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FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Approximately 20" / 50 cm around x 8" / 20.5 cm down center with ribbing folded up, slightly stretched.

YARN

BERROCO AURELIA (100 g): 1 ball #11707 Stormy Slate

NEEDLES

16" / 40 cm circular needles, sizes 4 / 3.5 mm and 6 / 4 mm or size to obtain gauge

Crochet Hook, size G-6 / 4 mm

NOTIONS

Removable stitch markers

GAUGE

19 sts and 28 rows = 4" / 10 cm in St st using larger needle

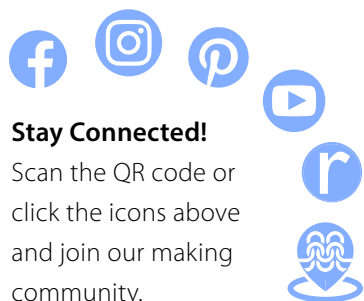
Gauge is measured after blocking. To save time and ensure accurate measurements, take time to check gauge.

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CONSTRUCTION NOTES

Hat is knit in the round from the bottom up; ear flaps are then picked up from brim and worked down. Hat is then closed with a single crochet seam across the top for a flat top look.

INSTRUCTIONS

With smaller needle, cast on 90 sts, place BOR marker and join for working in the round.

Work in k1, p1 ribbing until brim measures 1½" / 4 cm. Change to larger needle.

Work in St st until piece measures 9½" / 24 cm from cast-on edge. Move marker to BOR between brim and body of hat. Bind off.

LEFT EAR FLAP

Fold brim up and then hold hat with folded edge at top. With RS facing, using larger needle, and starting 2¼" / 5.5 cm to the left of the marker, pick up and knit 25 sts along folded edge of brim.



Set Up Row: Purl to last 3 sts, sl 3 wyif (I-cord).

Row 1 (RS): Knit to last 3 sts, sl 3 wyib (I-cord).

Row 2 and all WS rows: Purl to last 3 sts, sl 3 wyif (I-cord).

Row 3: K4, SSK, knit to last 6 sts, k2tog, k1, sl 3 wyib. *2 sts dec'd.*

Row 5: Knit.

Rows 7–10: Rep Rows 3–6. *2 sts dec'd.*

Rows 11–22: Rep Rows 3 and 4 six times. *12 sts dec'd.*

Row 23: K3, CDD, sl 3 wyif. *2 sts dec'd.*

Row 24: K2, SSK, sl 3 wyif. *6 sts.*

Row 25: K6, do not turn. Slide stitches to beg of needle to work next row from RS.

Rep Row 25 until I-cord measures 10" / 25.5 cm long. Bind off.

RIGHT EAR FLAP

Continuing to hold hat with folded edge at top, start 7½" / 19 cm to the right of the marker, pick up and knit 25 sts along folded edge of brim.

Complete Right Ear Flap same as Left Ear Flap.

FINISHING

Lay hat flat with earflaps at each side. With WS facing (RS together), using crochet hook, insert hook into rightmost st of the hat body bind-off, insert through coordinating st on opposite side of hat, pull yarn through and make a sc. Continue closing hat with sc seam, fasten off.

Weave in all ends and block as desired.

STANDARD ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

Note: Berroco patterns use American crochet terms

beg: beginning

BOR: beginning of round

CDD: Centered Double Decrease—Slip 2 together (as if to k2tog), knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over

dec: decrease

k: knit

k2tog: knit 2 stitches together

p: purl

rep: repeat

RS: right side

sc: single crochet

sl: slip

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

st(s): stitch(es)

St st: Stockinette Stitch—Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round.

WS: wrong side

wyib: with yarn in back of work

wyif: with yarn in front of work
