FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Completed Blanket: Approximately 52" x 64" /
132 cm x 163 cm

Each Block: Approximately 12" / 30.5 cm square

YARN

BERROCO VINTAGE (100 g): 6 hanks of C1, 4 hanks of C2,
3 hanks each of C3 and C4, and 2 hanks of C5.

Sample colors shown: #5101 Mochi (C1), #5172 Calico
(C2), #51198 Acai (C3), #5105 Oats (C4), #51184 Twilight
(C5)

NEEDLES

See individual block patterns for needle sizes; most
blocks can be worked on straight or any length circular
needles, sizes 7 / 4.5 mm (smaller needle) and 8 / 5 mm
(larger needle) *or sizes to obtain gauge for each block; see
below for general gauge guideline.*

A few blocks are made in the round, and require double-
pointed needles (dpns), or preferred needles for working
small circumferences.

Edgings will require a long circular needle (smaller size).

NOTIONS

Stitch markers, tapestry needle, cable needle (cn)

GAUGE

Each block has its own gauge. However, to determine
which sizes to use for your smaller and larger size
needles, use the ball band gauges for Vintage:

Gauge #1: 20 sts and 27 rows = 4" / 10 cm in St st using
smaller needle

Gauge #2: 18 sts and 24 rows = 4" / 10 cm in St st using
larger needle

*Gauge is measured after blocking. To save time and ensure
accurate measurements, take time to check gauge.*

NOTE

Minor variations in block size—within about 1" / 2.5 cm
in either direction—are okay. Once the blocks are all
sewn together, these differences won't be noticeable.

Block #15—Cabled Lace

Designed by Alison Green / Skill level: Intermediate



NEEDLES

Knitting needles, size 7 / 4.5 mm (smaller needles) *or size to obtain gauge*

GAUGE

23 sts and 28 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Pattern St using smaller needles

SKILLS USED

Cast on, knit stitch, purl stitch, yo, working cables, decreases (k2tog tbl and CDD), binding off.

Optional: reading charts.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

LTDec (Left Twisted Decrease): Knit 2 sts together through the back loops.

RTDec (Right Twisted Decrease): Sl 1 purlwise, slip next st inserting needle from back to front (twisting st to the left), slip both sts back to LH needle and knit them together from this position.

1/1 TRC (1 over 1 Twisted Right Cable): Sl 1 to cn and hold to BACK, k1tbl, k1tbl from cn.

1/1 TLC (1 over 1 Twisted Left Cable): Sl 1 to cn and hold to FRONT, k1tbl, k1tbl from cn.

1/1 TRPC (1 over 1 Twisted Right Purl Cable): Sl 1 to cn and hold to BACK, k1tbl, p1 from cn.

1/1 TLPC (1 over 1 Twisted Left Purl Cable): Sl 1 to cn and hold to FRONT, p1, k1tbl from cn.

1/2 TRC (1 over 2 Twisted Right Cable): Sl 2 to cn and hold to BACK, k1tbl, (k1, k1tbl) from cn.

2/2 RC (2 over 2 Right Cable): Sl 2 to cn and hold to BACK, k2, k2 from cn.

2/2 LC (2 over 2 Left Cable): Sl 2 to cn and hold to FRONT, k2, k2 from cn.

BLOCK #15 INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Pattern may be worked either by using directions below or by following chart.

Using C4, cast on 70 sts.

Row 1 (WS): K4, p1tbl, p1, p1tbl, k2, p1tbl, p1, p1tbl, k3, * p1tbl, k4, p3, k4, p1tbl, k3, p1tbl, p1, p1tbl, k2, p1tbl, p1, p1tbl, k3; rep from * once more, k1.

Row 2 (RS): K1, * p3, LTDec, yo, k1tbl, p2, k1tbl, yo, RTDec, p3, k1tbl, p4, 1/2TRC, p4, k1tbl; rep from * once more, p3, LTDec, yo, k1tbl, p2, k1tbl, yo, RTDec, p3, k1.

Row 3: Rep Row 1.

Row 4: K1, * p3, LTDec, yo, k1tbl, p2, k1tbl, yo, RTDec, p3, k1tbl, p3, 1/1TRC, k1, 1/1TLC, p3, k1tbl; rep from * once more, p3, LTDec, yo, k1tbl, p2, k1tbl, yo, RTDec, p3, k1.

Row 5: K4, p1tbl, p1, p1tbl, k2, p1tbl, p1, p1tbl, k3, * p1tbl, k3, p1tbl, p3, p1tbl, k3, p1tbl, k3, p1tbl, p1, p1tbl, k2, p1tbl, p1, p1tbl, k3; rep from * once more, k1.

Row 6: K1, * p3, LTDec, yo, k1tbl, p2, k1tbl, yo, RTDec, p3, k1tbl, p3, k1tbl, yo, CDD, yo, k1tbl, p3, k1tbl; rep from * once more, p3, LTDec, yo, k1tbl, p2, k1tbl, yo, RTDec, p3, k1.

Row 7: K4, p8, k3, * [p1tbl, k3] 4 times, p8, k3; rep from * once more, k1.

Row 8: K1, * p3, k2, 2/2RC, k2, p3, k1tbl, p3, k1tbl, k3, k1tbl, p3, k1tbl; rep from * once more, p3, k2, 2/2RC, k2, p3, k1.

Row 9: K4, p8, k3, * p1tbl, k3, p1tbl, p3, [p1tbl, k3] twice, p8, k3; rep from * once more, k1.

Row 10: K1, * p3, [2/2LC] twice, [p3, k1tbl] twice, yo, CDD, yo, k1tbl, p3, k1tbl; rep from * once more, p3, [2/2LC] twice, p3, k1.

Row 11: K4, p8, k3, * [p1tbl, k3] 4 times, p8, k3; rep from * once more, k1.

Row 12: Rep Row 8.

Row 13: Rep Row 9.

Row 14: Rep Row 10.

Row 15: Rep Row 11.

Row 16: Rep Row 8.

Row 17: Rep Row 9.

Row 18: Rep Row 6.

Row 19: K4, p1tbl, p1, p1tbl, k2, p1tbl, p1, p1tbl, k3, * [p1tbl, k3] 4 times, p1tbl, p1, p1tbl, k2, p1tbl, p1, p1tbl, k3; rep from * once more, k1.

Row 20: K1, * p3, LTDec, yo, k1tbl, p2, k1tbl, yo, RTDec, p3, k1tbl, p3, 1/1TLPC, k1, 1/1TRPC, p3, k1tbl; rep from * once more, p3, LTDec, yo, k1tbl, p2, k1tbl, yo, RTDec, p3, k1.

Repeat Rows 1–20 three times more, then work Rows 1 and 2. Bind off in pattern on WS.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends and block as desired.

STANDARD ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

CDD: Centered Double Decrease—Slip 2 together (as if to k2tog), knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over

cn: cable needle

dec: decrease

inc: increase

k: knit

k tbl: knit through the back loop(s)

p: purl

p tbl: purl through the back loop(s)

rep: repeat

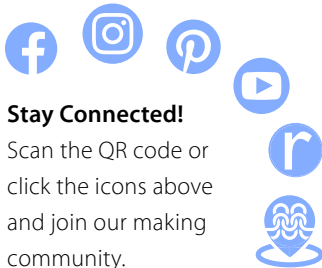
RS: right side

sl: slip

st(s): stitch(es)

WS: wrong side

yo: yarn over



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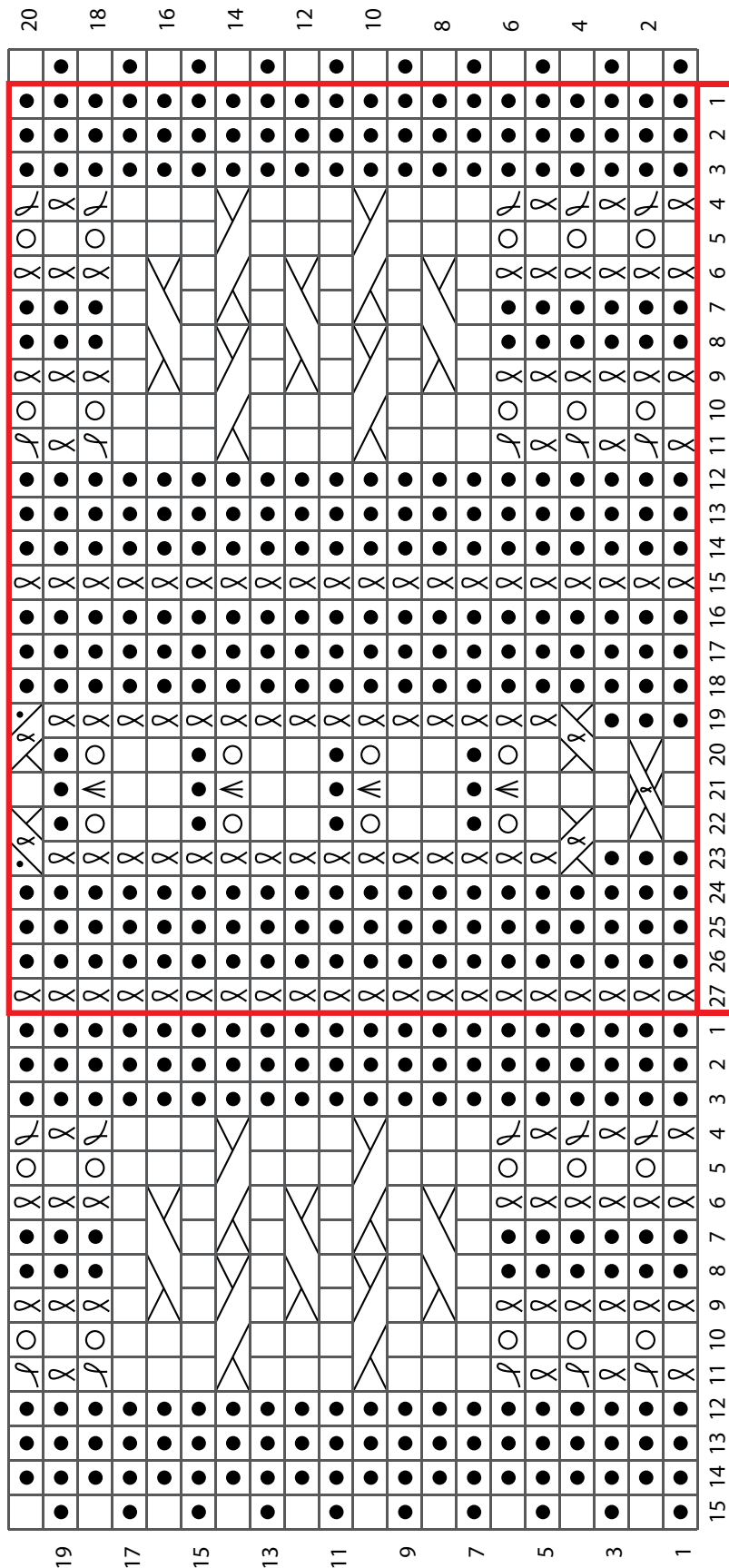

KEY TO CHART

- knit on RS; purl on WS
- purl on RS; knit on WS
- k1tbl on RS; p1tbl on WS
- yarn over
- CDD
- LTDec
- RTDec

Work from right to left on RS rows and from left to right on WS rows.

See Special Abbreviations for LTDec, RTDec, and all cable instructions.
