







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BALSAM FIR

Designed by Nadia Glaser / Skill level: Intermediate

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Approximately 5½" / 14 cm tall and 4" / 10 cm wide

YARN

BERROCO VINTAGE BABY (50 g): small amount each of 10033 Poppy (MC) and 10002 Pearl (CC)

NEEDLES

1 set double–pointed needles, or preferred needles for working small circumferences in the round, size 6 / 4 mm or size to obtain gauge.

GAUGE

22 sts and 32 rnds = 4" / 10 cm in St st Gauge is measured after blocking. To save time and ensure accurate measurements, take time to check gauge.

CONSTRUCTION NOTES

Stocking is worked in the round from the cuff down with a heel flap and gusset. Color not in use can be carried up to the next round it's used.

INSTRUCTIONS

With MC, cast on 28 sts. Place marker for BOR and join for working in the round.

Work in k1, p1 ribbing for 3 rounds.

Knit 1 round. Join CC.

Rnds 1-2: With CC, knit.

Rnds 3-4: With MC, knit.

Rnd 5: * Knit 1 MC, knit 1 CC; rep from * around.

Rnd 6: * Knit 1 CC, knit 1 MC, rep from * around.

Rnd 7: * Knit 1 MC, knit 1 CC; rep from * around.

Rnds 8-9: With MC, knit.

Repeat Rnds 1–7 once more. Remove BOR marker.

Heel Flap: This section will be worked flat on half of the sts using MC only. The remaining 14 sts can be placed on waste yarn or holder for instep.

Row 1 (WS): SI 1 wyif, p13.

Row 2 (RS): SI 1 wyib, k13.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 three times more.

Turn Heel:

Row 1 (WS): SI 1 wyif, p8, p2tog, turn

Row 2 (RS): Sl 1 wyib, k4, SSK, turn. 6 sts in center section and 3 sts on each side.

Row 3 (WS): SI 1 wyif, p4, p2tog, turn.

Row 4 (RS): SI 1 wyib, k4, SSK, turn.

Row 5 (WS): SI 1 wyif, p4, p2tog, turn.

Row 6 (RS): SI 1 wyib, k4, SSK, turn.

Row 5 (WS): SI 1 wyif, p4, p2tog, turn.

Row 6 (RS): SI 1 wyib, k4, SSK, do not turn. 6 heel sts remain.

Gusset: Return 14 instep sts to needle.

Turn work 90 degrees clockwise and continuing with MC, pick up 4 sts along edge of heel flap and 1 st between heel flap and instep sts, pm, knit across 14 instep sts, pm for new BOR, pick up 1 st between instep and heel flap, pick up and knit 4 sts along edge of heel flap, knit across heel turn sts and to end of rnd (going across instep sts to new BOR). 30 sts. 14 instep sts and 16 heel sts.

Dec Rnd: With CC, SSK, knit to 2 sts before marker, k2tog, sm, knit across instep sts. 2 sts decreased; 28 sts.

Next Rnd: With CC, knit to marker, sm, knit across instep sts. Knit 2 rnds with MC.

Next Rnd: * With MC, knit 1, with CC, knit 1; rep from * around.

Next Rnd: * With CC, knit 1, with MC, knit 1, rep from * around.

Next Rnd: * With MC, knit 1, with CC, knit 1; rep from * around.

Knit 2 rnds with MC.

Knit 2 Rnds with CC. Cut CC and continue with MC.

Toe:

Dec Rnd: * K1, SSK, knit to 3 sts before m, k2tog, k1; rep from * once more. 4 sts dec'd.

Next Rnd: Knit.

Rep last 2 rnds twice more, then work Dec Rnd once more. 12 sts remain.

Arrange 6 instep sts on one needle and 6 remaining sts on another. Cut yarn leaving a tail approximately 10" / 25 cm long. Graft toe closed.

FINISHING

Weave in ends and block if desired.



NORWAY SPRUCE

Designed by Tabetha Hedrick / Skill level: Intermediate

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Approximately $4\frac{1}{2}$ " / 11.5 cm circumference x 3" / 7.5 cm tall from bottom of ear flap to crown

YARN

BERROCO VINTAGE DK (100 g): approximately 6–7 grams #2141 Wisteria

NEEDLES

1 set double-pointed needles, or preferred needles for working small circumferences in the round, size 4 / 3.5 mm or size to obtain gauge

NOTIONS

Stitch marker

GAUGE

30 sts and 32 rounds = 4" / 10 cm in K2, p2 ribbing

Gauge is measured after blocking. To save time and ensure accurate measurements, take time to check gauge.

CONSTRUCTION NOTES

Hat is knit from the bottom to the crown. The stitches for the ear flaps are picked up along the brim. The pom-pom is sewn onto the crown

HAT

Cast on 36 sts. Arrange evenly on needles, place marker and join for working in the round.

Work K2, p2 ribbing for a total of 15 rnds.

Shape Crown: Dec Rnd 1: (k2, p2tog) 9 times. 27 sts.

Dec Rnd 2: (k1, ssk) 9 times. 18 sts. Dec Rnd 3: (k2tog) 9 times. 9 sts. Dec Rnd 4: K1, (k2tog) 4 times. 5 sts.

Cut a 10'' / 25.5 cm tail and draw through the remaining sts, pulling snugly. Leave the tail for sewing the pom-pom later.

EAR FLAPS

With 2 dpns, pick up and knit 7 sts on one side of the hat.

Row 1 (WS): Purl. Row 2 (RS): Knit.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 once more. Repeat Row 1 once.

Shape Flap: Dec Row (RS): K1, ssk, k1, k2tog, k1. 5 sts.

Next Row (WS): Purl.

Dec Row: K1, CDD, k1. *3 sts*.

Next Row: Purl.

Row 5—Dec Row: K1, k2tog. 2 sts.

Next Row: Purl.

I-cord Tie: Row 1 (RS): K2, do not turn. Slide sts to beginning of needle, keeping yarn held to the back, to work the next row from the RS.

Rep Row 1 until the i-cord tie measures approximately 4" / 10 cm. Bind off tightly.

Thread the tail onto a tapestry needle and pass it through the end of the i-cord tie, but do not pull it all the way through—leave a loop. Wrap the yarn around two fingers twice to create two loops, then draw the tail through the tie again to secure them. Next, wrap the yarn around the base of the ear flap and the yarn loops 2–3 times to anchor everything in place. Knot the yarn firmly, then weave the tail into the i-cord tie to secure. Leave the two loops as they are for now.

Repeat ear flap for the other side of the hat.

FINISHING

Block the hat as desired.

Pull the ear-flap tie loops snug, then cut them in half with scissors to create tassel ends. Align the ends of both ear flaps and trim the tails evenly for a neat finish. Make a ½" / 1.5 cm pom-pom (the tines of a fork help with this) and sew to the crown. Weave in all ends.



WHITE PINE

Designed by Asa Buchta / Skill level: Intermediate

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Approximately 3¼" / 8.5 cm across body x 2¾" / 7 cm high

YARN

BERROCO LANAS LIGHT (100 g): small amount each #7801 Cream (MC) and #78122 Tide (CC)

NEEDLES

1 set double-pointed needles, or preferred needles for working small circumferences in the round, size 6 / 4 mm or size to obtain gauge

NOTIONS

Stitch marker, waste yarn to hold stitches

GAUGE

23 sts and 36 rounds = 4" / 10 cm in St st

Gauge is measured after blocking. To save time and ensure accurate measurements, take time to check gauge.

Berroco Lanas® Light



CONSTRUCTION NOTES

Sweater is knit from the neck down in the round.

YOKE

With CC, cast on 20 sts. Place marker for BOR and join for working in the round. Change to MC and knit 1 rnd.

Inc Rnd: * With MC, k1, M1, k1; rep from * around. 30 sts.

Next Rnd: * With MC, k1, with CC, k1, with MC, k1; rep from * around.

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Inc Rnd: * With MC, k3, M1; rep from * around. 40 sts.

Next Rnd: * With MC, k3, with CC, k1; rep from * around.

Inc Rnd: * With MC, k1, M1, k3; rep from * around. 50 sts.

Next Rnd: * With MC, k2, with CC, k1, with MC, k2; rep from

* around.

Break CC and continue with MC only.

Inc Rnd: * K5, M1; rep from * around. 60 sts.

Knit 3 rounds.

Divide for Body and Sleeves: Next Rnd: Slip 12 sts to waste yarn for sleeve, k18 for front, slip 12 sts to waste yarn for sleeve, k18 for back. *36 sts.*

Body: Work even in St st until body measures $1\frac{1}{2}$ " / 3.5 cm from underarm. Work 1 round in k1, p1 ribbing. Bind off in ribbing.

Sleeves: Slip 12 sleeve stitches from waste yarn to needle. Work even in St st until sleeve measures $1\frac{1}{2}$ " / 3.5 cm from underarm. Work 1 round in k1, p1 ribbing. Bind off in ribbing.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends and block as desired.

STANDARD ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

BOR: beginning of round

CC: contrasting color

CDD: Centered Double Decrease—Slip 2 together (as if to

k2tog), knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over

dec: decrease

dpn(s): double pointed needle(s)

inc: increase

k: knit

k2tog: knit 2 stitches together

M1: Make 1—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left-hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch

increased).

MC: main color

p: purl

pm: place marker

rep: repeatrnd(s): round(s)RS: right side

sl: slip

sm: slip marker

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2

together.

st(s): stitch(es)

St st: Stockinette Stitch—Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the

round.

WS: wrong side

wyib: with yarn in back of workwyif: with yarn in front of work
