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## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Lower Edge: Approximately 42" / 106.5 cm around

Top Edge: Approximately 24" / 61 cm around

Length: Approximately 14" / 35.5 cm high

## YARN

**BERROCO MIRELLE** (100 g): 3 hanks #11810 Ocean Storm

## NEEDLES

32" / 80 cm and 16" / 40 cm circular needles, sizes 8 / 5 mm and 10 / 6 mm *or size to obtain gauge*

## NOTIONS

Cable needle, stitch marker, tapestry needle

## GAUGE

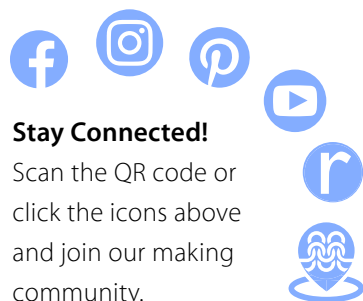
15 sts and 22 rows = 4" / 10 cm in St st using larger needle  
*Gauge is measured after blocking. To save time and ensure accurate measurements, take time to check gauge.*

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## SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

**5/5 LC:** Sl 5 to cn and hold to FRONT, k5, k5 from cn

**5/5 RC:** Sl 5 to cn and hold to BACK, k5, k5 from cn

**4/4 LC:** Sl 4 to cn and hold to FRONT, k4, k4 from cn

**4/4 RC:** Sl 4 to cn and hold to BACK, k4, k4 from cn

**3/3 LC:** Sl 3 to cn and hold in FRONT, k3, k3 from cn

**3/3 RC:** Sl 3 to cn and hold in BACK, k3, k3 from cn

**2/2 LC:** Sl 2 to cn and hold in FRONT, k2, k2 from cn

**2/2 RC:** Sl 2 to cn and hold in BACK, k2, k2 from cn

## CONSTRUCTION NOTES

Cowl is worked from the bottom up in the round and shaped to narrow towards the top. Pattern may be worked either by using directions below or by following chart.



## COWL INSTRUCTIONS

**Note:** Pattern is worked 9 times around. When there are too few stitches to fit comfortably on larger 32" / 80 cm needle, change to larger 16" / 40 cm needle.

With smaller 32" / 80 cm circular needle, cast on 153 sts, place BOR marker and join for working in the round.

Purl 1 rnd, knit 1 rnd, purl 1 rnd.

Change to larger 32" / 80 cm needle.

**Rnd 1:** \* K8, M1, k9, M1; rep from \* around. *171 sts.*

**Rnds 2–8:** Knit.

**Rnd 9:** \* K7, 5/5 LC, k2; rep from \* around.

**Rnds 10–18:** Knit.

**Rnd 19:** \* K2, 5/5 RC, k7; rep from \* around.

**Rnd 20 (Dec Rnd):** \* K6, SSK, k11; rep from \* around. *162 sts.*

**Rnds 21–23:** Knit.

**Rnd 24 (Dec Rnd):** \* K11, k2tog, k5; rep from \* around. *153 sts.*

**Rnd 25:** \* K7, 4/4 LC, k2; rep from \* around.

**Rnds 26–31:** Knit.

**Rnd 32 (Dec Rnd):** \* K5, SSK, k10; rep from \* around. *144 sts.*

**Rnd 33:** \* K2, 4/4 RC, k6; rep from \* around.

**Rnds 34–40:** Knit.

**Rnd 41:** \* K6, 4/4 LC, k2; rep from \* around.

**Rnd 42 (Dec Rnd):** \* K9, k2tog, k5; rep from \* around. *135 sts.*

**Rnds 43–45:** Knit.

**Rnd 46 (Dec Rnd):** \* K4, SSK, k9; rep from \* around. *126 sts.*

**Rnd 47:** \* K2, 3/3 RC, k6; rep from \* around.

**Rnds 48–51:** Knit.

**Rnd 52 (Dec Rnd):** \* K8, k2tog, k4; rep from \* around. *117 sts.*

**Rnd 53:** \* K5, 3/3 LC, k2; rep from \* around.

**Rnds 54–57:** Knit.

**Rnd 58:** \* K2, 3/3 RC, k5; rep from \* around.

**Rnds 59–63:** Knit.

**Rnd 64:** \* K5, 3/3 LC, k2; rep from \* around.

**Rnd 65 (Dec Rnd):** \* K7, k2tog, k4; rep from \* around. *108 sts.*

**Rnd 66:** Knit.

**Rnd 67 (Dec Rnd):** \* K2, SSK, k8; rep from \* around. *99 sts.*

**Rnd 68:** \* K2, 2/2 RC, k5; rep from \* around.

**Rnds 69 and 70:** Knit.

**Rnd 71 (Dec Rnd):** \* K6, k2tog, k3; rep from \* around. *90 sts.*



**Rnd 72:** \* K4, 2/2 LC, k2; rep from \* around.

**Rnds 73 and 74:** Knit.

**Rnd 75 (Dec Rnd):** \* K5, SSK, k3; rep from \* around. *81 sts.*

Change to smaller 16" / 40 cm circular needle.

Purl 1 rnd, knit 1 rnd, purl 1 rnd.

Bind off.

## FINISHING

Weave in all ends and block as desired.

▧ 2/2 RC: sl 2 to cn and hold to BACK, k2, k2 from cn

▧ 2/2 LC: sl 2 to cn and hold to FRONT, k2, k2 from cn

▧ 3/3 LC: sl 3 to cn and hold to FRONT, k3, k3 from cn

▧ 3/3 RC: sl 3 to cn and hold to BACK, k3, k3 from cn

▧ 4/4 LC: sl 4 to cn and hold to FRONT, k4, k4 from cn

▧ 4/4 RC: sl 4 to cn and hold to BACK, k4, k4 from cn

▧ 5/5 LC: sl 5 to cn and hold to FRONT, k5, k5 from cn

▧ 5/5 RC: sl 5 to cn and hold to BACK, k5, k5 from cn

## CHART NOTES

Work from right to left on every round.

## STANDARD ABBREVIATIONS &amp; TERMS

**beg:** beginning

**BOR:** beginning of round

**cn:** cable needle

**dec:** decrease

**inc:** increase

**k:** knit

**k2tog:** knit 2 stitches together

**M1:** Make 1—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

**rnd(s):** round(s)

**RS:** right side

**sm:** slip marker

**SSK:** Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

**st(s):** stitch(es)
