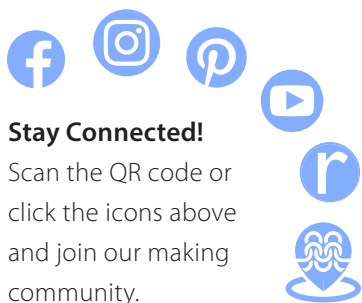

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SIZES

(1, 2, 3) [4, 5, 6] {7, 8, 9}

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Bust: (34, 38, 42½) [47, 51½, 55½] {60, 64½, 68½}" / (85, 95, 106.5) [117.5, 129, 139] {150, 161.5, 171.5} cm

Length: (19½, 20, 20½) [20¾, 21¼, 21½] {22, 22½, 22¾}" / (49, 50, 51.5) [52, 53, 54] {55, 56.5, 57} cm

Shown in size 3 (42½" / 106 cm), modeled with 7½" / 19 cm positive ease.

Recommended ease: 4–8" / 10–20 cm positive ease.

YARN

BERROCO TILLIE (100 g): (3, 4, 4) [4, 5, 5] {5, 5, 6} hanks
#10989 Nantucket Blue

HOOK

Crochet hook, size G-6 / 4 mm or size to obtain gauge

NOTIONS

Removable stitch markers, tapestry needle, seven ⅝" / 16 mm buttons

GAUGE

22 sts and 10 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Pattern St

Gauge is measured after blocking. To save time and ensure accurate measurements, take time to check gauge.

CONSTRUCTION NOTES

Cardigan is crocheted in pieces and seamed, crocheted ribbing is applied for bottom hem, sleeve cuffs, and neckband.

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INSTRUCTIONS

BACK

Ch (96, 108, 120) [132, 144, 156] {168, 180, 192}.

Row 1 (RS): Dc in 6th ch from hook (counts as dc, ch 1, dc), * ch 1, skip next ch, dc in next ch; rep from * to end, turn. (47, 53, 59) [65, 71, 77] {83, 89, 95} *dcs* and (46, 52, 58) [64, 70, 76] {82, 88, 94} *ch-1 sps*; (93, 105, 117) [129, 141, 153] {165, 177, 189} *total sts*.

Row 2 (WS): Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1 throughout), skip next ch-1 sp, * dc in next dc, skip next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from * to last dc, dc in last dc, turn.

Rows 3–(44, 45, 46) [47, 48, 49] {50, 51, 52}: Rep Row 2.

Fasten off.

RIGHT FRONT

Ch (46, 52, 58) [64, 70, 76] {82, 88, 94}.

Row 1 (RS): Dc in 6th ch from hook (counts as dc, ch 1, dc), * ch 1, skip next ch, dc in next ch; rep from * to end, turn. (22, 25, 28) [31, 34, 37] {40, 43, 46} *dcs*, (21, 24, 27) [30, 33, 36] {39, 42, 45} *ch-1 sps*; (43, 49, 55) [61, 67, 73] {79, 85, 91} *sts*.

Row 2 (WS): Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), skip next ch-1 sp, * dc in next dc, skip next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from * to last dc, dc in last dc, turn.

Rows 3–24: Rep Row 2.

Row 25—Dec Row (RS): Ch 3 (counts as dc), skip next ch-1 sp, * dc in next dc, skip next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from * to last dc, dc in last dc, turn. *1 st dec'd*.

Row 26—Dec Row (WS): Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), skip next ch-1 sp, * dc in next dc, skip next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from * to last 2 sts, dc2tog, turn. *1 st dec'd*.

Rows 27–40: Rep Rows 25 and 26. (22, 25, 28) [31, 34, 37] {40, 43, 46} *dcs*, (21, 24, 27) [30, 33, 36] {39, 42, 45} *ch-1 sps*; (27, 33, 39) [45, 51, 57] {63, 69, 75} *sts*.

Rows 41–(44, 45, 46) [47, 48, 49] {50, 51, 52}: Work even.

Fasten off.

LEFT FRONT

Ch (46, 52, 58) [64, 70, 76] {82, 88, 94}.

Row 1 (RS): Dc in 6th ch from hook (counts as dc, ch 1, dc), * ch 1, skip next ch, dc in next ch; rep from * to end, turn. (22, 25, 28) [31, 34, 37] {40, 43, 46} dcs, (21, 24, 27) [30, 33, 36] {39, 42, 45} ch-1 sps; (43, 49, 55) [61, 67, 73] {79, 85, 91} sts.

Row 2 (WS): Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), skip next ch-1 sp, * dc in next dc, skip next ch-1 space, ch 1; rep from * to last dc, dc in last dc, turn.

Rows 3–24: Rep Row 2.

Row 25—Dec Row (RS): Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), skip next ch-1 sp, * dc in next dc, skip next ch-1 space, ch 1; rep from * to last 3 sts, dc in next dc, skip next ch-1 sp, dc in last dc (do not ch between the last set of dcs), turn. *1 st dec'd.*

Row 26—Dec Row (WS): Ch 2, dc in next dc (counts as dc2tog), ch 1, * dc in next dc, skip next ch-1 space, ch 1; rep from * to last dc, dc in last dc, turn. *1 st dec'd.*

Rows 27–40: Rep Rows 25 and 26. (22, 25, 28) [31, 34, 37] {40, 43, 46} dcs, (21, 24, 27) [30, 33, 36] {39, 42, 45} ch-1 sps; (27, 33, 39) [45, 51, 57] {63, 69, 75} sts.

Rows 41–(44, 45, 46) [47, 48, 49] {50, 51, 52}: Work even. Fasten off.

SLEEVES

Ch (56, 56, 56) [58, 60, 62] {66, 66, 66}.

Row 1 (RS): Dc in 6th ch from hook (counts as dc, ch 1, dc), * ch 1, skip next ch, dc in next ch; rep from * to end, turn. (53, 53, 53) [55, 57, 59] {63, 63, 63} sts.

Row 2—Inc Row (WS): Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in same dc, ch 1, * dc in next dc, skip next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from * to last dc, 2 dc in last dc. *2 sts inc'd.*

Row 3—Inc Row (RS): Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1) dc in next dc, ch 1, * skip next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc, ch 1; rep from * to last 3 sts, skip next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc, ch 1, dc in last dc. *2 sts inc'd.*

Row 4: Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), * skip next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc, ch 1; rep from * to last 2 sts, skip next ch-1 sp, dc in last dc.

Row 5: Rep Row 4.

For Sizes (1, 2, 3) [4, 5, 6] {7, 8, X} ONLY:

Rows 6–(33, 33, 29) [25, 25, 17] {17, 9, X}: Rep Rows 2–5. (43, 43, 41) [40, 41, 38] {40, 36, X} dcs, (42, 42, 40) [39, 35, X] ch-1 sps; (85, 85, 81) [79, 81, 75] {79, 71, X} sts.

For Sizes (X, 2, 3) [4, 5, 6] {7, 8, 9} ONLY:

Rows (X, 34, 30) [26, 26, 18] {18, 10, 6}–(X, 37, 37) [37, 37, 35] {35, 33, 33}: Rep Rows 2 and 3. (X, 47, 49) [52, 53, 56] {58, 60, 60} dcs, (X, 46, 48) [51, 52, 55] {57, 59, 59} ch-1 sps; (X, 93, 97) [103, 105, 111] {115, 119, 119} sts.

For Size 1 ONLY:

Rows 34–36: Rep Row 4.

For ALL Sizes:

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Wet block pieces to measurements. Mark center 39 sts at top of back for neck, then sew shoulder seams. Place a removable stitch marker on back and fronts, (8, 8½, 8¾) [9¼, 9½, 10] {10½, 10¾, 11¼}" / (20, 21.5, 22) [23, 24, 25] {26.5, 27, 28} cm down from the shoulder seam. Sew on sleeves between markers.

Sleeve cuffs:

Join yarn to lower left corner of sleeve with a sl st in first st, then ch 14.

Set Up Rib: Row 1 (RS): Sc in second ch, sc in each ch across, sc2tog in the next 2 sts of sleeve, turn.

Row 2 (WS): Sc in BLO of second sc, sc in BLO of each sc across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in BLO of second sc, sc in BLO of each sc across, sc2tog in the next 2 sts of sleeve, turn.

Rep Rows 2 and 3, working into each ch across bottom of sleeve.

Fasten off.

Sew sleeve and side seams.

Lower Hem:

Join yarn to lower corner of left front with a sl st in first st, then ch 14.

Set Up Rib: Row 1 (RS): Sc in second ch, sc in each ch across, sc2tog in the next 2 sts of sleeve, turn.

Row 2 (WS): Sc in BLO of second sc, sc in BLO of each sc across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in BLO of second sc, sc in BLO of each sc across, sc2tog in the next 2 sts of sleeve, turn.

Rep Rows 2 and 3, working into each ch across bottom of left front, then continue across back and right front. Fasten off.

Collar:

Place removable markers along right front edge as follows: 1 centered on the lower ribbing, one 1" / 2.5 cm below beginning of neck shaping, and 5 evenly spaced between.

Join yarn to ribbing at lower right front edge with a sl st in first st, then ch 8.

Set up Rib: Row 1 (RS): Sc in second ch, sc in each ch across, sc2tog in the next 2 sts of ribbing, turn.

Row 2 (WS): Sc in BLO of second sc, sc in BLO of each sc across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in BLO of each sc across, sc2tog in the next 2 sts of ribbing, turn.

Rep Rows 2 and 3 once more.

Buttonhole Row: Sc in BLO of second sc, sc in BLO of next sc, ch 2, skip next 2 sc, sc in BLO of last 3 sc, turn.

Next Row: Ch 1, sc in BLO of next 3 sc, sc in next 2 ch, sc in BLO of next 2 sc across, sc2tog in the next 2 sts of ribbing, turn.

Continue working ribbing in this manner, adding buttonholes at each marker, 6 times more, working into each st of ribbing, then twice in each row of right front up to the shoulder, in each st of back neck, twice in each row of the left front down to the ribbing, then in each st of ribbing.

Fasten off.

Weave in all ends and sew on buttons opposite the buttonholes.

STANDARD ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

Note: Berroco patterns use American crochet terms

BLO: back loop only

ch: chain

dc: double crochet

dc2tog: double crochet 2 stitches together—Yo, insert hook into indicated stitch, yo, pull up a loop, yo, pull through 2 loops, yo, insert hook into next indicated stitch, yo, pull up a loop, yo, pull through 2 loops, yo, pull through all 3 loops.

dec: decrease

inc: increase

rep: repeat

RS: right side

sc: single crochet

sc2tog: single crochet 2 stitches together—Insert hook into first indicated stitch, yo, pull up a loop, insert hook into next indicated stitch, yo, pull up a loop, yo, pull through all 3 loops on hook

sl st: slip stitch

sp: space

st(s): stitch(es)

tog: together

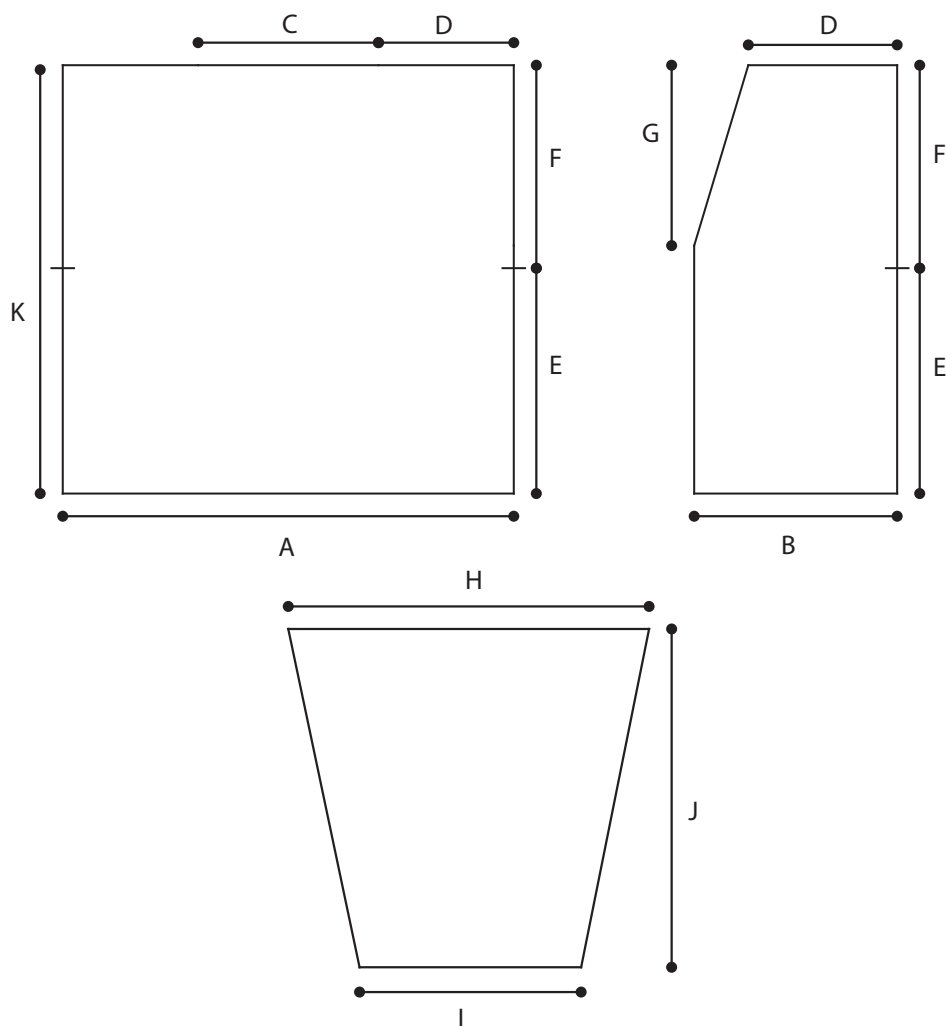
WS: wrong side

yo: yarn over

- A (Back Width): (17, 19, 21¼) [23½, 25¾, 27¾] {30, 32¼, 34¼}" / (42.5, 47.5, 53) [59, 64.5, 69.5] {75, 80.5, 85.5} cm
- B (Front Width): (7¾, 9, 10) [11, 12¼, 13¼] {14¼, 15½, 16½}" / (19.5, 22.5, 25) [27.5, 30.5, 33] {35.5, 39, 41.5} cm
- C (Back Neck Width): 7" / 17.5 cm
- D (Shoulder Width): (5, 6, 7) [8¼, 9¼, 10¼] {11½, 12½, 13¾}" / (12.5, 15, 17.5) [20.5, 23, 25.5] {29, 31.5, 34.5} cm
- E (Length to Underarms): 9½" / 24 cm (not including hems)
- F (Armhole Length): (8, 8½, 8¾) [9¼, 9½, 10] {10½, 10¾, 11¼}" / (20, 21.5, 22) [23, 24, 25] {26.5, 27, 28} cm
- G (Length of V-neck): (8, 8½, 9) [9¼, 9¾, 10] {10½, 11, 11¼}" / (20, 21.5, 22.5) [23, 24.5, 25] {26.5, 27.5, 28} cm
- H (Upper Sleeve Width): (15½, 17, 17¾) [18¾, 19, 20¼] {21, 21¾, 22¼}" / (39, 42.5, 44.5) [47, 47.5, 50.5] {52.5, 54.5, 55.5} cm
- I (Sleeve Cuff Width): (9¾, 9¾, 9¾) [10, 10¼, 10¾] {11½, 11½, 11½}" / (24.5, 24.5, 24.5) [25, 25.5, 27] {29, 29, 29} cm
- J (Sleeve Length): (15, 15, 15) [15, 15, 14½] {14, 13½, 13}" / (37.5, 37.5, 37.5) [37.5, 37.5, 36.5] {35, 34, 32.5} cm (not including hem)
- K (Total Length): (17½, 18, 18½) [18¾, 19¼, 19½] {20, 20½, 20¾}" / (44, 45, 46.5) [47, 48, 49] {50, 51.5, 52} cm (not including hem)
