SIZES

(1, 2, 3) [4, 5, 6, 7] {8, 9, 10}

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Bust: (36, 40, 44) [48, 52, 56, 60] {64, 68, 72}" / (91.5, 101.5, 112) [122, 132, 142, 152.5] {162.5, 172.5, 183} cm

Length: (16, 16, 17) [18, 18, 18½, 18½] {20, 20, 21}" / (40.5, 40.5, 43) [45.5, 45.5, 47, 47] {51, 51, 53.5} cm
Shown in size 4.

Recommended ease:

Approximately 2–4" / 5–10 cm positive ease.

YARN

BERROCO GIMLET (50 g): (3, 3, 3) [3, 4, 4, 4] {4, 5, 5} balls #10703 Champagne (C1) and (6, 6, 7) [7, 7, 8, 8] {9, 9, 10} balls #10733 Margarita (C2)

NEEDLES

16" / 40 cm and 32" / 80 cm circular needles, size 10½ / 6.5 mm or size to obtain gauge

1 set double-pointed needles or preferred needles for working small circumferences, size 10½ / 6.5 mm

NOTIONS

Stitch marker
Tapestry needle
Waste yarn to hold stitches

GAUGE

15 sts and 17 rows = 4" / 10 cm in pattern stitch

Gauge is measured after blocking. To save time and ensure accurate measurements, take time to check gauge.

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We recommend using yarns called for in our instructions. Every effort has been made to ensure that directions contained in this pattern are accurate and complete, however errors do occur. We cannot be responsible for variance of individual knitters, human or typographical errors.

All pattern PDFs are updated when corrections are made. In the event of finding an error, please make sure you've downloaded the most recent version.



CONSTRUCTION NOTES

Sweater is worked from the bottom up in the round and then divided at armholes and worked flat in rows. Shoulders are then sewn together and sleeves are picked up and worked down in the round.

PATTERN STITCH (in the round)

Even number of stitches

Rnd 1: Using C1, * slip 1 wyib, k1; rep from * around.

Rnd 2: Using C1, Knit.

Rnd 3: Using C2, * k1, slip 1 wyib; rep from * around.

Rnd 4: Using C2, knit.

Rep these 4 rounds for Pattern St in the round.

PATTERN STITCH (flat in rows)

Even number of stitches

Row 1 (RS): Using C1, * sl 1 wyib, k1; rep from * across.

Row 2: Using C1, purl.

Row 3: Using C2, * k1, sl 1 wyib; rep from * across.

Row 4: Using C2, purl.

Rep these 4 rows for Pattern St flat in rows.

INSTRUCTIONS

BODY

Using C1, cast on (136, 152, 164) [180, 196, 212, 224] {240, 256, 272} sts, place BOR marker and join for working in the round.

Knit one round

Rnd 1: Using C1, * slip 1 wyib, k1; rep from * around.

Rnd 2: Using C2, * k1, slip 1 wyib; rep from * around.

Rep last two rounds 3 times more.

Using C2, purl one round.

Work even in Pattern St in the round until piece measures (7, 7, 7) [8, 8, 8, 8] {9, 9, 9}" / (18, 18, 18) [20.5, 20.5, 20.5, 20.5] {23, 23, 23} cm from cast-on, end having just completed Rnd 2 of pattern.

Divide for Back and Front: Next Row (RS): Work the first (68, 76, 82) [90, 98, 106, 112] {120, 128, 136} sts in pattern as established, slip the stitches just worked to waste yarn for back, work in pattern as established to end. (68, 76, 82) [90, 98, 106, 112] {120, 128, 136} sts.

Front: Beginning with Row 4, work even in Pattern St flat in rows until piece measures (5, 5, 6) [6, 6, 6½, 6½] {7, 7, 8}" / (12.5, 12.5, 15) [15, 15, 16.5, 16.5] {18, 18, 20.5} cm from dividing row, end having just completed Row 3 of pattern.

Divide for Neck: Next Row (WS): Using C2, purl (26, 30, 33) [37, 41, 45, 48] {52, 56, 60} sts, slip these stitches to waste yarn for Right Front, bind off 16 sts for Front Neck Edge, then purl to end. (26, 30, 33) [37, 41, 45, 48] {52, 56, 60} sts.

Left Front: Shape Neck: Next Row (RS): Using C1, * sl 1 wyib, k1; rep from * across.

Dec Row (WS): Using C1, P1, p2tog, purl to end. 1 st dec'd

Next Row (RS): Using C2, * k1, sl 1 wyib; rep from * across.

Dec Row (WS): Using C2, P1, p2tog, purl to end. 1 st dec'd
Rep the last 4 rows 3 times more (8 sts dec'd total). (18, 22, 25) [29, 33, 37, 40] {44, 48, 52} sts

Work even in pattern as established until armhole measures (9, 9, 10) [10, 10, 10½, 10½] {11, 11, 12}" / (23, 23, 25.5) [25.5, 25.5, 26.5, 26.5] {28, 28, 30.5} cm, end having just completed a WS row. Bind off.

Right Front: With RS facing, slip (26, 30, 33) [37, 41, 45, 48] {52, 56, 60} sts from waste yarn to needle. Join C1 at neck edge.

Next Row (RS): * K1, sl 1 wyib; rep from * to end.

Dec Row (WS): Using C2, purl to last 3 sts, p2tog, p1.
1 st dec'd

Next Row (RS): Using C2, * k1, sl 1 wyib; rep from * to end.

Dec Row (WS): Using C1, purl to last 3 sts, p2tog, p1.
1 st dec'd

Rep the last 4 rows 3 times more (8 sts dec'd total). (18, 22, 25) [29, 33, 37, 40] {44, 48, 52} sts

Work even in pattern as established until armhole measures (9, 9, 10) [10, 10, 10½, 10½] {11, 11, 12}" / (23, 23, 25.5) [25.5, 25.5, 26.5, 26.5] {28, 28, 30.5} cm, end having just completed a WS row. Bind off.

Back: With WS facing, slip (68, 76, 82) [90, 98, 106, 112] {120, 128, 136} Back stitches from waste yarn to needle. Join C2.

Next Row (WS): With C2, Purl.

Row 1 (RS): Using C1, * slip 1 wyib, k1, rep from * across.

Row 2 (WS): Using C1, Purl.

Row 3 (RS): Using C2, * k1, slip 1 wyib, rep from * across.

Row 4 (WS): Using C2, purl.

Rep the last 4 rows until back measures (8, 8, 9) [9, 9, 9½, 9½] {10, 10, 11}" / (20.5, 20.5, 23) [23, 23, 24, 24] {25.5, 25.5, 28} cm from dividing row, end having just completed Row 3 of pattern.

Next Row (WS): With C2, purl (20, 24, 27) [31, 35, 39, 42] {46, 50, 54} sts, sl these stitches to waste yarn for Left Back, bind off the next 28 sts purl wise, then purl to end. (20, 24, 27) [31, 35, 39, 42] {46, 50, 54} sts

Right Back: Shape Neck: Next Row (RS): Using C1, * sl 1 wyib, k1; rep from * across.

Dec Row (WS): Using C1, P1, p2tog, purl to end. 1 st dec'd

Next Row (RS): Using C2, * k1, sl 1 wyib, rep from * across.

Dec Row (WS): Using C2, P1, p2tog, purl to end. 1 st dec'd
Bind off all stitches knitwise with C2.

Left Back: With RS facing you, slip (20, 24, 27) [31, 35, 39, 42] {46, 50, 54} sts from waste yarn to needle and reattach C1 at armhole.



Next Row (RS): Using C1, * sl 1 wyib, k1; rep from * across.

Dec Row (WS): Using C1, purl to last 3 sts, p2tog, p1.
1 st dec'd

Next Row (RS): Using C2, * k1, sl 1 wyib, rep from * across.

Dec Row (WS): Using C2, purl to last 3 sts, p2tog, p1.
1 st dec'd

Bind off all stitches knitwise with C2.

Sew shoulder seams.

SLEEVES

With RS facing, using 16" / 40 cm circular needle and C2, begin at underarm, pick up and knit (68, 68, 76) [76, 76, 80, 80] {84, 84, 92} sts evenly spaced around the entire armhole edge. Place BOR marker and join for working in the round. Work even in St st until sleeve measures (12½, 12½, 12) [12, 12, 12, 12] {12, 12, 11½}" / (31.5, 31.5, 30.5) [30.5, 30.5, 30.5, 30.5] {30.5, 30.5, 29} cm from shoulder.

Dec Rnd: Knit (15, 15, 17) [17, 17, 18, 18] {19, 19, 21} sts, k2tog, pm, rep from * 3 times more, omitting last pm (BOR marker is already there). 4 sts dec'd

Next Rnd: Knit.

Dec Rnd: * Knit to 2 sts before marker, k2tog, sm, rep from * around. 4 sts dec'd

Rep the last 2 rows (7, 7, 8) [8, 8, 8, 8] {8, 8, 9} times more. (32, 32, 36) [36, 36, 40, 40] {44, 44, 48} sts
Change to smaller needle.

Ribbing: Next Rnd: * P1, k1; rep from * around.
Work in ribbing as established for 1½" / 4 cm. Bind off in ribbing.

FINISHING

Neckband: With RS facing, using 16" / 40 cm circular needle and C2, begin at right shoulder seam, pick up and knit 28 sts across back neck edge, (12, 12, 16) [16, 16, 16, 16] {18, 18, 22} sts along left front neck edge, 16 sts along front neck edge, then (12, 12, 16) [16, 16, 16, 16] {18, 18, 22} sts along right front neck edge.
(68, 68, 76) [76, 76, 76, 76] {76, 76, 84} sts

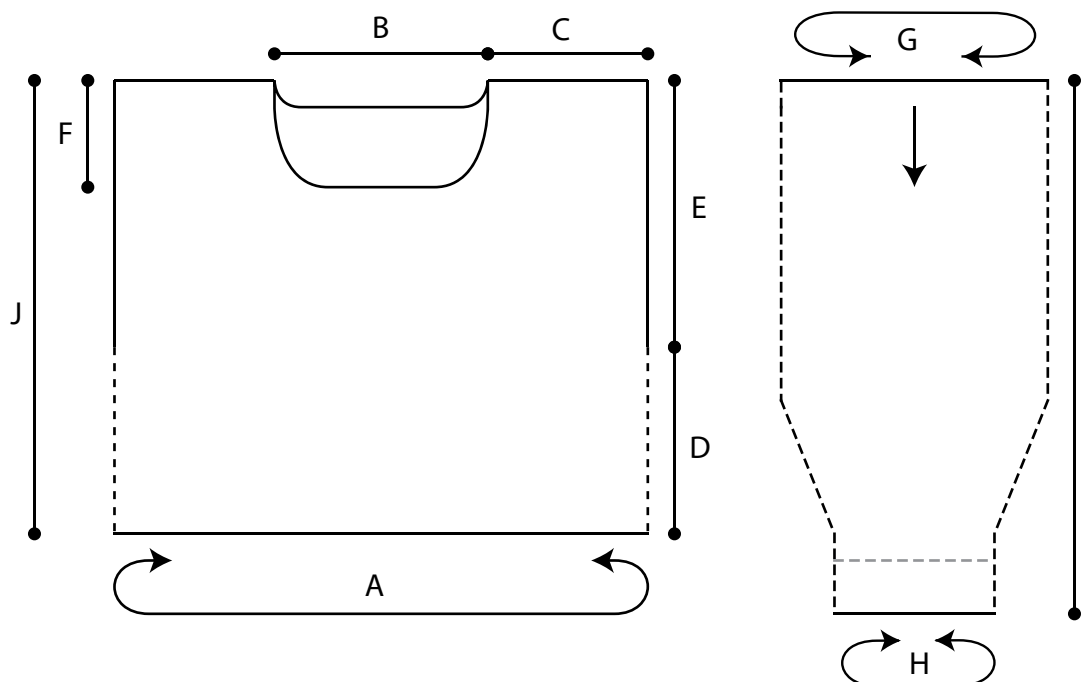
Note: Exact stitch count is not crucial, but it needs to be an even number.

Place marker and join for working in the round. Work in k1, p1 ribbing for 2" / 6 cm.

Bind off in ribbing.

Weave in all ends and block as desired.

- A** (Bust Circumference): (36, 40, 44) [48, 52, 56, 60] {64, 68, 72}" / (91.5, 101.5, 112) [122, 132, 142, 152.5] {162.5, 172.5, 183} cm
- B** (Back Neck Width): 8½" / 21.5 cm
- C** (Shoulder Width): (4¾, 5¾, 6¾) [7¾, 8¾, 9¾, 10¾] {11¾, 12¾, 13½}" / (12, 14.5, 17) [19.5, 22, 25, 27.5] {30, 32.5, 35} cm
- D** (Length to Underarms): (7, 7, 7) [8, 8, 8, 8] {9, 9, 9}" / (18, 18, 18) [20.5, 20.5, 20.5, 20.5] {23, 23, 23} cm
- E** (Armhole Length): (9, 9, 10) [10, 10, 10½, 10½] {11, 11, 12}" / (23, 23, 25.5) [25.5, 25.5, 26.5, 26.5] {28, 28, 30.5} cm
- F** (Front Neck Depth): 4" / 10 cm
- G** (Upper Sleeve Circumference): (18, 18, 20) [20, 20, 21, 21] {22, 22, 24}" / (45.5, 45.5, 51) [51, 51, 53.5, 63.5] {56, 56, 61} cm
- H** (Sleeve Cuff Circumference): (8½, 8½, 9½) [9½, 9½, 10½, 10½] {11½, 11½, 12½}" / (21.5, 21.5, 24) [24, 24, 26.5, 26.5] {29, 29, 31.5} cm
- I** (Sleeve Length): 18" / 45.5 cm
- J** (Total Length): (16, 16, 17) [18, 18, 18½, 18½] {20, 20, 21}" / (40.5, 40.5, 43) [45.5, 45.5, 47, 47] {51, 51, 53.5} cm

STANDARD ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

beg: beginning
BOR: beginning of round
CC: contrasting color
CDD: Centered Double Decrease—Slip 2 together (as if to k2tog), knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over
cn: cable needle
dec: decrease
dpn(s): double pointed needle(s)
end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong Side row.
end on RS: end having just completed a Right Side row
Garter St: Knit EVERY row when working back and forth in rows. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working in the round.
inc: increase
k: knit
k tbl: knit through the back loop(s)
k2tog: knit 2 stitches together
k3tog: knit 3 stitches together
kfb: knit in the front and back of the next st
LH: left hand
LLI: Left Lifted Increase—Insert LH needle into the purl bump one row below the st just worked on the RH needle and knit into this st (1 st inc'd)
M1: Make 1—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).
M1L: Make 1 Left—Work as for M1.
M1p: Make 1 purl—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).
M1pL: Make 1 purl Left—Work as for M1p.
M1pR: Make 1 purl Right—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).
M1R: Make 1 Right—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).
MC: main color
p: purl
p tbl: purl through the back loop(s)
p2tog: purl 2 stitches together
p3tog: purl 3 stitches together
pat(s): pattern(s)
pm: place marker

pss: pass slipped stitch over knit stitch
rep: repeat
Rev St st: Reverse Stockinette Stitch—Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round.
RH: right hand
RLI: Right Lifted Increase—Insert RH needle into the purl bump of the next st on the LH needle and knit into this st (1 st inc'd)
rnd(s): round(s)
RS: right side
sl: slip
sm: slip marker
SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.
SSP: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, transfer these 2 stitches back to left hand needle, purl 2 together through the back loops.
SSSK: Slip 3 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 3 stitches and knit 3 together.
st(s): stitch(es)
St st: Stockinette Stitch—Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round.
tbl: through back loop(s)
w&t: wrap and turn, a method of concealing a hole created in short row shaping. On RS rows: With yarn held in front, slip next stitch purlwise, then bring yarn between needles to the back. Slip that same stitch back to the left needle. Turn your work. On WS Rows: With yarn held in back, slip next stitch purlwise, then bring yarn between needles to the front. Slip that same stitch back to the left needle. Turn your work. Unless otherwise indicated, each time you come to a wrapped stitch when working subsequent rows, slip the wrap back over stitch and onto needle, then work the wrap together with its accompanying stitch.
WS: wrong side
wyib: with yarn in back
wyif: with yarn in front
yo: yarn over
