FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Completed Blanket: Approximately 52" x 64" /
132 cm x 163 cm

Each Block: Approximately 12" / 30.5 cm square

YARN

BERROCO VINTAGE (100 g): 6 hanks of C1, 4 hanks of C2,
3 hanks each of C3 and C4, and 2 hanks of C5.

Sample colors shown: #5101 Mochi (C1), #5172 Calico
(C2), #51198 Acai (C3), #5105 Oats (C4), #51184 Twilight
(C5)

NEEDLES

See individual block patterns for needle sizes; most
blocks can be worked on straight or any length circular
needles, sizes 7 / 4.5 mm (smaller needle) and 8 / 5 mm
(larger needle) *or sizes to obtain gauge for each block; see
below for general gauge guideline.*

A few blocks are made in the round, and require double-
pointed needles (dpns), or preferred needles for working
small circumferences.

Edgings will require a long circular needle (smaller size).

NOTIONS

Stitch markers, tapestry needle, cable needle (cn)

GAUGE

Each block has its own gauge. However, to determine
which sizes to use for your smaller and larger size
needles, use the ball band gauges for Vintage:

Gauge #1: 20 sts and 27 rows = 4" / 10 cm in St st using
smaller needle

Gauge #2: 18 sts and 24 rows = 4" / 10 cm in St st using
larger needle

*Gauge is measured after blocking. To save time and ensure
accurate measurements, take time to check gauge.*

NOTE

Minor variations in block size—within about 1" / 2.5 cm
in either direction—are okay. Once the blocks are all
sewn together, these differences won't be noticeable.

Block #12—Cable

Designed by Alison Green / Skill level: Intermediate



NEEDLES

Knitting needles, size 7 / 4.5 mm (smaller needles) *or size to obtain gauge*

NOTIONS

2 cable needles (cn), tapestry needle

GAUGE

25 sts and 32 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Pattern St using smaller needles

SKILLS USED

Cast on, knit stitch, purl stitch, working cables, making bobbles, binding off. Optional: reading charts.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

MB (Make Bobble): [K1, k1tbl] twice in next st, turn, p4, turn, k2tog twice, pass second st over first st – 1 st remains.

2/1 LPC: Sl 2 sts to cn and hold in FRONT, p1, k2 from cn

2/1 RPC: Sl 1 st to cn and hold in BACK, k2, p1 from cn

2/1 LC: Sl 2 sts to cn and hold in FRONT, k1, k2 from cn

2/2 LC: Sl 2 sts to cn and hold in FRONT, k2, k2 from cn

2/2 RC: Sl 2 sts to cn and hold in BACK, k2, k2 from cn

2/1/2 LPC: Sl 2 sts to cn and hold in FRONT, sl 1 st to second cn and hold in BACK, k2, p1 from second cn, k2 from first cn

2/1/2 RPC: Sl 3 sts to cn and hold in BACK, k2, sl left-most st from cn to LH needle and purl it, knit last 2 from cn

BLOCK #12 INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Pattern may be worked using directions below or by following chart.

Using C1, cast on 76 sts.

Row 1 (WS): K5, p2, k1, p2, k3, p2, [k1, p1] twice, k1, * p5, [k1, p1] twice, k1; rep from * 3 times more, p3, k3, p2, k1, p2, k5.

Row 2 (RS): K1, p3, 2/1 RPC, p1, 2/1 LPC, p2, 2/1 LPC, * [k1, p1] twice, 2/1 RPC, 2/1 LPC; rep from * 3 times more, [k1, p1] twice, 2/1 RPC, p2, 2/1 RPC, p1, 2/1 LPC, p3, k1.

Row 3: K4, p2, [k3, p2] twice, [k1, p1] twice, * p2, k2, p2, [k1, p1] twice; rep from * 3 times more, [p2, k3] twice, p2, k4.

Row 4: K1, p2, 2/1 RPC, p3, 2/1 LPC, p2, * 2/1 LPC, k1, p1, 2/1 RPC, p2; rep from * 3 times more, 2/1 LPC, k1, p1, 2/1 RPC, p2, 2/1 RPC, p3, 2/1 LPC, p2, k1.

Row 5: K3, p2, k5, p2, k3, p2, k1, p2, * p1, k4, p2, k1, p2; rep from * 3 times more, p1, k3, p2, k5, p2, k3.

Row 6: K1, p1, 2/1 RPC, p5, 2/1 LPC, p2, * 2/1 LPC, 2/1 RPC, p4; rep from * 3 times more, 2/1 LPC, 2/1 RPC, p2, 2/1 RPC, p5, 2/1 LPC, p1, k1.

Row 7: K2, p2, k7, p2, k3, p4, * k6, p4; rep from * 3 times more, k3, p2, k7, p2, k2.

Row 8: K1, p1, k2, p3, MB, p3, k2, p3, * 2/2 LC, p6; rep from * 3 times more, 2/2 LC, p3, k2, p3, MB, p3, k2, p1, k1.

Row 9: Rep Row 7.

Row 10: K1, p1, 2/1 LPC, p5, 2/1 RPC, p2, * 2/1 RPC, 2/1 LC, p4; rep from * 3 times more, 2/1 RPC, 2/1 LC, p2, 2/1 LPC, p5, 2/1 RPC, p1, k1.

Row 11: K3, p2, k5, p2, k3, p3, k1, p1, * p1, k4, p3, k1, p1; rep from * 3 times more, p1, k3, p2, k5, p2, k3.

Row 12: K1, p2, 2/1 LPC, p3, 2/1 RPC, p2, * 2/1 RPC, k1, p1, 2/1 LC, p2; rep from * 3 times more, 2/1 RPC, k1, p1, 2/1 LC, p2, 2/1 LPC, p3, 2/1 RPC, p2, k1.

Row 13: K4, p2, [k3, p2] twice, [p1, k1] twice, * p2, k2, p2, [p1, k1] twice; rep from * 3 times more, [p2, k3] twice, p2, k4.

Row 14: K1, p3, 2/1 LPC, p1, 2/1 RPC, p2, 2/1 RPC, * [k1, p1] twice, 2/1 LC, 2/1 RPC; rep from * 3 times more, [k1, p1] twice, 2/1 LC, p2, 2/1 LPC, p1, 2/1 RPC, p3, k1.

Row 15: K5, p2, k1, p2, k3, p3, [k1, p1] twice, * k1, p5, [k1, p1] twice; rep from * 3 times more, k1, p2, k3, p2, k1, p2, k5.

Row 16: K1, p4, 2/1/2 LPC, p3, k3, * [p1, k1] twice, p1, 2/2 RC, k1; rep from * 3 times more, [p1, k1] 3 times, k1, p3, 2/1/2 RPC, p4, k1.

Repeat Rows 1–16 four times more (5 times total), then work Rows 1–14 once more.

Bind off on WS, knitting the knit sts and purling the purl sts.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends and block as desired.

STANDARD ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

cn: cable needle

k: knit

k2tog: knit 2 stitches together

p: purl

rep: repeat

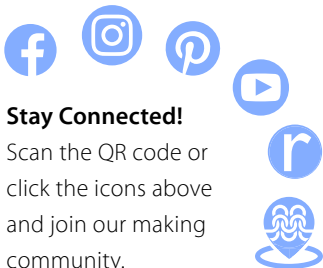
RS: right side

sl: slip

WS: wrong side

wyib: with yarn in back

wyif: with yarn in front



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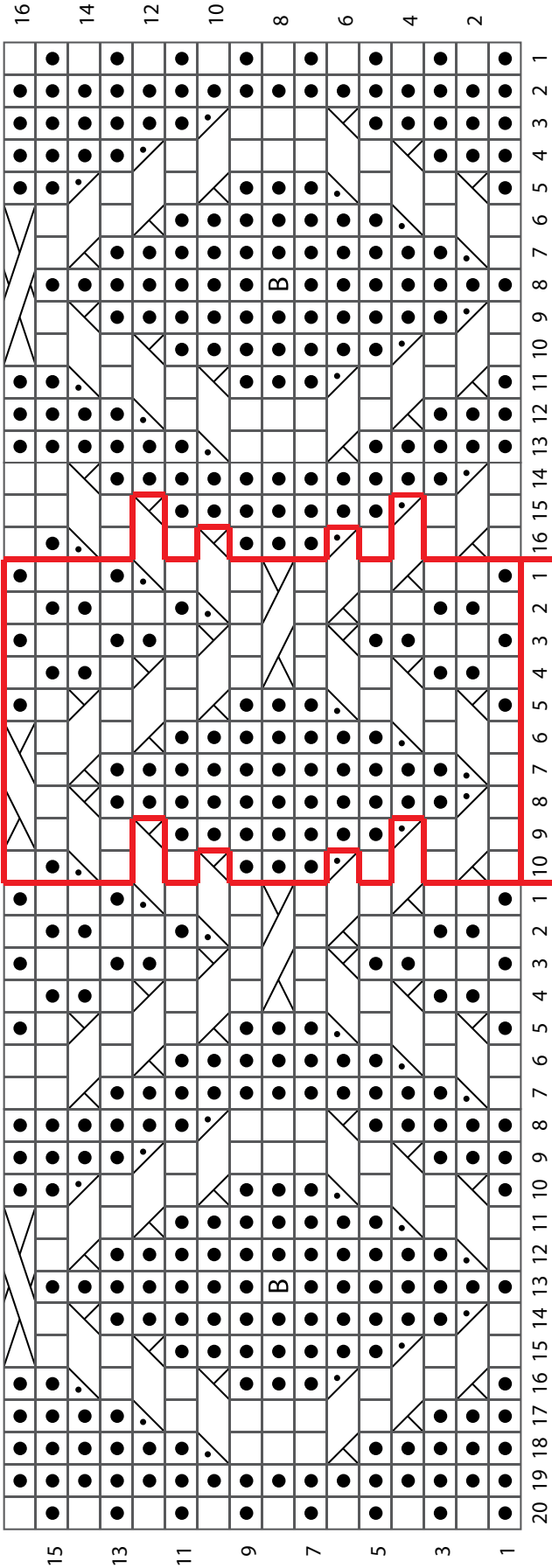

BLOCK #12 CHART



work 10-st repeat 4 times total

KEY TO CHART

- knit on RS; purl on WS
- purl on RS; knit on WS
- make bobble: (k1, k1tbl) twice in next st, turn, (k2tog) twice, pass 2nd st on RH needle over first st
- 2/1 LPC: sl 2 to cn and hold to FRONT, p1, k2 from cn
- 2/1 RPC: sl 1 to cn and hold to BACK, k2, p1 from cn
- 2/1 LC: sl 2 to cn and hold to FRONT, k1, k2 from cn
- 2/2 RC: sl 2 to cn and hold to BACK, k2, k2 from cn

- 2/2 LC: sl 2 to cn and hold to FRONT, k2, k2 from cn
- 2/1/2 RPC: sl 3 to cn and hold to BACK, k2, sl left-most st from cn to LH needle and purl it; knit last 2 from cn
- 2/1/2 LPC: sl 2 to cn and hold to FRONT, sl 1 st onto 2nd cn and hold to BACK, k2, p1 from 2nd cn, k2 from first cn
- pattern repeat

CHART NOTES

Work from right to left on RS rows and from left to right on WS rows.
Chart begins on WS.
