## SIZES

Directions are for girl's size Large (8-10), X-Large (14) as well as women's sizes (see Finished Measurements).

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Bust (closed): (28, 30, 32, 36) [40, 44, 47, 53] {57, 60, 66, 68½"} / (71, 76, 81.5, 91.5) [101.5, 112, 119.5, 134.5] {145, 152.5, 167.5, 174} cm  
Length: (22¾, 22¾, 23¼, 23¾) [24¾, 25¾, 25¾, 26¼] {26¼, 26¾, 26¾, 27¼}" / (58, 58, 59, 60) [63, 65.5, 65.5, 66.5] {66.5, 68, 68, 69} cm  
Shown in size 28" / 71 cm.  
Recommended ease: 2-4" / 5-10 cm positive ease.

## YARN

**BERROCO VINTAGE** (100 grs): (4, 5, 5, 6) [7, 7, 8, 8] {9, 9, 10, 10} hanks  
**BERROCO #51182 Indigo (MC)** and  
1 hank **#5192 Chana Dal (CC)**

## NEEDLES and NOTIONS

Knitting needles, sizes 6 / 4 mm and 8 / 5 mm *or size to obtain gauge*  
32" / 80 cm circular needle, size 6 / 4 mm  
2 double-pointed needles, size 6 / 4 mm  
1 stitch holder

## GAUGE

18 sts and 24 rows = 4" / 10 cm in St st on larger needles  
*To save time and ensure accurate measurements, take time to check gauge.*

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We recommend using yarns called for in our instructions. Every effort has been made to ensure that directions contained in this book are accurate and complete, however errors do occur. We cannot be responsible for variance of individual knitters, human or typographical errors.

All pattern PDFs are updated when corrections are made. In the event of finding an error, please make sure you've downloaded the most recent version.

## NOTE

When changing colors, hold yarn to the left and pick up new color from underneath. This twists yarn so there are no holes.

## BACK

With smaller needles, using CC, cast on (65, 69, 73, 83) [89, 99, 107, 117] {127, 133, 147, 153} sts. Work even in St st for 1" / 2.5 cm, end on RS. Knit 1 row on WS for turning ridge. Change to larger needles and work even in St st until piece measures 2" / 5 cm from beginning, end on WS. Join MC and work in St st.

**Establish Chart: Next Row (RS):** With MC, knit (0, 2, 0, 1) [0, 1, 1, 2] {3, 2, 1, 0} st(s), work Row 1 of Chart to last (0, 2, 0, 1) [0, 1, 1, 2] {3, 2, 1, 0} st(s), knit to end. Work even in pattern as established until 22 rows of chart have been completed, end on WS, (dec 1, dec 1, dec 1, dec 1) [inc 1, inc 1, dec 1, inc 1] {inc 1, inc 1, inc 1, inc 1} stitch at end of last row—(64, 68, 72, 82) [90, 100, 106, 118] {128, 134, 148, 154} sts. Fasten off CC and from here work in MC only.

Dec 1 st each side on next row, then every (10th, 10th, 12th, 12th) [12th, 12th, 12th, 12th] {12th, 12th, 12th, 12th} twice more—(58, 62, 66, 76) [84, 94, 100, 112] {122, 128, 142, 148} sts. Work even until piece measures (11, 11, 11½, 11½) [12, 12½, 12½, 12½] {12½, 12½, 12½, 12½}" / (28, 28, 29, 29) [30.5, 32, 32, 32] {32, 32, 32, 32} cm from beginning, end on WS. Inc 1 st each side on next row, then every 1½" / 4 cm twice more—(64, 68, 72, 82) [90, 100, 106, 118] {128, 134, 148, 154} sts. Work even until piece measures (15, 15, 15½, 15½) [16, 16½, 16½, 16½] {16½, 16½, 16½, 16½}" / (38, 38, 39.5, 39.5) [40.5, 42, 42, 42] {42, 42, 42, 42} cm from beginning, end on WS.

**Shape Raglan Armholes:** Bind off (4, 4, 4, 5) [7, 10, 10, 11] {11, 12, 12, 13} sts at beginning of the next 2 rows—(56, 60, 64, 72) [76, 80, 86, 96] {106, 110, 124, 128} sts.

**For Sizes 47" / 119.5 cm, 53" / 134.5 cm, 57" / 145 cm, 60" / 152.5 cm, 66" / 167.5, and 68½" / 174 cm ONLY:** **Dec Row 1 (RS):** K2, k3tog, knit to the last 5 sts, sl 1, k2tog, pssso, k2—4 sts dec'd.

Rep Dec Row 1 every RS row (X, X, X, X) [X, X, 2, 6] {11, 11, 18, 19} times more, end on WS—(X, X, X, X) [X, X, 74, 68] {58,



62, 48, 48} sts.

**For ALL Sizes: Dec Row 2 (RS):** K2, k2tog, knit to last 4 sts, SSK, k2—2 sts dec'd.

Rep Dec Row 2 every RS row (6, 10, 14, 20) [23, 25, 22, 19] {14, 16, 9, 9} times more, then every 4th row (7, 5, 3, 1) [0, 0, 0, 0] {0, 0, 0, 0} times, end on WS. Bind off remaining 28 sts for back neck.

## FRONT

Work as for back until chart has been completed, end on WS—(64, 68, 72, 82) [90, 100, 106, 118] {128, 134, 148, 154} sts.

**Divide for Pocket: Next Row (RS):** K1, SSK, knit (11, 13, 15, 15) [19, 24, 22, 28] {33, 31, 38, 41}, [M1, k1] (36, 36, 36, 46) [46, 46, 56, 56] {56, 66, 66, 66} times, slipping each M1 onto holder held in front for pocket [(36, 36, 36, 46) [46, 46, 56, 56] {56, 66, 66, 66} sts on holder], knit to the last 3 sts, k2tog, k1—(62, 66, 70, 80) [88, 98, 104, 116] {126, 132, 146, 152} sts. Dec 1 st each side every (10th, 10th, 12th, 12th) [12th, 12th, 12th, 12th] {12th, 12th, 12th, 12th} row twice more—(58, 62, 66, 76) [84, 94, 100, 112] {122, 128, 142, 148} sts. Work even until piece measures (11, 11, 11½, 11½) [12, 12½, 12½, 12½] {12½, 12½, 12½, 12½}" / (28, 28, 29, 29) [30.5, 32, 32, 32] {32, 32, 32, 32} cm from beginning, end on WS. Slip all stitches



onto a spare needle ready for a RS row.

**Outer Pocket:** With WS facing, slip (36, 36, 36, 46) [46, 46, 56, 56] {56, 66, 66, 66} sts from holder onto larger needle. Join MC and, beginning with a purl row, work in St st for 1" / 2.5 cm, end on WS.

**Dec Row (RS):** K1, k2tog, knit to last 3 sts, SSK, k1—2 sts dec'd.

Rep Dec Row every 4th row 4 times more—(26, 26, 26, 36) [36, 36, 46, 46] {46, 56, 56, 56} sts. Work even until pocket measures (5½, 5½, 6, 6) [6½, 7, 7, 7] {7, 7, 7, 7}" / (14, 14, 15, 15) [16.5, 18, 18, 18] {18, 18, 18, 18} cm from beginning, end on WS.

**Joining Row (RS):** Join MC and knit (16, 18, 20, 20) [24, 29, 27, 33] {38, 36, 43, 46} sts of front; hold needle with outer pocket stitches in front of LH needle, \* insert point of RH needle through first stitch of outer pocket and first stitch on LH needle and knit these 2 sts together; rep from \* until all pocket sts have been worked, knit remaining (16, 18, 20, 20) [24, 29, 27, 33] {38, 36, 43, 46} sts of front—(58, 62, 66, 76) [84, 94, 100, 112] {122, 128, 142, 148} sts. Purl 1 row. Inc 1 st each side on next row, then every 1½" / 4 cm twice more—(64, 68, 72, 82) [90, 100, 106, 118] {128, 134, 148, 154} sts. AT THE SAME TIME, when piece measures (13, 13, 13½, 13½) [14, 14½, 14½, 14½] {14½, 14½, 14½, 14½}" / (33, 33, 34.5, 34.5) [35.5, 37, 37, 37] {37, 37, 37, 37} cm from beginning,

end on WS. Mark center 6 sts.

**Divide for Front Slit: Next Row (RS):** Knit to first marker, slip stitches just worked to holder for left side, bind off center 6 sts, knit to end.

**Right Upper Front:** Continue to work side incs as before. When all incs have been completed, work even on (29, 31, 33, 38) [42, 47, 50, 56] {61, 64, 71, 74} sts until piece measures (15, 15, 15½, 15½) [16, 16½, 16½, 16½] {16½, 16½, 16½, 16½}" / (38, 38, 39.5, 39.5) [40.5, 42, 42, 42] {42, 42, 42, 42} cm from beginning, end on RS.

**Note:** Please read through this entire next section before starting to knit.

**Shape Raglan Armhole:** Bind off (4, 4, 4, 5) [7, 10, 10, 11] {11, 12, 12, 13} sts at beginning of the next row—(25, 27, 29, 33) [35, 37, 40, 45] {50, 52, 59, 61} sts.

**For Sizes 47" / 119.5 cm, 53" / 134.5 cm, 57" / 145 cm, 60" / 152.5 cm, 66" / 167.5, and 68½" / 174 cm ONLY: Dec Row 1 (RS):** Knit to the last 5 sts, sl 1, k2tog, pss0, k2—2 sts dec'd. Rep Dec Row 1 every RS row (X, X, X, X) [X, X, 2, 6] {11, 11, 18, 19} times more, end on WS—(X, X, X, X) [X, X, 42, 55] {70, 72, 93, 97} sts.

**For ALL Sizes: Dec Row 2 (RS):** Knit to the last 4 sts, SSK, k2—1 st dec'd.

Rep Dec Row 2 every RS row (6, 10, 14, 20) [23, 25, 22, 19] {14, 16, 9, 9} times more, then every 4th row (7, 5, 3, 1) [0, 0, 0, 0] {0, 0, 0, 0} times, end on WS.

AT THE SAME TIME, when armholes measure (4½, 4½, 4½, 5) [5½, 6, 6, 6½] {6½, 7, 7, 7½}" / XXXXXX cm (before all decs have been completed), end on WS.

**Shape Neck:** Bind off 3 sts at beginning of the next row.

Continuing to work armhole decs as before, dec 1 st at neck edge every RS row 7 times. When all decs have been completed, end on WS. Fasten off last stitch.

**Left Upper Front:** Continue to work side incs as before. When all incs have been completed, work even on (29, 31, 33, 38) [42, 47, 50, 56] {61, 64, 71, 74} sts until piece measures (15, 15, 15½, 15½) [16, 16½, 16½, 16½] {16½, 16½, 16½, 16½}" / (38, 38, 39.5, 39.5) [40.5, 42, 42, 42] {42, 42, 42, 42} cm from beginning, end on WS.

**Note:** Please read through this entire next section before starting to knit.

**Shape Raglan Armhole:** Bind off (4, 4, 4, 5) [7, 10, 10, 11] {11, 12, 12, 13} sts at beginning of the next row—(25, 27, 29, 33) [35, 37, 40, 45] {50, 52, 59, 61} sts.

**For Sizes 47" / 119.5 cm, 53" / 134.5 cm, 57" / 145 cm, 60" / 152.5 cm, 66" / 167.5, and 68½" / 174 cm ONLY: Dec Row 1 (RS):** K2, k3tog, knit to end—2 sts dec'd.

Rep Dec Row 1 every RS row (X, X, X, X) [X, X, 2, 6] {11, 11, 18, 19} times more, end on WS—(X, X, X, X) [X, X, 42, 55] {70,

72, 93, 97} sts.

**For All Sizes: Dec Row 2 (RS):** K2, k2tog, knit to end—1 st dec'd.

Rep Dec Row 2 every RS row (6, 10, 14, 20) [23, 25, 22, 19] {14, 16, 9, 9} times more, then every 4th row (7, 5, 3, 1) [0, 0, 0, 0] {0, 0, 0, 0} times, end on WS.

AT THE SAME TIME, when armholes measure (4½, 4½, 4½, 5) [5½, 6, 6, 6½] {6½, 7, 7, 7½}" / XXXXXXXX cm (before all decs have been completed), end on RS.

**Shape Neck:** Bind off 3 sts at beginning of the next row.

Continuing to work armhole decs as before, dec 1 st at neck edge every RS row 7 times. When all decs have been completed, end on WS. Fasten off last stitch.

## SLEEVES

With smaller straight needles, using MC, cast on (50, 50, 54, 58) [64, 68, 72, 76] {80, 84, 88, 92} sts.

**Set Up Rib: Row 1 (RS):** K2, \* p2, k2; rep from \* across.

**Row 2:** P2, \* k2, p2; rep from \* across.

Rep these 2 rows until sleeve measures 3" / 7.5 cm from beginning, end on WS. Change to larger needles and work even in St st until sleeve measures (10, 11, 12, 12) [12, 12, 12, 12] {12, 12, 12, 12}" / (25.5, 28, 30.5, 30.5) [30.5, 30.5, 30.5, 30.5] {30.5, 30.5, 30.5, 30.5} cm from beginning, end on WS.

**Shape Raglan Cap:** Bind off (4, 4, 4, 5) [7, 10, 10, 11] {11, 12, 12, 13} sts at beginning of the next 2 rows—(42, 42, 46, 48) [50, 48, 52, 54] {58, 60, 64, 66} sts.

**Dec Row (RS):** K2, k2tog, knit to the last 4 sts, SSK, k2—2 sts dec'd.

Rep Dec Row every RS row (4, 4, 8, 8) [9, 5, 9, 10] {14, 14, 18, 19} times more, then every 4th row (8, 8, 6, 7) [7, 10, 8, 8] {6, 7, 5, 5} times, end on WS—16 sts. Bind off.

## HOOD

With larger needles, using MC, cast on 90 sts. Work even in St st for 9½" / 60.5 cm, end on WS.

**Shape Top: Next Row (RS):** Knit 45 and slip these sts to holder for right side.

**Left Side: Row 1 (RS):** K2tog, knit to end—44 sts. Purl 1 row. Rep these 2 rows 8 times more, end on WS—36 sts. Bind off.

**Right Side:** With WS facing, slip 45 sts from holder to larger needle. Join MC and purl to end.

**Next Row (RS):** Knit to the last 2 sts, SSK—44 sts. Purl 1 row. Rep these 2 rows 8 times more, end on WS—36 sts. Bind off.

## FINISHING

**Left Pocket Band:** With RS facing, using smaller straight needles, beg 1" / 2.5 cm up from beg of pocket, pick up and

knit (22, 22, 26, 26) [30, 34, 34, 34] {34, 34, 34, 34} sts along left side edge of pocket. Beginning with Row 2, work in ribbing as for sleeves for ½" / 1 cm, end on WS. Bind off in ribbing.


**Right Pocket Band:** Beginning at top of pocket, work as for left pocket band. Sew lower 1" / 2.5 cm at each side of pocket and ends of pocket bands to front. Sew raglan sleeve caps to raglan armholes. Sew top seam of hood. Sew cast-on edge of hood to neck edge, gathering hood if necessary.

**Front/Hood Band:** With RS facing, using circular needle and MC, begin at lower right edge of front slit, pick up and knit (36, 36, 36, 40) [42, 44, 44, 44] {44, 44, 44, 44} sts along right edge of slit, 142 sts along edge of hood, then (36, 36, 36, 40) [42, 44, 44, 44] {44, 44, 44, 44} sts along left edge of slit—(214, 214, 214, 222) [226, 230, 230, 230] {230, 230, 230, 230} sts. Beginning with Row 2, work in ribbing as for sleeves for 1¼" / 32 cm, end on WS. Bind off in ribbing. Lap right end of band over left end of band and sew both ends to sts bound off for front slit. Sew side and sleeve seams. Fold bottom edge to WS along turning ridge and sew in place.

**Drawstring:** With dpn's, using CC, cast on 3 sts and work I-Cord as follows:

**Row 1:** \* K3, do not turn work. Slide stitches to beginning of needle to work next row from RS. Rep from \* until drawstring measures (50, 50, 50, 52) [54, 56, 56, 56] {56, 56, 56, 56}" / (127, 127, 127, 132) [137, 142, 142, 142] {142, 142, 142, 142} cm from beginning. Fasten off. Beginning and ending at front neck edges, weave drawstring in and out of front/hood band as in photo.



- B** (Back Waist Width): (13, 14, 14½, 17) [19, 21, 22, 25] {27, 28½, 31½, 33}" / (33, 35.5, 37, 43) [47, 53.5, 56, 63.5] {68.5, 72.5, 80, 84} cm
- C** (Pocket Width): (8, 8, 8, 10) [10, 10, 12½, 12½] {12½, 14½, 14½, 14½}" / (20.5, 20.5, 20.5, 25.5) [25.5, 25.5, 32, 32] {32, 37, 37, 37} cm

## STANDARD ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

**beg:** beginning

**CC:** contrasting color

**CDD:** Centered Double Decrease—Slip 2 together (as if to k2tog), knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over

**cn:** cable needle

**dec:** decrease

**dpn(s):** double pointed needle(s)

**end on WS:** end having just completed a Wrong Side row.

**end on RS:** end having just completed a Right Side row

**Garter St:** Knit EVERY row when working back and forth in rows. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working in the round.

**inc:** increase

**k:** knit

**k tbl:** knit through the back loop(s)

**k2tog:** knit 2 stitches together

**k3tog:** knit 3 stitches together

**kfb:** knit in the front and back of the next st

**LH:** left hand

**LLI:** Left Lifted Increase—Insert LH needle into the purl bump one row below the st just worked on the RH needle and knit into this st (1 st inc'd)

**M1:** Make 1—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

**M1L:** Make 1 Left—Work as for M1.

**M1p:** Make 1 purl—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

**M1pL:** Make 1 purl Left—Work as for M1p.

**M1pR:** Make 1 purl Right—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

**M1R:** Make 1 Right—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

**MC:** main color

**p:** purl

**p tbl:** purl through the back loop(s)

**p2tog:** purl 2 stitches together

**p3tog:** purl 3 stitches together

**pat(s):** pattern(s)

**pm:** place marker

**pssso:** pass slipped stitch over knit stitch

**rep:** repeat

**Rev St st:** Reverse Stockinette Stitch—Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round.

**RH:** right hand

**RLI:** Right Lifted Increase—Insert RH needle into the purl bump of the next st on the LH needle and knit into this st (1 st inc'd)

**rnd(s):** round(s)

**RS:** right side

**sl:** slip

**sm:** slip marker

**SSK:** Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

**SSP:** Slip 2 stitches knitwise, transfer these 2 stitches back to left hand needle, purl 2 together through the back loops.

**SSSK:** Slip 3 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 3 stitches and knit 3 together.

**st(s):** stitch(es)

**St st:** Stockinette Stitch—Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round.

**tbl:** through back loop(s)

**w&t:** wrap and turn, a method of concealing a hole created in short row shaping. On RS rows: With yarn held in front, slip next stitch purlwise, then bring yarn between needles to the back. Slip that same stitch back to the left needle. Turn your work. On WS Rows: With yarn held in back, slip next stitch purlwise, then bring yarn between needles to the front. Slip that same stitch back to the left needle. Turn your work. Unless otherwise indicated, each time you come to a wrapped stitch when working subsequent rows, slip the wrap back over stitch and onto needle, then work the wrap together with its accompanying stitch.

**WS:** wrong side

**wyib:** with yarn in back

**wyif:** with yarn in front

**yo:** yarn over

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
