



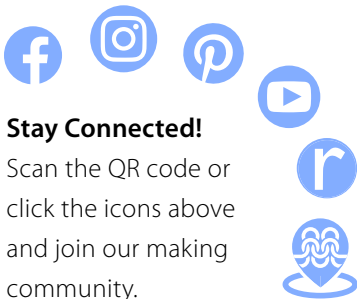

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## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Hat: 22" / 56 cm around x 11" / 28 cm high

Cowl: 30¾" / 78 cm around x 13" / 33 cm high

## YARN

**BERROCO VINTAGE HANDPAINT** (100 g): 1 hank #5203  
Wisteria Dream for hat and 2 hanks for cowl

## NEEDLES

For Hat: 16" / 40 cm circular needles, sizes 5 / 3.75 mm and 7 / 4.5 mm *or size to obtain gauge*

1 set double-pointed needles, or preferred needles for working small circumferences in the round, size 7 / 4.5 mm

For Cowl: 24" / 60 cm circular needles, sizes 5 / 3.75 mm and 7 / 4.5 mm *or size to obtain gauge*

## NOTIONS

Stitch marker and tapestry needle

## GAUGE

20 sts and 28 rnds = 4" / 10 cm in St st on larger needles

*Gauge is measured after blocking. To save time and ensure accurate measurements, take time to check gauge.*

## CONSTRUCTION NOTES

Both Hat and Cowl are worked in the round from the bottom up.

## PATTERN STITCH

Worked over 22 sts

**Rnds 1–12:** Knit.

**Rnd 13:** \* K3, insert RH needle into the stitch 5 rnds below the third stitch on LH needle and loosely pull yarn through forming a long loop, k3, make another long loop in same stitch, k3, make another long loop in same stitch, k13; rep from \* around.

**Note:** Do not make the loops too tight.

**Rnd 14:** \* K2, knit the next stitch and the first loop together, k2, knit the next stitch and the second loop together, k2, knit the next stitch and the third loop together, k13; rep from \* around.

**Rnds 15–26:** Knit.

**Rnd 27:** \* K14, insert RH needle into the stitch 5 rnds below the third stitch on LH needle and loosely pull yarn through forming a long loop, k3, make another long loop in same stitch, k3, make another long loop in same stitch, k2; rep from \* around.

**Note:** Do not make the loops too tight.

**Rnd 28:** \* K13, knit the next stitch and the first loop together, k2, knit the next stitch and the second loop together, k2, knit the next stitch and the third loop together, k2; rep from \* around.

Repeat Rnds 1–28 for pattern.

## INSTRUCTIONS

### HAT

Using smaller needle, cast on 110 sts using a tubular method (or preferred cast-on). Place BOR marker and join for working in the round.

**Set Up Rib: Rnd 1:** \* K1, p1; rep from \* around.

Work in ribbing as established until piece measures 4" / 10 cm from cast-on.

Change to larger needle.

Work Rounds 1–28 of Pattern Stitch, then knit 2 rounds. Hat should measure approximately 8" / 20 cm from cast-on.

**Note:** As you decrease for top, when there are too few stitches to fit comfortably on circular needle, change to dpns or preferred needles for working small circumferences in the round.

**Shape Top:** Remove marker, k5, replace marker for new BOR.

**Dec Rnd 1:** \* K1, k2tog, k17, SSK; rep from \* around. 100 sts.

Knit 3 rounds.

**Dec Rnd 2:** \* K1, k2tog, k15, SSK; rep from \* around. 90 sts.

Knit 3 rounds.

**Dec Rnd 3:** \* K1, k2tog, k13, SSK; rep from \* around. 80 sts.

Knit 1 round.

**Dec Rnd 4:** \* K1, k2tog, k11, SSK; rep from \* around. 70 sts.

Knit 1 round.

**Dec Rnd 5:** \* K1, k2tog, k9, SSK; rep from \* around. 60 sts.

Knit 1 round.

**Dec Rnd 6:** \* K1, k2tog, k7, SSK; rep from \* around. 50 sts.

Knit 1 round.

**Dec Rnd 7:** \* K1, k2tog, k5, SSK; rep from \* around. 40 sts.

Knit 1 round.

**Dec Rnd 8:** \* K1, k2tog, k3, SSK; rep from \* around. 30 sts.

Knit 1 round.

**Dec Rnd 9:** \* K1, k2tog, k1, SSK; rep from \* around. 20 sts.

Knit 1 round.

**Dec Rnd 10:** \* K1, CDD; rep from \* around. 10 sts.

## FINISHING

Break yarn leaving an approximately 8" / 20 cm long end. Thread end into tapestry needle and draw through all stitches on needles. Pull up tightly and secure, then fasten off. Weave in all ends and block as desired.

### COWL

Using smaller needle, cast on 154 sts using a tubular method (or preferred cast-on). Place BOR marker and join for working in the round.

**Set Up Rib: Rnd 1:** \* K1, p1; rep from \* around.

Work in ribbing as established until piece measures 2½" / 6.5 cm from cast-on. Change to larger needle.

**Set Up Pattern: Next Rnd:** \* K22, pm; rep from \* around.

Work Rounds 1–28 of Pattern Stitch twice. Cowl should measure approximately 10½" / 26.5 cm from cast-on. Change to smaller needle.

**Set Up Rib: Rnd 1:** \* K1, p1; rep from \* around.

Work in ribbing as established for 2½" / 6.5 cm.

Bind off using a tubular method, or with preferred bind-off.

## FINISHING

Weave in all ends and block as desired.



## STANDARD ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

**BOR:** beginning of round

**CDD:** Centered Double Decrease—Slip 2 together (as if to k2tog), knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over

**dec:** decrease

**dpn(s):** double pointed needle(s)

**k:** knit

**k2tog:** knit 2 stitches together

**LH:** left hand

**p:** purl

**pm:** place marker

**rep:** repeat

**RH:** right hand

**rnd(s):** round(s)

**SSK:** Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

**st(s):** stitch(es)

**St st:** Stockinette Stitch—Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round.
