for saddle (narrow strip that runs along shoulder) for 2 (2½, 3, 3½, 4, 4½, 5, 5½)", end on WS. Bind off.

FINISHING

Sew side edges of saddles to back and front shoulders and sleeve caps to armhole edges.

Left Neck Insert: With smaller needles, cast on 17 sts.

Ribbing: Row 1 (RS): K1tbl, * p1tbl, k1tbl; rep from * across.

Row 2: P1tbl, * k1tbl, p1tbl; rep from * across. Work in ribbing as established, inc 1 st at beginning of RS rows every RS row 15 times, then every 4th row twice, working incs into ribbing—34 sts. Work even until piece measures 8 (8, 8½, 9, 9½, 10, 10½, 11)" from beginning, end on WS. Slip sts onto holder. Mark placement of 5 buttons along straight edge, the first 1" up from lower edge, the last ½" below stitches on holder and the others evenly spaced between.

Right Neck Insert: With smaller needles, cast on 23 sts.

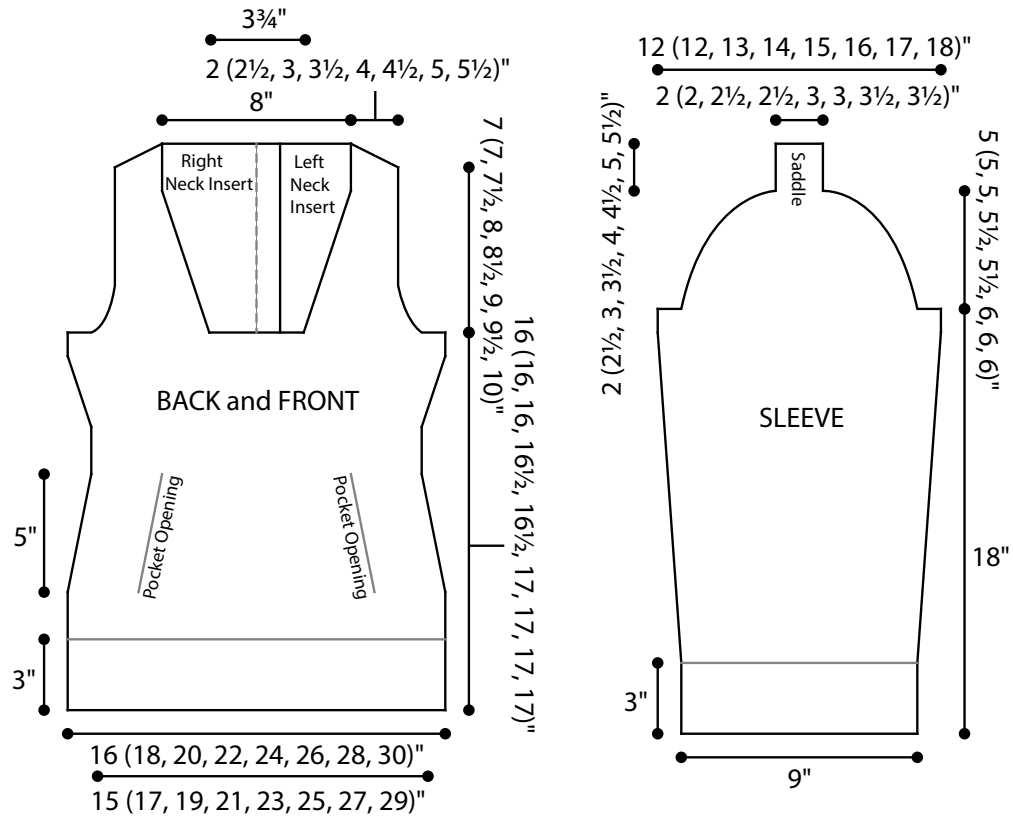
Working in twisted ribbing as for left neck insert, inc 1 st at end of RS rows every RS row 15 times, then every 4th row twice, working incs into ribbing—40 sts. AT THE SAME TIME, when piece measures 1" from beginning, end on WS.

Buttonhole Row (RS): Work 3 sts, yo, k2tog, work to end.

Make 4 more buttonholes opposite markers on left neck insert. When all incs have been completed, work even until piece measures 8 (8, 8½, 9, 9½, 10, 10½, 11)", end on RS. DO NOT break off yarn.

Neckband: With RS facing, using needle holding 40 stitches of right neck insert, pick up and knit 11 (11, 13, 13, 15, 15, 17, 17) sts across top of right saddle, 37 sts across back neck edge, 11 (11, 13, 13, 15, 15, 17, 17) sts across top of left saddle, then work 34 sts from left holder—133 (133, 137, 137, 141, 141, 145, 145) sts. Beginning with Row 2, work in ribbing as for left neck insert until neckband measures 1", end on WS. Make buttonhole on next row, then work even until band measures 2" from beginning, end on WS. Bind off in ribbing. Sew slanted edges of neck inserts to front neck edges. Lap right neck insert over left and sew cast-on edges of inserts to bound-off edge of front neck, working through double thickness of inserts. Sew on buttons.

Pocket Ribbing: With RS facing, using smaller needles, pick up and knit 33 sts along edge of pocket. Beginning with Row 2, work in ribbing as for left neck insert for ½", end on WS. Bind off in ribbing. Repeat on second pocket. Sew side edges of pocket ribbing to front. Sew side and sleeve seams. Weave in all ends and block as desired.



STANDARD ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

beg: beginning

CC: contrasting color

CDD: Centered Double Decrease—Slip 2 together (as if to k2tog), knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over

cn: cable needle

dec: decrease

dpn(s): double pointed needle(s)

end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong Side row.

end on RS: end having just completed a Right Side row

Garter St: Knit EVERY row when working back and forth in rows. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working in the round.

inc: increase

k: knit

k tbl: knit through the back loop(s)

k2tog: knit 2 stitches together

k3tog: knit 3 stitches together

kfb: knit in the front and back of the next st

LH: left hand

LLI: Left Lifted Increase—Insert LH needle into the purl bump one row below the st just worked on the RH needle and knit into this st (1 st inc'd)

M1: Make 1—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1L: Make 1 Left—Work as for M1.

M1p: Make 1 purl—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1pL: Make 1 purl Left—Work as for M1p.

M1pR: Make 1 purl Right—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

M1R: Make 1 Right—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

MC: main color

p: purl

p tbl: purl through the back loop(s)

p2tog: purl 2 stitches together

p3tog: purl 3 stitches together

pat(s): pattern(s)

pm: place marker

psso: pass slipped stitch over knit stitch

rep: repeat

Rev St st: Reverse Stockinette Stitch—Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round.

RH: right hand

RLI: Right Lifted Increase—Insert RH needle into the purl bump of the next st on the LH needle and knit into this st (1 st inc'd)

rnd(s): round(s)

RS: right side

sl: slip

sm: slip marker

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

SSP: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, transfer these 2 stitches back to left hand needle, purl 2 together through the back loops.

SSSK: Slip 3 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 3 stitches and knit 3 together.

st(s): stitch(es)

St st: Stockinette Stitch—Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round.

tbl: through back loop(s)

w&t: wrap and turn, a method of concealing a hole created in short row shaping. On RS rows: With yarn held in front, slip next stitch purlwise, then bring yarn between needles to the back. Slip that same stitch back to the left needle. Turn your work. On WS Rows: With yarn held in back, slip next stitch purlwise, then bring yarn between needles to the front. Slip that same stitch back to the left needle. Turn your work. Unless otherwise indicated, each time you come to a wrapped stitch when working subsequent rows, slip the wrap back over stitch and onto needle, then work the wrap together with its accompanying stitch.

WS: wrong side

wyib: with yarn in back

wyif: with yarn in front

yo: yarn over
