#### SIZES

(1, 2, 3) [4, 5, 6, 7] {8, 9, 10}

#### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Bust: (34, 38, 42) [46, 50, 54, 58] {62, 66, 70}" / (86.5, 96.5, 106.5) [117, 127, 137, 147.5] {157.5, 167.5, 178} cm

Length: (21, 21½, 22½) [23, 23½, 24, 24½] {25, 25½, 26¼}" / (53.5, 55, 57) [58.5, 59.5, 61, 62] {63.5, 65, 66.5} cm  
(measured from back neck)

Shown in size 4 (46" / 117 cm) with 10" / 25 cm positive ease.

Recommended ease: Approximately 6–10" / 15–25 cm of positive ease.

#### YARN

**BERROCO MILLSTONE TWEED** (50 grs): (8, 9, 10) [11, 12, 13, 14] {16, 17, 19} balls #11116 Admiral

#### NEEDLES

16" / 40 cm and 32" / 80 cm circular needles, sizes 7 / 4.5 mm and 9 / 5.5 mm or size to obtain gauge

1 set each double-pointed needles, or preferred needles for working small circumferences, sizes 7 / 4.5 mm and 9 / 5.5 mm

#### NOTIONS

4 stitch markers, one a different color for BOR, waste yarn to hold stitches, tapestry needle

#### GAUGE

16 sts and 24 rnds = 4" / 10 cm in St st using larger needles

*Gauge is measured after blocking. To save time and ensure accurate measurements, take time to check gauge.*

#### CONSTRUCTION NOTES

Pullover is worked in the round from the top down with raglan shaping on the yoke. Neck is shaped using short rows.



## INSTRUCTIONS

### YOKE

With larger 16" / 40 cm needle, cast on (80, 80, 80) [80, 84, 84, 84] {88, 88, 88} sts. Place BOR marker and join for working in the round. (Marker will be at right back shoulder).

**Set-Up Rnd:** \* K6, pm, knit (34, 34, 34) [34, 36, 36, 36] {38, 38, 38}, pm; rep from \* once more, omitting last pm (BOR marker is already in place).

**Short Rows:** **Short Row 1 (RS):** K1, M1R, knit to 1 st before marker M1L, k1, sm, k1, M1R, k1, w&t. 3 sts inc'd.

**Short Row 2 (WS):** Purl to BOR marker, sm, \* p1, M1pL, purl to 1 st before next marker, M1pR, p1, sm; rep from \* once more, p1, M1pL, p1, w&t. 5 sts inc'd.

**Short Row 3 (RS):** Knit to BOR marker, sm, k1, M1R, knit to 1 st before marker, M1L, k1, sm, k1, M1R, knit to wrapped st, pick up wrap and knit it with its st, k1, w&t. 3 sts inc'd.

**Short Row 4 (WS):** Purl to BOR marker, sm, \* p1, M1pL, purl to 1 st before next marker, M1pR, p1, sm; rep from \* once more, p1, M1pL, purl to wrapped st, pick up wrap and purl it with its st, p1, w&t. 5 sts inc'd.

Rep the last 2 rows 3 times more.

**Next Rnd (Inc Rnd):** Knit to BOR marker, \* sm, k1, M1R, knit to 1 st before next marker, M1L, k1; rep from \* 3 times more, picking up wraps and knitting them with their sts as you come to them. (128, 128, 128) [128, 132, 132, 132] {136, 136, 136} sts. (46, 46, 46) [46, 48, 48, 48] {50, 50, 50} sts each on front and back, (18, 18, 18) [18, 18, 18, 18] {18, 18, 18} on each sleeve.

Knit 1 round even.

**Note:** For the remainder of the yoke, the following three types of increase rounds will be used; please read ahead for instructions about when to work which type of round. Do not work any Inc Rnds until you reach the instructions for your size.

**Inc Rnd 1:** \* K1, M1R, knit to 1 st before marker, M1L, k1, sm; rep from \* 3 more times. 8 sts inc'd; 2 on each sleeve, 2 each on front and back.

**Inc Rnd 2:** \* K1, M1R, knit to 1 st before marker, M1L, k1, sm, knit to next marker, sm; rep from \* one more time. 4 sts inc'd; 2 on each sleeve.

**Inc Rnd 3:** \* Knit to marker, sm, k1, M1R, knit to 1 st before marker, M1L, k1, sm; rep from \* one more time. 4 sts inc'd; 2 each on front and back.

**Note:** When there are too many stitches to fit comfortably on larger 16" / 40 cm circular needle, change to larger 32" / 80 cm circular needle.

**For All Sizes:** Work Inc Rnd 1, work 1 round even. Repeat the last 2 rounds (0, 3, 7) [14, 16, 18, 13] {14, 13, 13} times more. (136, 160, 192) [248, 268, 284, 244] {256, 248, 248} sts total; (48, 54, 62) [76, 82, 86, 76] {80, 78, 78} sts each for front and back, (20, 26, 34) [48, 52, 56, 46] {48, 46, 46} sts for each sleeve.

**For Sizes 1, 2, and 3 ONLY:** Work Inc Rnd 2, work 1 round even, work Inc Rnd 1, work 1 round even. Repeat the last 4 rounds (5, 3, 1) [X, X, X, X] {X, X, X} time(s) more, then work Inc Rnd 1 every 4th round (0, 3, 4) [X, X, X] {X, X, X} times. (208, 232, 248) [X, X, X, X] {X, X, X} sts total; (60, 68, 74) [X, X, X, X] {X, X, X} sts each for front and back, (44, 48, 50) [X, X, X, X] {X, X, X} sts for each sleeve.

**For Sizes 4 and 5 ONLY:** Work Inc Rnd 1, work 3 rounds even. Repeat the last 4 rounds (X, X, X) [2, 1, X, X] {X, X, X} time(s) more, then work Inc Rnd 3 (X, X, X) [0, 1, X, X] {X, X, X} time(s), work 3 rounds even. (X, X, X) [272, 288, X, X] {X, X, X} sts total, (X, X, X) [82, 88, X, X] {X, X, X} sts each for front and back, (X, X, X) [54, 56, X, X] {X, X, X} sts for each sleeve.

**For Sizes 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10 ONLY:** Work Inc Rnd 1, work 1 round even, work Inc Rnd 3, work 1 round even. Repeat the last 4 rounds (X, X, X) [X, X, 0, 5] {5, 6, 7} times more, then work Inc Rnd 3 every round (X, X, X) [X, X, 3, 1] {2, 4, 6} time(s) more. (X, X, X) [X, X, 308, 320] {336, 348, 368} total sts; (X, X, X) [X, X, 96, 102] {108, 114, 122} sts each for front and back, (X, X, X) [X, X, 58, 58] {60, 60, 62} sts for each sleeve.

**For All Sizes:** Work even if necessary until yoke measures (8, 8 3/4, 9 1/2) [10, 10 1/2, 11, 11 1/2] {12, 12 1/2, 13 1/4}" / (20.5, 22, 24) [25.5, 26.5, 28, 29] {30.5, 32, 33.5} cm (measured down from back neck).

**Divide for Body and Sleeves: Next Rnd:** Remove marker, slip the next (44, 48, 50) [54, 56, 58, 58] {60, 60, 62} sts to waste yarn for Right Sleeve, remove marker, cast on (4, 4, 5) [5, 6, 6, 7] {8, 9, 9} sts, place new BOR marker, cast on (4, 4, 5) [5, 6, 6, 7] {8, 9, 9} sts, knit to next marker, remove marker, slip the next (44, 48, 50) [54, 56, 58, 58] {60, 60, 62} sts to waste yarn for Left Sleeve, remove marker, cast on (4, 4, 5) [5, 6, 6, 7] {8, 9, 9} sts, place side marker, cast on (4, 4, 5) [5, 6, 6, 7] {8, 9, 9} sts, knit to end. (136, 152, 168) [184, 200, 216, 232] {248, 264, 280} sts.

**Body:** Work even until piece measures approximately 9" / 23 cm from underarm.

#### Divide for Hem:

Change to smaller needle.

**Set up Rib: Next Row (RS):** K1, p2tog, k1, \* p1, k1; rep from \* to side marker. (67, 75, 83) [91, 99, 107, 115] {123, 131, 139} sts.

Remove side marker, slip remaining sts to waste yarn for back hem (or leave on larger needle, if preferred).

**Next Row (WS):** P1, \* k1, p1; rep from \* across. Work as established until ribbing measures 4" / 10 cm, end after completing a WS row. Bind off in ribbing.

Work back hem same as front hem.

**Sleeves:** Slip (44, 48, 50) [54, 56, 58, 58] {60, 60, 62} sts from waste yarn to larger dpns, or preferred needles for working small rounds. Begin in center of cast-on stitches of body, pick up and knit (4, 4, 5) [5, 6, 6, 7] {8, 9, 9} sts in these stitches, knit (44, 48, 50) [54, 56, 58, 58] {60, 60, 62} sts previously on waste yarn, then pick up and knit (4, 4, 5) [5, 6, 6, 7] {8, 9, 9} sts in remaining cast-on stitches. (52, 56, 60) [64, 68, 70, 72] {76, 78, 80} sts.

Place marker and join for working in the round. Work even for 4" / 10 cm.

**Dec Rnd:** K1, k2tog, knit to the last 3 sts, SSK, k1. 2 sts dec'd.


Rep Dec Rnd every (20, 14, 10) [10, 10, 10, 8] {7, 6, 5} rounds (2, 3, 4) [4, 4, 4, 5] {6, 7, 8} times more. (46, 48, 50) [54, 58, 60, 60] {62, 62, 62} sts.

Work even until sleeve measures 12" / 30 cm from underarm. Change to smaller needle. Work in k1, p1 ribbing for 4" / 10 cm. Bind off in ribbing.

#### FINISHING

**Neckband:** Using smaller 16" / 40 cm circular needle, begin at right back raglan, pick up and knit one stitch in each cast on st: (34, 34, 34) [34, 36, 36, 36] {38, 38, 38} sts in back neck cast on edge, 6 sts in left sleeve edge, (34, 34, 34) [34, 36, 36, 36] {38, 38, 38} sts in front edge, and 6 sts in right sleeve edge. Pm and join to work in the round. (80, 80, 80) [80, 84, 84, 84] {88, 88, 88} sts.

Work in k1, p1 ribbing until neck measures 8" / 20 cm. Weave in all ends and block as desired.

- A (Body Circumference): (34, 38, 42) [46, 50, 54, 58] {62, 66, 70}" / (86.5, 96.5, 106.5) [117, 127, 137, 147.5] {157.5, 167.5, 178} cm
- B (Neck Circumference): (20, 20, 20) [20, 21, 21, 21] {22, 22, 22}" / (51, 51, 51) [51, 53.5, 53.5, 53.5] {56, 56, 56} cm
- C (Yoke Length): (8, 8¾, 9½) [10, 10½, 11, 11½] {12, 12½, 13¼}" / (20.5, 22, 24) [25.5, 26.6, 28, 29] {30.5, 32, 33.5} cm
- D (Length to Underarms): 13" / 33 cm
- E (Upper Sleeve Circumference): (13, 14, 15) [16, 17, 17½, 18] {19, 19½, 20}" / (33, 35.5, 38) [40.5, 43, 44.5, 45.5] {48.5, 49.5, 51} cm
- F (Sleeve Cuff Circumference): (11½, 12, 12½) [13½, 14½, 15, 15] {15½, 15½, 15½}" / (29, 30.5, 32) [34.5, 37, 38, 38] {39.5, 39.5, 39.5} cm
- G (Sleeve Length): 16" / 40.5 cm
- H (Total Length): (21, 21¾, 22½) [23, 23½, 24, 24½] {25, 25½, 26¼}" / (53.5, 55, 57) [58.5, 59.5, 61, 62] {63.5, 65, 66.5} cm (measured down from back neck)

## STANDARD ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

**BOR:** beginning of round

**dec:** decrease

**inc:** increase

**k:** knit

**k2tog:** knit 2 stitches together (1 st dec'd)

**M1L:** Make 1 Left— Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch inc'd)

**M1pL:** Make 1 purl Left— Make 1 purl—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch inc'd).

**M1pR:** Make 1 purl Right—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch inc'd).

**M1R:** Make 1 Right—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch inc'd)

**p:** purl

**pm:** place marker

**rep:** repeat

**rnd(s):** round(s)

**RS:** right side

**sm:** slip marker

**SSK:** Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together. (1 st dec'd)

**St st:** Stockinette Stitch—Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round.

**st(s):** stitch(es)

**w&t:** wrap and turn, a method of concealing a hole created in short row shaping. On RS rows: With yarn held in front, slip next stitch purlwise, then bring yarn between needles to the back. Slip that same stitch back to the left needle. Turn your work. On WS Rows: With yarn held in back, slip next stitch purlwise, then bring yarn between needles to the front. Slip that same stitch back to the left needle. Turn your work. Unless otherwise indicated, each time you come to a wrapped stitch when working subsequent rows, slip the wrap back over stitch and onto needle, then work the wrap together with its accompanying stitch.

**WS:** wrong side
