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FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Cowl Neck Circumference: 23" / 57.5 cm

Lower Edge Circumference: 47" / 117.5 cm

Length: 14 ½" / 36.5 cm

YARN

BERROCO BRINA (50 g): 3 balls

NEEDLES

16" / 40 cm and 32" / 80 cm circular needle, sizes 9 / 5.5 mm or size to obtain gauge

NOTIONS

Stitch markers (1 a different color for BOR),
Tapestry needle

GAUGE

16 sts and 26 rnds = 4" / 10 cm in St st

Gauge is measured after blocking. To save time and ensure accurate measurements, take time to check gauge.

CONSTRUCTION NOTES

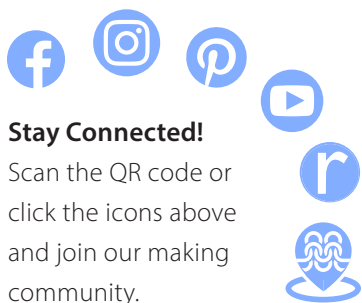
Capelet is worked from the neck down in rounds.

We recommend using yarns called for in our instructions. Every effort has been made to ensure that directions contained in this pattern are accurate and complete, however errors do occur. We cannot be responsible for variance of individual knitters, human or typographical errors.

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CAPELET INSTRUCTIONS

With 16" / 40 cm circular needle, cast on 92 sts. Do not join.

Set Up Row (RS): K23, pm, k46, pm, knit to end.

Place BOR marker and join for working in the round.

[Purl 1 round, knit 1 round] 3 times, slipping markers.

Set Up Pattern: Next Rnd: * Knit to 2 sts before marker, SSK, yo, sm, k1, yo, k2tog; rep from * once more, knit to end.

Knit 1 rnd.

Rep last 2 rnds 15 times more.

Inc Rnd: * Knit to marker, yo, sm, k1, yo; rep from * once more, knit to end. *4 sts inc'd.*

Knit 1 rnd.

Rep the last 2 rnds 23 times more. *188 sts.*

[Purl 1 round, knit 1 round] 3 times, slipping markers.

Bind off purlwise.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends and block as desired.

STANDARD ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

BOR: beginning of round

inc: increase

k: knit

k2tog: knit 2 stitches together

pm: place marker

rep: repeat

rnd(s): round(s)

RS: right side

sm: slip marker

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left-hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

st(s): stitch(es)

St st: Stockinette Stitch—Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round.

yo: yarn over
