YARN

BERROCO VINTAGE (100 grs): (7, 8, 8, 10) [11, 12, 13, 14] {15, 16, 17, 18} hanks #5107 Cracked Pepper

5–10 cm positive ease.

NEEDLES and NOTIONS knitting needles, sizes 6 / 4 mm and 8 / 5 mm or size to obtain gauge 32" / 80 cm circular needle, size 6 / 4 mm Crochet hook, size 5 mm (H) 2 stitch holders Eight ½" metal snaps Eight 1" buttons

GAUGE

17 sts and 32 rows = 4'' / 10 cm in Pattern Stitch on larger needle To save time and ensure accurate measurements, take time to check gauge.

NOTE

When increasing or decreasing while working pattern stitch, if there are not enough stitches to work an entire repeat, work the extra stitches in St st.

PATTERN STITCH

Even number of sts

Row 1 (WS): Sl 1 wyif, * yo, sl 1 wyib, k1; rep from * across, end p1.

Row 2: Sl 1 wyib, * k1, k2tog (the yo and sl st of previous row); rep from * across, end k1.

Row 3: Sl 1 wyif, k1, * yo, sl 1 wyib, k1; rep from * across, end k1, p1.

Row 4: Sl 1 wyib, k2, * k2 tog, k1; rep from * across, end k1. Rep these 4 rows for Pattern Stitch.

BACK

With smaller straight needles, cast on (69, 73, 77, 87) [95, 103, 111, 119] {127, 137, 145, 153} sts.

Set Up Rib: Row 1 (RS): K1, * p1, k1; rep from * across.

Row 2: P1, * k1, p1; rep from * across.

Rep these 2 rows until piece measures 2" / 5 cm from beginning, end on RS, dec 1 st at end of the last row— (68, 72, 76, 86) [94, 102, 110, 118] {126, 136, 144, 152} sts. Change to larger needles and work even in Pattern Stitch until piece measures 4½" / 11.5 cm from beginning, end on WS.

Dec Row (RS): Sl 1 wyib, SSK, work to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1—2 sts dec'd.

Rep Dec Row every (16th, 18th, 18th, 18th) [18th, 16th, 16th, 16th] {14th, 14th, 14th, 14th} row 5 times more— (56, 60, 64, 74) [82, 90, 98, 106] {114, 124, 132, 140} sts. Work even until piece measures (17, 18, 19, 18½) [18, 17½, 17, 16½] {16, 15½, 15, 14½}" / (43, 45.5, 4.58, 47) [46.5, 44.5, 43, 42] {40.5, 39, 38, 37} cm from beginning, end on WS.

Inc Row (RS): SI 1 wyib, M1L, work to last stitch, M1R, k1—2 sts inc'd.

Work 15 rows even, then rep Inc Row once more—(60, 64, 68, 78) [86, 94, 102, 110] {118, 128, 136, 144} sts. Work even until piece measures (21, 22, 23, 22½) [22, 21½, 21, 20½] {20,



19½, 19, 18½}" / (53.5, 56, 58.5, 57) [56, 54.5, 53.5, 52] {51, 49.5, 48.5, 47} cm from beginning, end on WS.

Shape Raglan Armholes: Bind off (2, 2, 3, 4) [4, 5, 5, 6] {6, 8, 10, 12} sts at beginning of the next 2 rows—(56, 60, 62, 70) [78, 84, 92, 98] {106, 112, 116, 120} sts.

Dec Row (RS): Sl 1 wyib, SSK, work to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1—2 sts dec'd.

Rep Dec Row every RS row (1, 5, 5, 11) [17, 21, 27, 31] {37, 41, 43, 45} times more, then every 4th row (12, 10, 11, 9) [7, 6, 4, 3] {1, 0, 0, 0} times, end on WS—28 sts. Bind off.

LEFT FRONT

With smaller straight needles, cast on (41, 43, 45, 49) [53, 57, 61, 65] [69, 73, 77, 81] sts.

Set Up Rib: Row 1 (RS): K1, * p1, k1; rep from * across, end k1. Row 2: K1, * p1, k1; rep from * across, end p1.

Rep these 2 rows until piece measures 2" / 5 cm from beginning, end on WS.

Chang to larger needles.

Next Row (RS): Knit (30, 32, 34, 38) [42, 46, 50, 54] [58, 62, 66, 70] sts, slip remaining 11 sts to holder for front band. Work even in Pattern Stitch until piece measures 4½" / 11.5 cm from beginning, end on WS.

Dec Row (RS): SI 1 wyib, SSK, work to end—1 st dec'd.



Rep Dec Row every (16th, 18th, 18th, 18th) [18th, 16th, 16th, 16th, 16th] {14th, 14th, 14th, 14th} row 5 times more—(24, 26, 28, 32) [36, 40, 44, 48] {52, 56, 60, 64} sts. Work even until piece measures (17, 18, 19, 18½) [18, 17½, 17, 16½] {16, 15½, 15, 14½}" / (43, 45.5, 4.58, 47) [46.5, 44.5, 43, 42] {40.5, 39, 38, 37} cm from beginning, end on WS.

Inc Row (RS): SI 1 wyib, M1L, work to end—1 st inc'd. Work 15 rows even, then rep Inc Row once more—(26, 28, 30, 34) [38, 42, 46, 50] {54, 58, 62, 66} sts. Work even until piece measures (21, 22, 23, 22½) [22, 21½, 21, 20½] {20, 19½, 19, 18½}" / (53.5, 56, 58.5, 57) [56, 54.5, 53.5, 52] {51, 49.5, 48.5, 47} cm from beginning, end on WS.

Shape Raglan Armhole: Next Row (RS): Bind off (2, 2, 3, 4) [4, 5, 5, 6] {6, 8, 10, 12} sts, work to end—(24, 26, 27, 30) [34, 37, 41, 44] {48, 50, 52, 54} sts. Work 1 row even.

Dec Row (RS): SI 1 wyib, SSK, work to end—1 st dec'd. Rep Dec Row every RS row (1, 5, 5, 11) [17, 21, 27, 31] {37, 41, 43, 45} times more, then every 4th row (12, 10, 11, 9) [7, 6, 4, 3] {1, 0, 0, 0} times. AT THE SAME TIME, when armhole measures (4½, 4½, 5, 5½) [6, 6½, 7, 7½] {8, 8½, 9, 9½}" / (11.5, 11.5, 12.5, 14) [15, 16.5, 18, 19] {20.5, 21.5, 23, 24} cm, end on RS.

Shape Neck: Next Row (WS): Bind off (4, 4, 4, 3) [3, 3, 3, 3] {3, 2, 2, 2} sts, work to end. Continuing to work armhole decs as before, dec 1 st at neck edge every RS row twice, then every

4th row 3 times. When all armhole and neck decs have been completed, end on WS. Fasten off last stitch.

RIGHT FRONT

With smaller needles, cast on (41, 43, 45, 49) [53, 57, 61, 65] [69, 73, 77, 81] sts.

Set Up Rib: Row 1 (RS): K2, * p1, k1; rep from * across. Row 2: * P1, k1; rep from * to last st, end k1. Rep these 2 rows until piece measures 2" / 5 cm from beginning, end on WS.

Next Row (RS): Work 11 sts and slip these sts onto holder for frontband, change to larger needles and knit to end— (30, 32, 34, 38) [42, 46, 50, 54] {58, 62, 66, 70} sts. Work even in Pattern Stitch until piece measures 4½" / 11.5 cm from beginning, end on WS.

Dec Row (RS): Work to the last 3 sts, k2tog, k1—1 st dec'd. Rep Dec Row every (16th, 18th, 18th, 18th) [18th, 16th, 16th, 16th, 16th] {14th, 14th, 14th, 14th} row 5 times more—(24, 26, 28, 32) [36, 40, 44, 48] {52, 56, 60, 64} sts. Work even until piece measures (17, 18, 19, 18½) [18, 17½, 17, 16½] {16, 15½, 15, 14½}" / (43, 45.5, 4.58, 47) [46.5, 44.5, 43, 42] {40.5, 39, 38, 37} cm from beginning, end on WS.

Inc Row (RS): Work to the last stitch M1R, k1—1 st inc'd. Work 15 rows even, then rep Inc Row once more—(26, 28, 30, 34) [38, 42, 46, 50] {54, 58, 62, 66} sts. Work even until piece measures (21, 22, 23, 22½) [22, 21½, 21, 20½] {20, 19½, 19, 18½}" / (53.5, 56, 58.5, 57) [56, 54.5, 53.5, 52] {51, 49.5, 48.5, 47} cm from beginning, end on RS.

Shape Raglan Armhole: Next Row (WS): Bind off (2, 2, 3, 4) [4, 5, 5, 6] {6, 8, 10, 12} sts, work to end—(24, 26, 27, 30) [34, 37, 41, 44] {48, 50, 52, 54} sts.

Dec Row (RS): Work to the last 3 sts, k2tog, k1—1 st dec'd. Rep Dec Row every RS row (1, 5, 5, 11) [17, 21, 27, 31] {37, 41, 43, 45} times more, then every 4th row (12, 10, 11, 9) [7, 6, 4, 3] {1, 0, 0, 0} times. AT THE SAME TIME, when armhole measures (4½, 4½, 5, 5½) [6, 6½, 7, 7½] {8, 8½, 9, 9½}" / (11.5, 11.5, 12.5, 14) [15, 16.5, 18, 19] {20.5, 21.5, 23, 24} cm, end on WS.

Shape Neck: Next Row (RS): Bind off (4, 4, 4, 3) [3, 3, 3, 3] {3, 2, 2, 2} sts, work to end. Continuing to work armhole decs as before, dec 1 st at neck edge every RS row twice, then every 4th row 3 times. When all armhole and neck decs have been completed, end on WS. Fasten off last stitch.

SLEEVES

With larger needles, cast on (30, 30, 34, 34) [34, 34, 38, 38] {38, 38, 42, 42} sts. Work even in Garter St for 2" / 5 cm, end on RS. Work even in Pattern Stitch until piece measures 3" / 7.5 cm from beginning, end on WS.

Inc Row (RS): Sl 1 wyib, M1L, work to last stitch, M1R, k1—1 st inc'd.

Shape Raglan Cap: Bind off (2, 2, 3, 4) [4, 5, 5, 6] {6, 8, 10, 12} sts at beginning of the next 2 rows—(38, 38, 42, 44) [48, 50, 54, 56) [60, 60, 60, 60] sts. Work 2 rows even.

Dec Row (RS): Sl 1 wyib, SSK, work to last 3 sts, k2 tog, k1—2 sts dec'd.

Rep this Dec Row every RS row (0, 0, 0, 0) [0, 0, 2, 2] {4, 2, 0, 0} times more, every 4th row (6, 6, 10, 11) [15, 16, 16, 17] {17, 19, 21, 19} times more, then every 6th row (4, 4, 2, 2) [0, 0, 0, 0] {0, 0, 0, 2} times, end on WS. Bind off remaining 16 sts.

FINISHING

Sew raglan sleeve caps to raglan armholes. Sew side and sleeve seams.

Left Front Band: With RS facing, slip 11 sts from left holder to smaller needles. Join yarn and inc 1, then work in ribbing as established across—12 sts. Keeping inc'd stitch in St st and remaining stitches in ribbing as established, work even until front band, when slightly stretched, reaches to beginning of neck, end on RS.

Next Row (WS): Work to last 2 sts, p2tog—11 sts. Slip these stitches onto holder for collar. Sew inner edge of front band to left front edge.

Right Front Band: With WS facing, slip 11 sts from right holder to smaller needles. Join yarn and inc 1, then work in ribbing as established across—12 sts. Work to correspond to left front band, dec 1 st at beginning of last row instead of at end. Sew inner edge of frontband to right front edge. Collar: With RS facing, using circular needle, work 11 sts from right holder, pick up and knit 16 sts along right front neck edge, 22 sts across top of right sleeve, 33 sts across back neck edge, 22 sts across top of left sleeve, pick up and knit 16 sts along left front neck edge, then work 11 sts from left holder—131 sts.

Row 1 (WS): K1, * p1, k1; rep from * across.


Row 2: K2, * p1, k1; rep from * across, end k1. Rep these 2 rows until collar measures 6" / 15 cm, end on WS. Bind off in ribbing. Fold collar in half to WS and sew in place. Sew front edges of collar together. Sew one half of each snap evenly spaced along RS of left front edge, the first in center of collar, the last 3" / 7.5 cm up from cast-on edge of frontband and the others evenly spaced between. Sew the second half of each snap to WS of right front edge opposite their matching halves. Sew buttons to RS of right front edge on top of snaps. Try on garment and mark placement of belt loops on each side seam.

Belt Loops (Make 2): With RS facing, using crochet hook, join yarn with a sl st in left side seam. Chain for 2" / 5 cm, skip 2" / 5 cm on side seam, join with a sl st in side seam. Fasten off. Repeat on right side seam.

Belt: With smaller straight needles, cast on 16 sts. Work even in k1, p1 ribbing until belt reaches around waist, adding 30" / 76 cm for ties. Bind off. Thread ends of belt through belt loops.

Weave in all ends and block as desired.

CDD: Centered Double Decrease—Slip 2 together (as if to

k2tog), knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over

cn: cable needle dec: decrease

dpn(s): double pointed needle(s)

end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong Side row. end on RS: end having just completed a Right Side row Garter St: Knit EVERY row when working back and forth in rows. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working in the round.

inc: increase k: knit

k tbl: knit through the back loop(s) k2tog: knit 2 stitches together k3tog: knit 3 stitches together

kfb: knit in the front and back of the next st

LH: left hand

LLI: Left Lifted Increase—Insert LH needle into the purl bump one row below the st just worked on the RH needle and knit into this st (1 st inc'd)

M1: Make 1—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1L: Make 1 Left—Work as for M1.

M1p: Make 1 purl—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1pL: Make 1 purl Left—Work as for M1p.

M1pR: Make 1 purl Right—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

M1R: Make 1 Right—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

MC: main color

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p: purl

p tbl: purl through the back loop(s) p2tog: purl 2 stitches together p3tog: purl 3 stitches together

pat(s): pattern(s) pm: place marker

psso: pass slipped stitch over knit stitch

rep: repeat

Rev St st: Reverse Stockinette Stitch—Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round.

RH: right hand

RLI: Right Lifted Increase—Insert RH needle into the purl bump of the next st on the LH needle and knit into this st (1

st inc'd) rnd(s): round(s) RS: right side sl: slip

sm: slip marker

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together. SSP: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, transfer these 2 stitches back to left hand needle, purl 2 together through the back loops. SSSK: Slip 3 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 3 stitches and knit 3

st(s): stitch(es)

together.

St st: Stockinette Stitch—Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round.

tbl: through back loop(s)

w&t: wrap and turn, a method of concealing a hole created in short row shaping. On RS rows: With yarn held in front, slip next stitch purlwise, then bring yarn between needles to the back. Slip that same stitch back to the left needle. Turn your work. On WS Rows: With yarn held in back, slip next stitch purlwise, then bring yarn between needles to the front. Slip that same stitch back to the left needle. Turn your work. Unless otherwise indicated, each time you come to a wrapped stitch when working subsequent rows, slip the wrap back over stitch and onto needle, then work the wrap together with its accompanying stitch.

WS: wrong side

wyib: with yarn in back wyif: with yarn in front

yo: yarn over



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
