(1, 2, 3, 4) [4, 5, 6] {7, 8, 9, 10}

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Bust: (32½, 36½, 40½, 44½) [48½, 52½, 56½] {60½, 64½, 68½, 72½}" / (82.5, 92.5, 103, 113) [123, 133.5, 143.5] {153.5, 164, 174, 184} cm

Length: (16½, 16¾, 17, 17½) [18, 18½, 19] {19¼, 19¼, 20, 20¼}" / (42, 42.5, 43, 44.5) [45.5, 47, 48.5] {49, 49, 51, 51.5} cm (including straps)

Shown in size 36½" / 92.5 cm, modeled with approximately 2" / 5 cm positive ease

Recommended ease: 0–2" / 0–5 cm positive ease.

YARN

BERROCO MODERN LINEN (100 g): (1, 2, 2, 2) [2, 2, 2] {3, 3, 3, 3} hanks #11332 Nocturnal

NEEDLES

24–32" / 60–80 cm circular needles, sizes 3 / 3.25 mm and 5 / 3.75 mm *or size to obtain gauge*

1 set double-pointed needles, size 5 / 3.75 mm for I-cord

NOTIONS

Stitch markers, waste yarn to hold stitches, tapestry needle

GAUGE

20 sts and 32 rows/rnds = 4" / 10 cm in St st using larger needle

Gauge shown is after blocking. To save time and ensure accurate measurements, take time to check gauge.

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CONSTRUCTION NOTES

Camisole is worked in the round from the bottom up to the underarm, then divided for back and front. Integrated I-cord straps complete the camisole.

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INSTRUCTIONS

BODY

With smaller circular needle, cast on (162, 182, 202, 222) [242, 262, 282] {302, 322, 342, 362} sts. Place marker and join for working in the round. Beginning and ending with a purl round, work 7 rounds in Garter St.

Change to larger circular needle.

Work in St st until piece measures 10" / 25.5 cm from caston edge, end (2, 2, 3, 4) [5, 6, 7] {8, 9, 10, 13} sts before BOR marker.

Divide for Front and Back: Next Row (RS): Bind off (15, 20, 24, 28) [34, 36, 40] {44, 48, 52, 60} sts, removing marker, (1 st remains on RH needle after bind off), knit the next (9, 9, 9, 13) [13, 17, 17] {21, 21, 21, 21} sts and slip these (10, 10, 10, 14) [14, 18, 18] {22, 22, 22, 22} sts to waste yarn for Right Back, bind off (35, 35, 39, 35) [35, 35, 39] {35, 39, 43, 43} sts, (1 st remains on RH needle after bind off), knit the next (9, 9, 9, 13) [13, 17, 17] {21, 21, 21, 21} sts and slip these (10, 10, 10, 14) [14, 18, 18] {22, 22, 22, 22} sts to waste yarn for Left Back, bind off (15, 20, 24, 28) [34, 36, 40] {44, 48, 52, 60} sts, removing marker, (1 st remains on RH needle after bind off), knit the next (37, 42, 46, 50) [54, 58, 62] {66, 70, 74, 76} sts and slip these (38, 43, 47, 51) [55, 59, 63] {67, 71, 75, 77} sts to waste yarn for Left Front, bind off 1 st, knit to end. (38, 43, 47, 51) [55, 59, 63] {67, 71, 75, 77} sts remain for Right Front.

RIGHT FRONT

Work 1 WS row even.

For Sizes (1, 2, 3, X) [X, X, X] {X, X, X, X} ONLY: Dec Row 1 (RS): SI 1 knitwise wyib, k2tog, knit to last 3 sts, SSK, k1tbl. 2 sts dec'd.

Dec Row 2 (WS): Sl 1 purlwise wyif, purl to last 2 sts, SSP, p1. *1 st dec'd (at neck only).*

Rep Dec Rows 1 and 2 (5, 0, 0, X) [X, X, X] {X, X, X, X} times more. (20, 40, 44, X) [X, X, X] {X, X, X, X} sts.

For ALL Sizes: Dec Row 1 (RS): Sl 1 knitwise wyib, k2tog, knit to last 3 sts, SSK, k1tbl. 2 sts dec'd.

Dec Row 2 (WS): Sl 1 purlwise wyif, p2tog, purl to last 2 sts, SSP, p1. *2 sts dec'd*.

Rep Dec Rows 1 and 2 (3, 8, 9, 7) [3, 4, 5] {1, 2, 3, 1} more times. (4, 4, 4, 19) [39, 39, 39] {59, 59, 59, 69} sts.

For Sizes (X, X, X, 4) [5, 6, 7] {8, 9, 10, 11} ONLY: Dec Row 3 (RS): SI 1 knitwise wyib, k2tog, knit to last 4 sts, SSSK, k1tbl. 3 sts dec'd.

Dec Row 4 (WS): Sl 1 purlwise wyif, p2tog, purl to last 2 sts, SSP, p1. *2 sts dec'd*.



Rep Dec Rows 3 and 4 (X, X, X, 2) [6, 6, 6] {10, 10, 10, 12} more times. *4 sts remain.*

For ALL Sizes: Right Strap: Using dpns, begin working I-cord over remaining 4 sts.

I-Cord: Row 1 (RS): * K4, do not turn. Slide sts to beginning of needle to work next row from RS.

Rep from * until l-cord measures approximately (10, 10½, 10¾, 11½) [12½, 13, 13¾] {14, 13¾, 15, 15½}" / (25.5, 26.5, 27.5, 29) [32, 33, 35] {35.5, 35, 38, 39.5}, sl sts to waste yarn, leaving yarn attached. (You can cut the yarn, but leave a couple yards in case you want to adjust the strap.)

LEFT FRONT

Slip (38, 43, 47, 51) [55, 59, 63] {67, 71, 75, 77} Left Front sts from waste yarn to needle. Rejoin yarn at neck edge and work 1 WS row even.

Sizes (1, 2, 3, X) [X, X, X] {X, X, X, X} ONLY: Dec Row 1 (RS): SI 1 knitwise wyib, k2tog, knit to last 3 sts, SSK, k1tbl. 2 sts dec'd.

Dec Row 2 (WS): Sl 1 purlwise wyif, p2tog, purl to end. *1 st dec'd (at neck only).*

Rep Dec Rows 1 and 2 (5, 0, 0, X) [X, X, X] {X, X, X, X} times more. (20, 40, 44, X) [X, X, X] {X, X, X, X} sts.

For ALL Sizes: Dec Row 1 (RS): SI 1 knitwise wyib, k2tog, knit to last 3 sts, SSK, k1tbl. 2 sts dec'd.

Dec Row 2 (WS): Sl 1 purlwise wyif, p2tog, purl to last 2 sts, SSP, p1. 2 sts dec'd.

Rep Dec Rows 1 and 2 (3, 8, 9, 7) [3, 4, 5] {1, 2, 3, 1} more time(s). (4, 4, 4, 19) [39, 39, 39] {59, 59, 59, 69} sts.

For Sizes (X, X, X, 4) [5, 6, 7] {8, 9, 10, 11} ONLY: Dec Row 3 (RS): Sl 1 knitwise wyib, k3tog, knit to last 3 sts, SSK, k1tbl. 3 sts dec'd.

Dec Row 4 (WS): Sl 1 purlwise wyif, p2tog, purl to last 2 sts, SSP, p1. *2 sts dec'd*.

Rep Dec Rows 3 and 4 (X, X, X, 2) [6, 6, 6] {10, 10, 10, 12} more times. *4 sts remain.*

For ALL Sizes: Left Strap: Using dpns, begin working I-cord over remaining 4 sts as for right strap.

LEFT BACK

Slip (10, 10, 10, 14) [14, 18, 18] {22, 22, 22, 22} Left Back sts from waste yarn to needle. Rejoin yarn with WS facing.

Dec Row 1 (WS): SI 1 purlwise wyif, SSP, purl to last 3 sts, p2tog, p1. *2 sts dec'd*.

Dec Row 2 (RS): SI 1 knitwise wyib, k2tog, knit to last 3 sts, SSK, k1tbl. *2 sts dec'd*.

Rep Dec Rows 1 and 2 (0, 0, 0, 1) [1, 2, 2] {3, 3, 3, 3} more time(s). 6 sts remain.

Dec Row 3 (WS): SI 1 purlwise wyif, SSP, p2tog, p1. *4 sts remain.*

Cut yarn, leaving an end for weaving in. Place Left Front sts on one dpn to check the fit of strap before grafting if desired, and adjust length if needed. Graft Left Front and Left Back sts together.

RIGHT BACK

Slip (10, 10, 10, 14) [14, 18, 18] {22, 22, 22, 22} Right Back sts from waste yarn to needle and work same as for Left Back.


FINISHING

Weave in all ends and block as desired.

STANDARD ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

BOR: beginning of round CC: contrasting color dec: decrease **dpn(s):** double pointed needle(s) end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong Side row. end on RS: end having just completed a Right Side row Garter St: Knit EVERY row when working back and forth in rows. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working in the round. inc: increase k: knit **k tbl:** knit through the back loop(s) k2tog: knit 2 stitches together LH: left hand p: purl p2tog: purl 2 stitches together pm: place marker rep: repeat RH: right hand rnd(s): round(s) RS: right side sl: slip sm: slip marker SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together. SSP: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, transfer these 2 stitches back to left hand needle, purl 2 together through the back loops. st(s): stitch(es) St st: Stockinette Stitch—Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round. WS: wrong side

wyib: with yarn in back wyif: with yarn in front
