NEEDLES and NOTIONS Knitting needles, sizes 5 / 3.75 mm and 7 / 4.5 mm or size to obtain 16" / 40 cm circular needle, size 5 / 3.75 mm 1 stitch marker Waste yarn to hold stitches

GAUGE

20 sts and 27 rows = 4'' / 10 cm in Pattern Stitch on larger needles Gauge is measured after blocking. To save time and ensure accurate measurements, take time to check gauge.

CONSTRUCTION NOTES

Back and front are worked flat, separately, then seamed at shoulders. Stitches for sleeves are picked up and worked flat down to the cuff.

PATTERN STITCH

Multiple of 8 sts + 7

Row 1 (RS): K3, * yo, sl 1, k1, psso, k6; rep from * across, end last rep k2 instead of k6.

Row 2 and all WS rows: Purl.

Row 3: K2, * yo, sl 1, k2tog, psso, yo, k5; rep from * across, end last rep k2 instead of k5.

Rows 5, 7, 9, 15, 17, and 19: Knit.

Row 11 (RS): K7, * yo, sl 1, k1, psso, k6; rep from * across. **Row 13:** K6, * yo, sl 1, k2tog, psso, yo, k5; rep from * across, end last rep k6 instead of k5.

Row 20: Purl.

Rep these 20 rows for Pattern Stitch.

BACK

With smaller needles, cast on (95, 103, 111, 119) [127, 135, 143, 151] {159, 167, 175, 183} sts.

Set Up Rib: Row 1 (WS): P1, * k1, p1; rep from * across.

Row 2 (RS): K1, * p1, k1; rep from * across.

Rep these 2 rows until piece measures 1" / 2.5 cm from cast-on, end on RS.

Change to larger needles and purl 1 row, knit 1 row, then



purl 1 row, end on WS. Work even in Pattern Stitch until piece measures 10½" / 26.5 cm from cast-on, end on WS. Mark beginning and end of last row for beginning of armholes. Work even until armholes measure (6½, 7, 7, 7½) [7½, 8, 8, 8½] {8½, 9, 9, 9½}" / (16.5, 18, 18, 19) [19, 20.5, 20.5, 21.5] {21.5, 23, 23, 24} cm from markers, end on WS.

Shape Neck: Next Row (RS): Work (30, 34, 38, 42) [46, 50, 54, 58] {62, 66, 70, 74} sts, slip these stitches to waste yarn for right side, bind off center 35 sts, work to end—(30, 34, 38, 42) [46, 50, 54, 58] {62, 66, 70, 74} sts.

Left Side: Dec 1 st at neck edge EVERY row 4 times—(26, 30, 34, 38) [42, 46, 50, 54] {58, 62, 66, 70} sts. Work even until armhole measures (7½, 8, 8, 8½) [8½, 9, 9, 9½] {9½, 10, 10, 10½}" / (19, 20.5, 20.5, 21.5) [21.5, 23, 23, 24] {24, 25.5, 25.5, 26.5} cm from marker, end on RS.

Shape Shoulder: Bind off (13, 15, 17, 19) [21, 23, 25, 27] {29, 31, 33, 35} sts at beginning of the next 2 WS rows.

Right Side: With WS facing, slip (30, 34, 38, 42) [46, 50, 54, 58] {62, 66, 70, 74} sts from waste yarn to larger needle. Work 1 WS row. Dec 1 st at neck edge EVERY row 4 times— (26, 30, 34, 38) [42, 46, 50, 54] {58, 62, 66, 70} sts. Work even until armhole measures (7½, 8, 8, 8½) [8½, 9, 9, 9½] {9½, 10, 10, 10½}" / (19, 20.5, 20.5, 21.5) [21.5, 23, 23, 24] {24, 25.5, 25.5, 26.5} cm from marker, end on WS.

Shape Shoulder: Bind off (13, 15, 17, 19) [21, 23, 25, 27] {29, 31, 33, 35} sts at beginning of the next 2 RS rows.



FRONT

Work as for back until armholes measure (5, 5½, 5½, 6) [6, 6½, 6½, 7] {7, 7½, 7½, 8}" / (12.5, 14, 14, 15) [15, 16.5, 16.5, 18] {18, 19, 19, 20.5} cm from markers, end on WS.

Shape Neck: Next Row (RS): Work (30, 34, 38, 42) [46, 50, 54, 58] {62, 66, 70, 74} sts, slip these stitches to waste yarn for left side, bind off center 35 sts, then work to end—(30, 34, 38, 42) [46, 50, 54, 58] {62, 66, 70, 74} sts.

Right Front: Work 1 WS row. Dec 1 st at neck edge EVERY row 4 times—(26, 30, 34, 38) [42, 46, 50, 54] {58, 62, 66, 70} sts. Work even until armhole measures (7½, 8, 8, 8½) [8½, 9, 9, 9½] {9½, 10, 10, 10½}" / (19, 20.5, 20.5, 21.5) [21.5, 23, 23, 24] {24, 25.5, 25.5, 26.5} cm from marker, end on RS.

Shape Shoulder: Bind off (13, 15, 17, 19) [21, 23, 25, 27] {29, 31, 33, 35} sts at beginning of the next 2 WS rows.

Left Front: With WS facing, slip (30, 34, 38, 42) [46, 50, 54, 58] {62, 66, 70, 74} sts from waste yarn to larger needle. Join yarn and work 1 WS row. Dec 1 st at neck edge EVERY row 4 times—(26, 30, 34, 38) [42, 46, 50, 54] {58, 62, 66, 70} sts. Work even until armhole measures (7½, 8, 8, 8½) [8½, 9, 9, 9½] {9½, 10, 10, 10½}" / (19, 20.5, 20.5, 21.5) [21.5, 23, 23, 24] {24, 25.5, 25.5, 26.5} cm from marker, end on WS.

Shape Shoulder: Bind off (13, 15, 17, 19) [21, 23, 25, 27] {29, 31, 33, 35} sts at beginning of the next 2 RS rows.

SLEEVES

With RS facing, using larger needles, pick up and knit (71, 79, 79, 87) [87, 87, 87, 95] {95, 103, 103, 103} sts along entire armhole edge between markers. Purl 1 row, knit 1 row, purl 1 row, end on WS. Work even in Pattern Stitch until sleeve measures 1" / 2.5 cm from picked-up stitches, end on WS. Dec Row (RS): K1, k2tog, work to last 3 sts, SSK, k1—2 sts dec'd. Rep Dec Row every (30th, 16th, 16th, 10th) [10th, 10th, 10th, 8th] {8th, 6th, 6th, 6th} row (2, 5, 5, 8) [8, 7, 7, 10] {10, 13, 13, 12} times more—(65, 67, 67, 69) [69, 71, 71, 73] {73, 75, 75, 77} sts. Work even until sleeve measures 13" / 33 cm from picked-up stitches, end on RS. Change to smaller needles and work in ribbing as for back for 1" / 2.5 cm, end on WS. Bind off loosely in ribbing.




FINISHING

Neckband: With RS facing, using circular needle, begin at left shoulder seam, pick up and knit 122 sts around entire neck edge. Place marker and join for working in the round. Work even in k1, p1 ribbing for 1" / 2.5 cm. Bind off loosely in ribbing.

Sew side and sleeve seams. Weave in all ends and block as desired.

Sew shoulder seams.

{37, 38, 38, 39.5] cm **J** (Cuff Length): 1" / 2.5 cm **K** (Sleeve Length): 14" / 35.5 cm

CDD: Centered Double Decrease—Slip 2 together (as if to

k2tog), knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over

cn: cable needledec: decrease

dpn(s): double pointed needle(s)

end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong Side row. end on RS: end having just completed a Right Side row Garter St: Knit EVERY row when working back and forth in rows. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working in the round.

inc: increasek: knit

k tbl: knit through the back loop(s)k2tog: knit 2 stitches togetherk3tog: knit 3 stitches together

kfb: knit in the front and back of the next st

LH: left hand

LLI: Left Lifted Increase—Insert LH needle into the purl bump one row below the st just worked on the RH needle and knit into this st (1 st inc'd)

M1: Make 1—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1L: Make 1 Left—Work as for M1.

M1p: Make 1 purl—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1pL: Make 1 purl Left—Work as for M1p.

M1pR: Make 1 purl Right—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

M1R: Make 1 Right—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

MC: main color

p: purl

p tbl: purl through the back loop(s)p2tog: purl 2 stitches togetherp3tog: purl 3 stitches together

pat(s): pattern(s)
pm: place marker

psso: pass slipped stitch over knit stitch

rep: repeat

Rev St st: Reverse Stockinette Stitch—Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round.

RH: right hand

RLI: Right Lifted Increase—Insert RH needle into the purl bump of the next st on the LH needle and knit into this st (1

st inc'd)

rnd(s): round(s)
RS: right side

sl: slip

sm: slip marker

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together. **SSP:** Slip 2 stitches knitwise, transfer these 2 stitches back to left hand needle, purl 2 together through the back loops.

SSSK: Slip 3 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 3 stitches and knit 3 together.

st(s): stitch(es)

St st: Stockinette Stitch—Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round.

tbl: through back loop(s)

w&t: wrap and turn, a method of concealing a hole created in short row shaping. On RS rows: With yarn held in front, slip next stitch purlwise, then bring yarn between needles to the back. Slip that same stitch back to the left needle. Turn your work. On WS Rows: With yarn held in back, slip next stitch purlwise, then bring yarn between needles to the front. Slip that same stitch back to the left needle. Turn your work. Unless otherwise indicated, each time you come to a wrapped stitch when working subsequent rows, slip the wrap back over stitch and onto needle, then work the wrap together with its accompanying stitch.

WS: wrong side

wyib: with yarn in backwyif: with yarn in front

yo: yarn over
