SIZES

(1, 2, 3) [4, 5, 6]

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Back Shoulder Width: (10½, 12, 13½) [15, 16¼, 18]" / (26.5,

30.5, 34.5) [38, 41.5, 45.5] cm

Back Length: (16, 17, 18) [19, 20, 21]" / (40.5, 43, 45.5) [48.5,

51, 53.5] cm

Shown in size 4 (15" / 38 cm). Recommended ease: Approximately 2–4" / 5–10 cm positive ease.

Note: The fit of this garment is very forgiving and each size will fit multiple sizes depending on the amount of overlap you want. To determine your size, go by the back shoulder width and the armhole measurement given on schematic.

YARN

BERROCO SPLASH (50 g): (5, 6, 7) [8, 9, 10] hanks #5454 Laguna

NEEDLES

Knitting needles, size 6 / 4 mm or size to obtain gauge

NOTIONS

3 st markers

GAUGE

22 sts and 30 rows = 4" in St st

Gauge is measured after blocking. To save time and ensure accurate measurements, take time to check gauge



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CONSTRUCTION NOTES

Back and Front are worked flat separately then sewn together, matching numbers on schematic.



INSTRUCTIONS

BACK

Cast on (80, 88, 96) [104, 112, 120] sts.

Set-Up Row (RS): Knit (29, 33, 37) [41, 45, 49], pm, k22, pm, knit (29, 33, 37) [41, 45, 49]. Beginning with a purl row, work even in St st until piece measures 1" / 2.5 cm from cast-on, end after completing a WS row.

Dec Row (RS): Knit 1 st before to first marker, SSK, removing marker, pm, knit to 1 st before second marker, pm, k2tog, removing marker, knit to end. *2 sts dec'd*.

Repeat Dec Row every 4th row (4, 2, 0) [0, 0, 0] times more, then every 6th row (6, 8, 10) [10, 10, 10] times. (58, 66, 74) [82, 90, 98] sts (no sts remain between markers).

Removing markers, work even until piece measures (8½, 9, 9½) [10, 10½, 11]" / (21.5, 23, 24) [25.5, 26.5, 28] cm from cast-on, end after completing a WS row. Mark beginning and end of last row for beginning of armholes. Work even until armholes measure (6, 6½, 7) [7½, 8, 8½]" / (15, 16.5, 18) [19, 20.5, 21.5] cm, end after completing a WS row.

Shape Shoulders: Bind off (2, 3, 4) [5, 6, 7] sts at beginning of the next (6, 8, 10) [8, 6, 4] rows then (3, 4, 0) [4, 5, 6] sts at beginning of the next (4, 2, 0) [2, 4, 6] rows. Bind off remaining 34 sts for back neck.

LEFT FRONT

Cast on (86, 90, 94) [100, 104, 108] sts. Work even in St st until piece measures (8½, 9, 9½) [10, 10½, 11]" / (21.5, 23, 24) [25.5, 26.5, 28] cm from cast-on, end after completing a WS row. Mark end of last row for beginning of armhole.

Shape Armhole: Next Row (RS): Bind off 20 sts, knit to end. (66, 70, 74) [80, 84, 88] sts.

Purl 1 row.

Inc Row (RS): K2, M1, knit to end. 1 st inc'd.

Repeat Inc Row every RS row (16, 15, 13) [11, 9, 7] times more, then every 4 rows (3, 4, 6) [8, 10, 12] times. (86, 90, 94) [100, 104, 108] sts.

Work even until piece measures (18%, 19%, 21) [22%, 23%, 24%]" / (47.5, 50, 53.5) [56.5, 59.5, 62.5] cm from cast-on, end after completing a WS row. Bind off.

RIGHT FRONT

Work same as Left Front until piece measures (8½, 9, 9½) [10, 10½, 11]" / (21.5, 23, 24) [25.5, 26.5, 28] cm from cast-on, end after completing a RS row. Mark beginning of last row for beginning of armhole.

Shape Armhole: Next Row (WS): Bind off 20 sts, purl to end. (66, 70, 74) [80, 84, 88] sts.


Inc Row (RS): Knit to the last 2 sts, M1, k2. 1 st inc'd.

Repeat Inc Row every RS row (16, 15, 13) [11, 9, 7] times more, then every 4 rows (3, 4, 6) [8, 10, 12] times. (86, 90, 94) [100, 104, 108] sts.

Work even until piece measures (18¾, 19¾, 21) [22¼, 23½, 24¾]" / (47.5, 50, 53.5) [56.5, 59.5, 62.5] cm from cast-on, end after completing a WS row. Bind off.

FINISHING

Sew shoulder and side seams, matching numbers shown on diagram. Weave in all ends and block as desired.



LENI MEASUREMENTS

- **A** (Lower Back Width): (14½, 16, 17½) [19, 20½, 22]" / (37, 40.5, 44.5) [48.5, 52, 56] cm
- **B** (Back Bust Width): (10½, 12, 13½) [15, 16½, 18]" / (26.5, 20.5, 34.5) [38, 42, 45.5] cm
- C (Back Neck Width)" 6" / 15 cm
- **D** (Back Shoulder Width): (2¼, 3, 3¾) [4½, 5¾, 6]" / (57, 7.5, 9.5) [11.5, 14.5, 15] cm
- **E** (Length to Underarms): (8½, 9, 9½) [10, 10½, 11]" / (21.5, 23, 24) [25.5, 26.5, 28] cm
- **F** (Armhole Length): (6, 6½, 7) [7½, 8, 8½}" / (15, 16.5, 18) [19, 20.5, 21.5] cm
- **G** (Lower Front Width): (15¾, 16½, 17¼) [18, 18¾, 19½]" / (40, 42, 44) [45.5, 47.5, 49.5] cm
- H (Front Armhole Width): 3½"/9 cm

STANDARD ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

dec: decrease
inc: increase

k: knit

k2tog: knit 2 stitches together

M1: Make 1—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

p: purl

pm: place markerrep: repeatRS: right side

sl: slip

sm: slip marker

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

st(s): stitch(es)

St st: Stockinette Stitch—Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round.

WS: wrong side
