YARN

BERROCO DULCE (50 grs): 2 balls #2022 Sapphire

Note: Scarf used almost the entirety of the two balls; consider purchasing an extra ball, especially if you may want to make a larger shawl.

HOOKS and NOTIONS Crochet hook, size 7 US / 4.5 mm or size to obtain gauge

GAUGE

5 ch spaces and 10 rows = 4" / 10 cm in pattern stitch To save time and ensure accurate measurements, take time to check gauge.

SCARF

Ch 6.

Set-Up Rows: Row 1: Dc in 6th ch from hook, turn.

Row 2: Ch 5, sc in ch space, ch 3, dc in same ch space,

Row 3: Ch 5, [sc in next ch space, ch 3] twice, dc in same ch space, turn.

Row 4: Ch 5, [sc in next ch space, ch 3] 3 times, dc in same ch space, turn.

Row 5: Ch 5, sc in next ch space, ch 3, sc in next ch space, 3 dc in next sc, sc in next ch space, ch 3, sc in next ch space, ch 3, dc in same ch space, turn.

Row 6: Ch 5, [sc in next ch space, ch 3] twice, skip next sc and dc, sc in the center dc, ch 3, skip next dc and sc, [sc 1 in next ch space, ch 3] twice, dc in same ch space, turn.

Pattern Repeat: Rows 7–10: Ch 5, * sc in next ch space, ch 3, repeat from * to the end of the row, dc in same ch space, turn.

Row 11: Ch 5, sc in next ch space, ch 3, sc in next ch space, * 3 dc in next sc, sc in next ch space, [ch 3, sc in next ch space] twice, repeat from * to last space, ch 3, dc in same ch space, turn.

Row 12: Ch 5, [sc in next ch space, ch 3] twice, * skip next sc and dc, sc in the center dc, ch 3, skip next dc and sc, [sc in next ch space, ch 3] twice, repeat from * to last space, dc in same ch space, turn.

Repeat Rows 7–12 eight times more, then work Rows 7–10 once more. Fasten off.


FINISHING

Weave in all ends and block as desired.

Make 3 tassels and attach 1 tassel to each of the 3 points of the triangle.

beg: beginning **CC:** contrasting color

cont: continue ch: chain dec: decrease dc: double crochet

dtr: double treble crochet

est: established

hdc: half double crochet

inc: increase MC: main color pat(s): pattern(s) pm: place marker rep: repeat rnd(s): round(s) RS: right side **sc:** single crochet

sl st: slip stitch

sliding loop: Form a loop of yarn around your fingers, with the end attached to the ball on the right and the tail on the left. Insert hook into the loop under both pieces of yarn and draw up a loop onto hook. (This does not count as your first stitch.) Work first row into the original loop. Pull up the yarn tail after your first row is complete to close the loop.

sp: space st(s): stitch(es) tog: together tr: treble

WS: wrong side yo: yarn over
