

#### YARN

BERROCO LANAS LIGHT (100 g): 1 ball #78122 Tide (MC) BERROCO LANAS LIGHT MINI COLOR PACK #3 Cool Beach (25 g each) 78130 Driftwood (C1), 78110 Grapefruit (C2), 78125 Lavender (C3), 78118 Aquamarine (C4), 78102 Steel Cut Oats (C5)

HOOKS Size G-6 / 4 mm crochet hook

**NOTIONS** Tapestry needle Three ½" / 12 mm buttons

#### GAUGE

Granny Square (Rnds 1–5) measures 4" / 10 cm across. (Does not include joining rnd) Gauge shown is after blocking. To save time and ensure accurate measurements, take time to check gauge.

#### **CONSTRUCTION NOTES**

Jacket is made from granny square motifs attatched using the join as you go method.

### BASIC GRANNY SQUARE (Color Versions 1–4)

**Note:** Using the directions below, make granny squares with colors listed for each version.

Begin with a sliding loop.

Rnd 1: Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), 2 dc in loop, ch 2, [3 dc in loop, ch 2] 3 times, join with sl st in top of beg ch-3. Do not turn. Fasten off.

Rnd 2: Join yarn in any ch-2 sp. Ch 3, (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same ch-2 sp, ch 1, [(3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp, ch 1] 3 times, join with sl st in top of beg ch-3. Do not turn. Fasten off.

Rnd 3: Join in any ch-2 sp. Ch 3, (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same ch-2 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, [(3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1] 3 times, join with sl st in top of beginning ch-3. Fasten off.

Rnd 4: Join yarn in any ch-2 sp. Ch 3, (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same ch-2 sp, ch 1, \* 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from \* across to next ch-2 sp, [(3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in ch-2 sp, ch 1, \*\* 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from \*\* across to next ch-2 sp] 3 times, join with sl st in top of beg ch-3. Do not turn. Fasten off.

Rnd 5: Join yarn in any ch-2 sp. Ch 3, (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same ch-2 sp, ch 1, \* 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from \* across to next ch-2 sp, [(3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in ch-2 sp, ch 1,



\*\* 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from \*\* across to next ch-2 sp] 3 times, join with sl st in top of beginning ch-3. Fasten off.

#### **GRANNY SQUARE (Color Version 1)**

Make (2, 3, 4) using colors below.

**Rnd 1:** C1.

**Rnd 2:** C2.

Rnd 3: C3.

Rnd 4: C4.

**Rnd 5:** C5.

#### GRANNY SQUARE (Color Version 2)

Make (2, 3, 4) using colors below.

Rnd 1: C2.

Rnd 2: C4.

Rnd 3: C5.

Rnd 4: C3.

**Rnd 5:** C1.

#### **GRANNY SQUARE (Color Version 3)**

Make (2, 3, 4) using colors below.

**Rnd 1:** C5.

Rnd 2: C3.

Rnd 3: C2.

**Rnd 4:** C1.

**Rnd 5:** C4.

#### **GRANNY SQUARE (Color Version 4)**

Make (3, 3, 4) using colors below.

**Rnd 1:** C3.

**Rnd 2:** C1.

Rnd 3: C4.

Rnd 4: C5.

Rnd 5: C2.

#### **GRANNY SQUARE (Color Version 5)**

Make (2, 2, 4) using colors below.

Rnd 1: C5.

**Rnd 2:** C1.

Rnd 3: C2.

Rnd 4: C3.

Rnd 5: C4.

#### FIRST SQUARE

Start with a (Version 2, Version 2, Version 3) square. Join MC in any ch-2 sp. Ch 3, (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same ch-2 sp, ch 1, \* 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from \* across to next ch-2 sp, [(3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in ch-2 sp, ch 1, \*\* 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from \*\* across to next ch-2 sp] 3 times, join with sl st in top of beginning ch-3. Fasten off.

#### GRANNY JOINING (Attaching on 1 Side)

Refer to assembly diagram for placement of squares. Join MC in any ch-2 sp. Ch 3, 2 dc in same ch-2 sp, ch 1, \* 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from \* across to next ch-2 sp, [(3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in ch-2 sp, ch 1, \*\* 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from \*\* across to next ch-2 sp] 2 times, 3 dc in ch-2 sp, ch 1, slst in ch-2 sp of next granny square, 3 dc in same

ch-2 sp of working granny square, sl st in ch-1 sp of other granny square, \*\*\* 3 dc in next ch-1 sp of working granny square, slst in ch-1 sp of other granny square; rep from \*\*\* across to next ch-2 sp, 3 dc in ch-2 sp, ch 1, sl st in ch-2 sp of other granny square, join with sl st in top of beginning ch-3. Fasten off.

#### GRANNY JOINING (Attatching on 2 Sides)

For second square (and following) of each row, work as follows:

Join MC in any ch-2 sp. Ch 3, 2 dc in same ch-2 sp, ch 1, \* 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; repeat from \* across to next ch-2 sp, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in ch-2 sp, ch 1, \*\* 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from \*\* across to next ch-2 sp, [3 dc in ch-2 sp, ch 1, sl st in ch-2 sp of next granny square, 3 dc in same ch-2 sp of working granny square, sl st in ch-1 sp of other granny square, \*\*\* 3 dc in next ch-1 sp of working granny square, sl st in ch-1 sp of other granny square; repeat from \*\*\* across to next ch-2 sp] 2 times, 3 dc in ch-2 sp, ch 1, sl st in ch-2 sp of other granny square, join with sl st in top of beginning ch-3. Fasten off.

Rep Granny Joining until all granny squares are attatched as shown in corresponding diagram.

Attatch two ½" / 12 mm buttons to one of the front neck squares about 3" / 7.5 cm apart and the third button at the top center of the first square, as shown on assembly diagram.. To place these buttons, lay Jacket on dog and mark furthest point of overlap. Stitch on buttons.

#### FINISHING


Weave in all ends and block as desired.

Start here, join in direction of arrows below.




#### **CHART NOTES**

10th square of small size added in same manner as 1st square after all other squares are joined


#### **LARGE**

#### STANDARD ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

**Note:** Berroco patterns use American crochet terms

beg: beginningBLO: back loop onlyBP: back post

**BPdc:** back post double crochet

BPhdc: back post half double crochet

**BPsc:** back post single crochet **BPtc:** back post treble crochet

CC: contrasting color cont: continue ch: chain dec: decrease dc: double crochet

dc2tog: double crochet 2 stitches together—Yo, insert hook into indicated stitch, yo, pull up a loop, yo, pull through 2 loops, yo, insert hook into next indicated stitch, yo, pull up a loop, yo, pull through 2 loops, yo, pull

through all 3 loops.

dtr: double treble crochet

est: established
FLO: front loop only
est: established
FP: front post

**FPdc:** front post double crochet **FPhdc:** front post half double crochet

**FPsc:** front post single crochet **FPtc:** front post treble crochet **hdc:** half double crochet

hdc2tog: half double crochet 2 stitches together—Yo, insert hook into indicated stitch, yo, pull up a loop, yo, insert hook into next indicated stitch, yo, pull up a loop,

yo, pull through all 5 loops.

inc: increase

Magic Ring: Form a loop of yarn around your fingers, with the end attached to the ball on the right and the tail on the left. Insert hook into the loop under both pieces of yarn and draw up a loop onto hook. (This does not count as your first stitch.) Work first row into the original loop. Pull up the yarn tail after your first row is complete to close the loop.

MC: main color
pat(s): pattern(s)
pm: place marker
rep: repeat
rnd(s): round(s)
RS: right side
sc: single crochet

**sc2tog:** single crochet 2 stitches together—Insert hook into first indicated stitch, yo, pull up a loop, insert hook into next indicated stitch, yo, pull up a loop, yo, pull through all

3 loops on hook sl st: slip stitch sp: space st(s): stitch(es) tog: together tr: treble

WS: wrong side yo: yarn over
