

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FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Scarf: Approximately 72" / 183 cm long and x 10" / 25.5 cm wide

Hat: Approximately 17" / 43 cm around x 11" / 28 cm high

YARN

BERROCO GIANNA (100 g): 1 ball #9108 Cotton Candy for hat, 2 balls for scarf

NEEDLES

32" / 80 cm circular needle, size 10 / 6 mm *or size to obtain gauge*

NOTIONS

Tapestry needle

GAUGE

16 sts and 32 rows = 4" in Garter st, using larger needles Gauge is measured after blocking. To save time and ensure accurate measurements, take time to check gauge.

CONSTRUCTION NOTES

Hat is worked flat sideways and seamed, using short rows to shape top. Scarf is worked from one long side to the other.

SCARF INSTRUCTONS

Cast on 288 sts.

Work in Garter St (knit all sts) until piece measures approximately 10" / 25.5 cm, or until there are a few yards left in the second ball of yarn. Bind off, taking care to match tension of the bind off to the cast-on.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends and block as desired.

HAT INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 60 sts. Do not join.

Set-up Row (WS): Purl 32 sts, pm, knit to end.

Row 1 (RS): Knit to the last 4 sts, w&t.

Rows 2 and all WS rows: Purl to marker, sm, knit to end.

Rows 3 and 5: Knit to 3 sts before wrapped st, w&t.

Row 7: Knit to wrapped st, pick up wrap and knit it together with its st, knit to next wrapped stitch, w&t. This is now a double wrapped stitch.

Row 9: Knit to double wrapped st, pick up wraps and knit them together with their st, knit to next srapped stitch, w&t. This is now a double wrapped stitch.

Row 11: Knit to double wrapped st, pick up wraps and knit them together with their st, knit to end.

Row 12: Work as Row 2.

Rep Rows 1–12 eleven more times. Bind off knitwise on RS.



FINISHING

Break yarn, leaving a tail at least 3 times the length of the bound-off edge. Use tail to seam cast-on edge to bound-off edge, then sew into the garter edges at the top of the hat to close it up.

Weave in all ends and block as desired.



STANDARD ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

Garter St: Knit EVERY row when working back and forth in rows. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working in the round.

k: knitp: purl

pm: place markerRS: right sidesm: slip markerst(s): stitch(es)

St st: Stockinette Stitch—Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round.

w&t: wrap and turn, a method of concealing a hole created in short row shaping. On RS rows: With yarn held in front, slip next stitch purlwise, then bring yarn between needles to the back. Slip that same stitch back to the left needle. Turn your work. On WS Rows: With yarn held in back, slip next stitch purlwise, then bring yarn between needles to the front. Slip that same stitch back to the left needle. Turn your work. Unless otherwise indicated, each time you come to a wrapped stitch when working subsequent rows, slip the wrap back over stitch and onto needle, then work the wrap together with its accompanying stitch.

WS: wrong side
